TMC-W&J SHOWDOWN SET: The race for the top seed in the 2009 PAC Men's Basketball Championship Tournament is down to two teams. Thomas More took a big step towards clinching the top spot with a pair of league road wins last week. The only PAC team that can still catch Thomas More for the top seed is Washington & Jefferson, which visits Kentucky for a huge PAC showdown this Wednesday (Feb. 11). A TMC win clinches the top spot and home court advantage for the Saints.

WHO'S HOT: Saint Vincent ran its win streak to six games with two victories last week, led by Tre'sor Kalambay with 22 points against Geneva... Washington & Jefferson has now won four straight contests, as senior C Josip Lucic-Jozak posted 23 points and nine rebounds in a win over Thiel ... Junior F Ryne Murray became the 32nd 1,000-point scorer in Westminster history while averaging 14.0 ppg for the 1-1 Titans ... Junior F Joe Testa averaged 17.5 points and 11.0 rebounds for 1-1 Bethany.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: ... Freshman Dave Phillips scored 23 points for Geneva in a 102-89 loss to Saint Vincent ... Senior W Daniel Ellis scored a career-high 20 points for Thomas More in a 73-59 road win at Grove City, while Romell Salone averaged 17.0 ppg in two wins ... Senior Ryan Gibson surpassed the 1,000-point mark for Grove City in a loss to Thomas More ... G Dan Happe averaged 18.0 ppg in a pair of losses for Waynesburg last week ... Nick Sefscik averaged 12.0 ppg during an 0-2 week for Thiel.

BJ McGill finished with 18 points, going 7-of-9 from the floor and 4-of-5 from behind the arc, to go with five assists, three steals, and three blocks.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (15-6, 6-3 PAC)

W&J increased its win streak to four games this week with victories over Westminster

and Thiel ... The Presidents need a victory at Thomas More Wednesday to keep their hopes alive of obtaining the No. 1 seed for the upcoming PAC Tournament ... Senior F Wahab Owolabi had a pair of double-doubles during the week, increasing his total to five this year ... Senior C Josip Lucic-Jozak averaged 13.5 points and 8.0 rebounds during the two wins, including 23 points and nine rebounds versus Thiel ... Sophomore PG Adam Braithwaite fired in a trio of three-pointers at Westminster ... W&J has won 15 games in a season for only the 12th time in school history.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (5-15)

In the only action of the week, the Golden Tor-nadoes dropped a 102-

89 decision to Saint Vincent College ... The Golden Tornadoes could not recover from a slow start and a 20-point halftime deficit ... Geneva watched the Bearcats shoot 67% from the field in the first half in opening up a 56-36 lead at the break ... The Golden Tornadoes managed to outscore Saint Vincent 53-46 in the second half, but it wasn't enough ... Dave Phillips led the offensive charge with 23 points while teammates Rich Colick and Lambros Svingos each added 19 points ... Geneva College has dropped five straight home games for the first time under head coach Jeff Santarsiero ... That marks the longest home losing streak since the 1987-88 season.

Thiel Tomcats (2-18, 1-9 PAC)

Thiel College fell 77-63 to Bethany Wednesday night

at Beeghly Gymnasium ... Bethany out-rebounded the Tomcats 41-25, including 18 offensive boards ... The Bison converted those rebounds into 15 second-chance points ... Bethany out-scored the Tomcats 31-0 off the bench ... Thiel was led by Cory Chaffee and Sean Devinney who each scored 15 points ... Brandon Mirizio and Nick Sefscik added 12 points apiece ... On Saturday, Washington & Jefferson extended its win streak versus Thiel to seven games with a 68-52 victory ... Nick Sefscik paced the Tomcats with 12 points and seven rebounds ... He also dished out a gamehigh-tying three assists.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (6-15, 2-8 PAC)

Waynesburg suffered a pair of PAC losses this past week, first dropping a 92-77 home contest against PAC leader Thomas More, and then coming up a little short on a comeback effort at Westminster ... Against the Saints, the Yellow Jackets had four players score in double digits ... Junior G Ryan Courneen led the way with a team-best 16 points, while senior Gs Dan Happe and Jason Clark added 15 and 14 points, respectively ... Sophomore G Erik Noone chipped in 10 points ... Saturday, Waynesburg was able to whittle a 23-point lead down to single digits against Westminster, but couldn't come all the way back as they fell 83-75 to the Titans ... Though it came in a loss, Happe had a huge night, pouring in a game-best 21 points, 19 of

which came in the second half.

Grove City Wolverines (10-9, 4-5 PAC)

Grove City dropped to 4-5 in the PAC Saturday with a 73-59 set-

back against Thomas More ... Senior G Ryan Gibson fired in 20 points and became the program's 23rd all-time 1,000-point scorer ... He now has 1,005 career points ... Grove City held Thomas More to 34 percent shooting from the floor, but could not overcome the Saints' 12 three-pointers ... Thomas More had been 0-3 at the GCC Arena prior to Saturday's win ... Grove City honored David Crosby, Gibson, Joe McCoy and John Scheller prior to the game as part of Senior Day ... With Crosby and McCoy both starting, it marked the first time that two Grove City players wearing oddnumbered jerseys started in the same game since March 3, 1999 ... The 1998-99 season is the last year Grove City wore odd numbers on the road and even digits at home.

Salone also added 15 points in the Saints' win over the Wolverines ... For the season, McKeehan averages 11.6 points per game (ppg) and senior F Mark Tinklenberg averages 10.5 ppg.


