PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

RYAN ELLER

Grove City College

6-2 Senior Forward Erie, Pa./Iroquois H.S.

Eller scored a career-high 41 points (shooting 17-of-21 from the field) and added seven assists for Grove City as the Wolverines fell 110-102 in overtime at PAC rival Westminster in the team's only game of the week. He also became the 21st 1,000-point scorer in Grove City history in the contest. Eller's scoring total tied a 41-point output by **Mike Drahos** of Bethany on Jan. 24 for the highest single-game point total in the PAC this season.

Also nominated was junior G/F **Matt Drahos** of Bethany, sophomore G **Brandon Studer** of Washington & Jefferson, and freshman G **Craig Hannon** of Westminster.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

Bethany has now posted wins in its last five games, including two last week over conference foe Thiel (78-72) and Lake Erie (96-93 in 2OT) ... Against Thiel, Bethany held on behind Matt Drahos' offensive performance ... The junior scored 29 points – with six straight points from the free throw line to ice the game - and nabbed 17 rebounds in the win ... Against Lake Erie, the Bison earned their 13th non-conference victory and wrapped up their non-league schedule with a wild 96-93 win in double overtime ... Brandon **Duncan** sank three straight free throws to end the second overtime ... Duncan scored a career-best 31 points off his 8of-11 three-point accuracy ... Matt Drahos notched 28 points and 16 rebounds.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J recorded its first win at the Rudy Marisa Fieldhouse since 1993-94 after defeating Waynesburg, 71-69, Saturday ... Sophomore G Brandon Studer canned a pair of free throws with eight seconds to lift the Presidents to the victory ... Studer finished with a game-high 23 points, while classmate Jon Koch added 20 ... A late first-half run on Tuesday gave LaRoche a double-digit lead and the Redhawks held on for a 76-69 triumph ... Koch led the Presidents with 22 points on 8-of-15 shooting ... Sophomore F Patrick Stewart finished with 12 points and six rebounds, while sophomore PG Anthony Hairston added 10 points and four boards ... The Presidents shot 42 percent (24-of-57) and were out-rebounded by a 32-29 margin.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City dropped into a second-place tie with Westminster Saturday after the Wolverines' overtime loss to Westminster ... Senior F Ryan Eller became Grove City's 21st 1,000-point scorer after pouring in a career-best 41 points Saturday, giving him 1,005 career points ... Eller also became the first Grove City player in 10 years to score 40 points or more in a game ... Phil Bushre nearly posted GCC's second all-time recorded tripledouble with 27 points, 12 rebounds and eight assists ... Saturday's game tied for the highest scoring in series history with 212 points ... Three years ago, Grove City downed the Titans in four overtimes, 111-101 ... Bushre, Eller and guard J.D. Collar all played in that game.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg fell to 2-4 in the PAC with a 71-69 loss to W&J after losing to nonconference Notre Dame (Ohio), 86-61, earlier in the week ... Against the Presidents, the Yellow Jackets trailed by 16 points with 14 minutes left in the game before tying the score at 69-69 with 30 seconds left ... Jacket F Jeff Nero finished with a team-high 17 points and seven rebounds off the bench ... He made 5-of-6 attempts from the field, including 4-of-5 from beyond the arc ... Reserve G Chris Moore added 10 points in the loss ... Against the NAIA Falcons, sophomore F Shawn Coleman scored a team-high 20 points on 9-of-13 attempts and grabbed a team-high six rebounds ... Classmates Marc Lodovico, Nero, and Beau Wilson all reached double digits.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel saw its winless streak extend to 13 last week - losing at Lancaster Bible 87-81 Wednesday and at home to Bethany 78-72 Saturday ... Against the Chargers freshman F Joe Herrmann led four Tomcats in double figures with 18 points, including 3-of-6 from three-point range ... On Saturday, senior G Daryl Moore capped a late 13-2 run by the Tomcats and cut the Bison lead to two (74-72) with just under a half-minute to play before Matt Drahos was perfect on four free throws down the stretch to seal the Bethany win ... Herrmann had 23 points, nine rebounds and four steals while freshman G Ross Watson had career highs in points (18) and rebounds (8)...Moore finished with 14 points and five assists.

Westminster Titans

The Titans dropped a 125-116 non-league decision at NAIA Geneva Tuesday before topping PAC foe Grove City 110-102 in overtime Saturday ... At Geneva, junior F Dom Joseph paced Westminster with 18 points, followed by junior G Mark DeMonaco with 17 ... Senior G Chris Hatch added 13 points and a team-high eight rebounds, while DeMonaco dished out seven assists ... Freshman G Craig Hannon scored 13 of his team-high 26 points in overtime of the GCC win ... Joseph added 19 points and a team- and season-best 10 rebounds and six assists ... Other Titan double-digit scorers included senior F Pat O'Connor with 12 and freshman G Brian Urso with a career-high 11 points.

Upcoming Game Notes: Bethany enters its game against W&J with a five-game win streak on the line ... W&J already snapped a Bison winning streak, edging Bethany 66-64 in Washington, Pa., to end an 11-game win streak ... Bethany hasn't tasted defeat since falling to W&J ... Saturday's contest with Westminster will be an offensive battle between the two schools ... Bethany earned a 120-109 victory over the Titans earlier this season with **Mike Drahos** scoring a PAC season-best 41 points ... The game also marks the second time the Bison face the team that defeated them in the 2004 PAC Championship game.
