## PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2008-09 - Week 10 Conference Notes

**TMC-W&J SHOWDOWN SET:** The race for the top seed in the 2009 PAC Men's Basketball Championship Tournament is down to two teams. Thomas More took a big step towards clinching the top spot with a pair of league road wins last week. The only PAC team that can still catch Thomas More for the top seed is Washington & Jefferson, which visits Kentucky for a huge PAC showdown this Wednesday (Feb. 11). A TMC win clinches the top spot and home court advantage for the Saints.

**WHO'S HOT:** Saint Vincent ran its win streak to six games with two victories last week, led by **Tre'sor Kalambay** with 22 points against Geneva ... Washington & Jefferson has now won four straight contests, as senior C **Josip Lucic-Jozak** posted 23 points and nine rebounds in a win over Thiel ... Junior F **Ryne Murray** became the 32nd 1,000-point scorer in Westminster history while averaging 14.0 ppg for the 1-1 Titans ... Junior F **Joe Testa** averaged 17.5 points and 11.0 rebounds for 1-1 Bethany.

**AROUND THE LEAGUE:** ... Freshman **Dave Phillips** scored 23 points for Geneva in a 102-89 loss to Saint Vincent ... Senior W **Daniel Ellis** scored a career-high 20 points for Thomas More in a 73-59 road win at Grove City, while **Romell Salone** averaged 17.0 ppg in two wins ... Senior **Ryan Gibson** surpassed the 1,000-point mark for Grove City in a loss to Thomas More ... G **Dan Happe** averaged 18.0 ppg in a pair of losses for Waynesburg last week ... **Nick Sefscik** averaged 12.0 ppg during an 0-2 week for Thiel.

# PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

## Bethany Bison (12-10, 6-3 PAC)



For the fourth week in a row, the Bison split their two games during the week ... **Joe Testa** scored eight points during an 18-5 second half run that helped BC pull away for a 77-63 victory at Thiel Wednesday ... Testa scored 16 of his game-high 17 in the second half and his seven rebounds helped Bethany hold a 42-25 advantage on the boards ... **Lance Beckwith** finished with 16 points, matched Testa with seven boards and added in four steals and three assists, while **Petre Petkovski** drilled a trio of threes and tallied 15 ... Against Saint Vincent Saturday, a 14-0 Bearcat run late in the second half allowed the visitors to score a 74-59 win ... Testa recorded his fifth double-double of the year with 18 points and a career-high 15 rebounds and Beckwith chipped in with 17 markers.

## Geneva Golden Tornadoes (5-15)



In the only action of the week, the Golden Tornadoes dropped a 102-89 decision to Saint Vincent College ... The Golden Tornadoes could not recover from a slow start and a 20-point halftime deficit ... Geneva watched the Bearcats shoot 67% from the field in the first half in opening up a 56-36 lead at the break ... The Golden Tornadoes managed to outscore Saint Vincent 53-46 in the second half, but it wasn't enough ... **Dave Phillips** led the offensive charge with 23 points while teammates **Rich Colick** and **Lambros Svingos** each added 19 points ... Geneva College has dropped five straight home games for the first time under head coach **Jeff Santarsiero** ... That marks the longest home losing streak since the 1987-88 season.

## Grove City Wolverines (10-9, 4-5 PAC)



Grove City dropped to 4-5 in the PAC Saturday with a 73-59 setback against Thomas More ... Senior **G Ryan Gibson** fired in 20 points and became the program's 23<sup>rd</sup> all-time 1,000-point scorer ... He now has 1,005 career points ... Grove City held Thomas More to 34 percent shooting from the floor, but could not overcome the Saints' 12 three-pointers ... Thomas More had been 0-3 at the GCC Arena prior to Saturday's win ... Grove City honored **David Crosby**, **Gibson**, **Joe McCoy** and **John Scheller** prior to the game as part of Senior Day ... With Crosby and McCoy both starting, it marked the first time that two Grove City players wearing odd-numbered jerseys started in the same game since March 3, 1999 ... The 1998-99 season is the last year Grove City wore odd numbers on the road and even digits at home.

## Saint Vincent Bearcats (18-3)



The Bearcats extended their win streak to six games with road wins over PAC foes Geneva and Bethany ... Wednesday at Geneva, SVC cracked the century mark for the second straight game, winning 102-89 ... SVC connected on 23-of-33 field goal attempts in the first half to jump out to a 56-36 halftime lead ... **Tre'sor Kalamabay** led five SVC scorers in double-figures with 22 points, going 8-of-9 from the floor ... **Mike Medved** added 15 points on a 6-of-8 performance, while **Jordan Cleary** scored a career-high 11, going 3-of-3 from behind the arc ... Saturday at Bethany, SVC outscored the Bison 18-4 over the final six minutes to earn the 74-59 win ... **BJ McGill** finished with 18 points, going 7-of-9 from the floor and 4-of-5 from behind the arc, to go with five assists, three steals, and three blocks.

