PAC Men's Basketball Player of the Week

ROB STRCULA

Waynesburg College

5-10 Senior Guard Vienna, W.Va./Parkersburg Catholic H.S.

Strcula earned PAC Player of the Week honors for the second time this season, as he led the Yellow Jackets to a 3-0 week with wins over Frostburg State (89-87), Westminster (68-60) and league leader Bethany (89-88). Strcula hit the game-winning shot as time expired against the Bison, as Waynesburg handed Bethany its first conference loss. For the week, he averaged 14.0 points, 3.7 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 1.3 steals in the three wins.

Also nominated was senior forward **Keith Schubert** of Bethany, freshman forward **Ryan Eller** of Grove City, junior forward **A.H. Davis** of Thiel, and junior guard **Nolan Larry** of Washington & Jefferson.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

After winning a pair of games to start the week, the Bison had their nine-game winning streak snapped in heart-breaking fashion at the buzzer against Waynesburg 89-88 ... Forward Keith Schubert became Bethany's all-time leading scorer in the Pitt-Greensburg win with 35 points on 12-18 shooting from the floor and 11-13 from the foul line ... The 111 points were the most by the Bison since a 120-67 win over Thiel in 1981 ... The 6-4 forward came back with 25 to lead four Bison in double figures vs. W&J, while Derek Hoffman and Nevada Smith added 15 each ... Schubert fired in 24, including a jumper with seven seconds left that gave Bethany the lead until Rob Strcula's buzzer-beater vs. Waynesburg.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J took PAC leader Bethany to the wire, but it was not enough as BC hit key free throws down the stretch for a 82-78 victory ... Nolan Larry stole the show in the second half, scoring 25 of his gamehigh 34 points, including five three-pointers ... For the game, he hit 6-of-7 from long distance and added eight rebounds and five assists ... Tony Franz added 15 points and nine rebounds, while **Scott** Chodor netted 12 markers ... Grove City defeated the Presidents for the third time this season, 80-58 ... Larry was the only W&J player in double figures with 23 points on 6-of-21 shooting ... With just more 10 points, Larry will break the single-season record of 500 points, which was set by current W&J assistant coach Terry Wilkins in 1993-94.

Grove City Wolverines

Another 1-1 week in conference play slipped the Wolverines into third place in the PAC behind Bethany and Thiel ... The Wolverines dropped a heartbreaker at Thiel Wednesday as the Tomcats rallied from a 60-53 deficit in the final minute to win 64-63 ... In the loss, freshman Ryan Eller poured in a career-high 22 points on 8-for-8 shooting from the floor and 6-for-6 marksmanship from the line ... Grove City rebounded with a 22-point win over W&J Saturday, completing a three-game sweep of the Presidents ... Junior Andy Vlajkovich led 12 Wolverines in the scoring column with 15 points ... GCC outrebounded W&J, 50-29, which could make them the D-III leader in rebound margin this week (+12.4).

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Jackets capped a 3-0 week as they defeated the PAC-leader Bethany Bison 89-88 in a game Saturday at the Rudy Marisa Field house ... Senior guard **Rob Strcula** hit a two-point field goal at the buzzer for the Jackets victory over Bethany.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats moved to 4-2 in the PAC when sophomore Justin Townsend hit a runner in the lane with less than one second left on the clock to give Thiel a 60-58 win over Grove City ... Thiel was victorious despite hitting just 8-of-19 shots from the charity stripe... Senior Erik Hemsing and junior Durrell Hackett each scored 14 points ... In similar fashion to the Tomcats last-second win over Grove City, Westminster freshman Chris Hatch hit a jumper with five seconds remaining to give the Titans a 60-58 win over the Tomcats ... Junior A.H. Davis paced the Tomcats with 16 points. four rebounds and three assists ... Hemsing finished with 13 markers in the

The Titans went 1-1 in home action against PAC teams last week, falling 68-60 to Waynesburg on Wednesday before topping Thiel 60-58 on freshman Chris Hatch's 15-foot jumper with five seconds remaining ... Junior guard Jeff Simmons was the lone Titan to score in double figures against the Jackets, posting 11 points ... Junior center Greg Foster has extended his streak of double-digit rebounding efforts to six games, after grabbing 10 boards against Waynesburg and 17 in the Thiel win ,,, Simmons and freshman Pat O'Connor tied for team scoring honors against the Tomcats with 14 points apiece, while Foster added 13 points and junior guard Rick Giordano dished out six assists.

The Grove City contest will be the final regular season home game for eight Bison seniors ... Bethany won a hard-fought 58-50 battle in Grove City Jan. 30, as the Green and White shot just 29 percent but forced 28 Wolverine turnovers.

The Titans won their first meeting with the Presidents this season, posting a 66-48 win over W&J in New Wilmington on Jan. 30 behind 18 points by sophomore guard Mike Hill.
