The Tomcats took command with a 66-59 road victory over second-place Bethany Wednesday and can clinch the top seed with a pair of wins this week.

Senior Rich Colick hit a 12-foot jumper as time expired gave him a team-high 23 points and lifted Geneva to a two-point road win at Thomas More ... 