## Thiel Tomcats (2-18, 1-9 PAC)



Thiel College fell 77-63 to Bethany Wednesday night at Beeghly Gymnasium ... Bethany out-rebounded the Tomcats 41-25, including 18 offensive boards ... The Bison converted those rebounds into 15 second-chance points ... Bethany out-scored the Tomcats 31-0 off the bench ... Thiel was led by **Cory Chaffee** and **Sean Devinney** who each scored 15 points ... **Brandon Mirizio** and **Nick Sefscik** added 12 points apiece ... On Saturday, Washington & Jefferson extended its win streak versus Thiel to seven games with a 68-52 victory ... **Nick Sefscik** paced the Tomcats with 12 points and seven rebounds ... He also dished out a game-high-tying three assists.

## Thomas More Saints (15-7, 9-2 PAC)



Thomas More went 2-0 last week to increase its season-high win streak to five games as it defeated Waynesburg, 92-77, and Grove City, 73-59, both on the road ... In the win over Waynesburg, junior **G Romell Salone** scored a game-high 20 points as he was 6-of-9 from the field and 8-of-10 from the line ... Joining Salone in double-figures was sophomore **W Daniel McKeehan** with 10 points ... The Saints had 11 different players score as they shot 59.9 percent from the field on 33-of-58 shooting ... In the win at Grove City, senior wing **Daniel Ellis** scored a career-high 20 points ... Salone also added 15 points in the Saints' win over the Wolverines ... For the season, McKeehan averages 11.6 points per game (ppg) and senior **F Mark Tinklenberg** averages 10.5 ppg.

## Washington & Jefferson Presidents (15-6, 6-3 PAC)



W&J increased its win streak to four games this week with victories over Westminster and Thiel ... The Presidents need a victory at Thomas More Wednesday to keep their hopes alive of obtaining the No. 1 seed for the upcoming PAC Tournament ... Senior **F Wahab Owolabi** had a pair of double-doubles during the week, increasing his total to five this year ... Senior **C Josip Lucic-Jozak** averaged 13.5 points and 8.0 rebounds during the two wins, including 23 points and nine rebounds versus Thiel ... Sophomore **PG Adam Braithwaite** fired in a trio of three-pointers at Westminster ... W&J has won 15 games in a season for only the 12<sup>th</sup> time in school history.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (6-15, 2-8 PAC)



Waynesburg suffered a pair of PAC losses this past week, first dropping a 92-77 home contest against PAC leader Thomas More, and then coming up a little short on a comeback effort at Westminster ... Against the Saints, the Yellow Jackets had four players score in double digits ... Junior **G Ryan Courneen** led the way with a team-best 16 points, while senior **Gs Dan Happe** and **Jason Clark** added 15 and 14 points, respectively ... Sophomore **G Erik Noone** chipped in 10 points ... Saturday, Waynesburg was able to whittle a 23-point lead down to single digits against Westminster, but couldn't come all the way back as they fell 83-75 to the Titans ... Though it came in a loss, Happe had a huge night, pouring in a game-best 21 points, 19 of which came in the second half.

## Westminster Titans (7-15, 6-4 PAC)



Westminster went 1-1 in two PAC home games last week, losing to Washington & Jefferson, 80-64, Wednesday before beating Waynesburg, 83-75, on Saturday ... Junior **F Ryne Murray** became the 34th player in team history to score 1,000 career points ... Murray scored 13 points in Westminster's loss to W&J Wednesday ... Freshman **F Rob Briggs** led the Titans with 15 points on 6-of-8 shooting from the floor ... Five Titans made their first starts of the season Saturday, including sophomore **Louie Pisani** who scored a career-high 14 points ... Along with Pisani, four other Westminster players scored in double figures including Murray with 15 points, Briggs with 12, sophomore **G Max Spinner** with 12, and senior **G Bobby Glass** with 10 ... Briggs led Westminster with a career-high 15 rebounds in the Waynesburg game.

A 23-1 blitz in the opening half helped give Bethany a 42-28 lead at the break, but GCC moved within six at 68-62 with 1:45 left in the second half ... **Lance Beckwith** clinched the win with a three and four foul shots in the final minute ... Beckwith and Joe Testa each had 15 to lead the scoring, while **Tyler Morando** dropped in 13 to help the Bison beat Grove City for the 12<sup>th</sup> time in the last 13 match-ups.
