#### PAC Player of the Week

#### BRIAN MUSE Thomas More 6-7 Junior C Bethel, Ohio Bethel H.S.

Muse led the Saints to a pair of tight PAC victories last week while



averaging 14.0 points, 6.0 rebounds, 5.5 blocked shots and 1.5 steals per game. He recorded 16 points, five boards, three blocks and a pair of steals in a 92-89 road win at league foe Geneva on Wednesday, then turned around to record 12 points, seven caroms and a career-high eight blocked shots for the Saints in a 72-68 home victory Saturday against Washington & Jefferson.

Also nominated was senior F Joe Testa of Bethany, sophomore G Brett Matson of Grove City, freshman G Blair Rozenblad of Thiel, junior G Paul Matthews of Washington & Jefferson, junior F Jeff Young of Waynesburg, and senior F Ryne Murray of Westminster.

#### PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2009-10 - Week 12 Conference Notes

SNOW WEEKEND: A huge blizzard which hit the Greater Pittsburgh region over the weekend resulted in the postponment of three of the four PAC men's games scheduled for Saturday. At the conclusion of Monday's play, Grove City is 8-2 in PAC play and in the driver's seat. The Wolverines can clinch the tournament top seed with wins over Thiel and Westminster. Thomas More (7-2) is tied with Grove City in the loss column, but GCC won both meetings between the teams this year.


NEWS & NOTES: Saint Vincent junior G BJ McGill averaged 27.5 ppg in a pair of Saint Vincent losses, while becoming the 29th 1,000-point scorer in school history ... Thiel freshman G Blair Rozenblad averaged 18.0 ppg and 7.0 rpg and Thiel went 2-0 to improve its win streak to six games ... Junior G Paul Matthews averaged 22.0 ppg and 6.5 rpg for 1-1 Washington & Jefferson ... Senior F Joe Testa averaged 24.5 ppg and 10.5 rpg for 0-2 Bethany, including a career-best 35 points against Thiel.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Westminster senior F Ryne Murray scored 22 points in a PAC win over Waynesburg, moving him into the WC all-time Top 10 in scoring with 1,415 career points ... At 12-10, Geneva need just one win in its final three games to clinch a winning record and a possible NCCAA playoff berth ... Grove City sophomore G Brett Matson posted 16 points and seven assists at Bethany ... Waynesburg junior F Jeff Young posted a 14-point, 14-re-bound double-double at Westminster.

### PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

#### **Bethany** Bison (14-7, 6-4 PAC)

Bethany lost a pair of heart-breakers over the last week, falling 86-84





and 11 rebounds.

The Bearcats fell to 5-16 after dropping a pair of games

against PAC foes ... Last Wednesday at W&J, junior BJ McGill became the 29th player in program history to reach the 1,000-point plateau, scoring a game-high 28 points, but it wasn't enough, as the Presidents prevailed 59-55 ... Saint Vincent went just 13-of-23 from the foul line, and was out-rebounded 32-20 ... The Bearcats' losing streak reached nine on Monday, as they fell 75-52 at home to Geneva ... McGill again led the way, scoring 27 points, including a 10-of-11 mark from the foul line ... Aside from McGill, the team's offense struggled again, as they went just 26 percent from the floor (15-of-56) and 4-of-18 from behind the arc.

#### Washington & Jefferson **Presidents** (9-13, 4-5 PAC)

The Presidents snapped a four-game losing streak with a 59-55 victory over Saint

Vincent Wednesday ... Junior G Paul Matthews led W&J with 18 points and four rebounds ... W&J only made two field goals over the final 11 minutes, but fired in 13-of-14 free throws to seal the win ... The Presidents, the nation's second-best free throw shooting unit, made 22-of-24 free throws overall ... Matthews contributed 24 points and nine rebounds Saturday at Thomas More, but a 12-0 Saints' run in the second half proved to be the difference ... Matthews connected on 6-of-9 three-pointers in the loss.

#### Geneva Golden Tornadoes (12-10)



Geneva battled back from 15 points down in GOLDEN TORNADOES the second half against

Thomas More to tie the game at 89-89 with 25 seconds remaining in regulation ... Bryan Hill's fifth three-point field goal of the game tied things up only to see the Saints pull out a 92-89 victory on a three-point field goal with only five seconds left ... The Golden Tornadoes ended their three-game losing streak Monday night with an impressive 75-52 victory at Saint Vincent ... The win completed the first season sweep over the Bearcats since 1999 ... It also put Geneva just one victory away from clinching a .500 season that would guarantee a shot at the NCCAA post-season ... Rich Colick scored 18 points to lead the offense while the defense held Saint Vincent to 26% shooting from the field.

## Thiel **Tomcats**

Senior Sean Devinney led Thiel's four-double-digit

scorers with 17 points Monday as the Tomcats cruised to a 78-54 win at Waynesburg ... Waynesburg didn't put up much resistance as Thiel won its sixth-consecutive contest ... The home-standing Yellow Jackets led only once by two points, 15 seconds into the game before the Tomcats took control ... In addition to Devinney, Devon Adams, Blair Rozenblad and Cory Chaffee each scored in double figures with 14, 13, and 11 points, respectively... Wednesday, Thiel held on to upset Bethany, 86-84, at Beeghly Gymnasium in a key PAC matchup ... Rozenblad paced the Tomcats with 23 points followed by Adams who tossed in 19 ... Devinney finished with 17 points ... Thiel snapped a 15-game winless streak vs. the Bison and upped its home record to 6-1.

In the win over W&J, senior PF Daniel McKeehan and junior C Brian Muse led the Saints as McKeehan had 18 points. seven rebounds and four steals and Muse finished with 12 points, seven rebounds and eight blocks ... After 21 games, three Saints average in double-figure scoring as McKeehan averages 15.1 ppg, junior F Aaron Miller averages 13.2 ppg., and Neeley averages 10.8 ppg. ... Miller leads the team in rebounding with 5.6 rebounds per game, while Neeley leads the team in steals with 44.
