# JON KOCH Washington & Jefferson College

6-2 Senior Guard New Kensington, Pa. Plum H.S.

Koch earned the award for the second consecutive week after averaging 24.5 points, 5.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists per



game in a 1-1 week for the Presidents, while surpassing the 1,700-point career scoring mark. He posted a game-high 29 points in a 93-67 road PAC win at Thomas More, then posted 20 points, eight rebounds and five assists (including a game-tying three-pointer with 53 seconds left) in a 79-76 home loss to PAC leader Bethany.

Also nominated was senior G/F **Chris Stephens** of Bethany, junior G **Shawn Carr** of Grove City, senior F **Geno Bianco** of Thiel, and senior G/F **Dom Joseph** of Westminster.

# Bethany Bison

Bethany stayed atop the PAC with wins over Waynesburg and W&J last week ... The Bison used a 49-32 rebounding advantage and five players scoring in double figures to post an 80-68 triumph over the Yellow Jackets ... **Ryan** 

**Besancon** had his fifth double-double with 17 points and 10 rebounds and **Brody Jackson** totaled 16 points and seven boards in BC's 10<sup>th</sup> straight win over Waynesburg ... The 79-76 victory over W&J was Bethany's sixth in a row over the Presidents ... **James Wallace** broke a 75-75 tie with a bucket with 23 seconds left, then **Chris Stephens** hit two free throws with eight seconds to play ... Stephens scored a season-high 18 points and had six assists, while Wallace (16) and **Marcus Adams** (14) also hit double digits.



# **Grove City Wolverines**

Grove City dropped a pair of games last week, including a 12-point home loss to Westminster Wednesday ... GCC held Westminster to a season-low 71 points, but the Wolverines shot just 29 percent from the field in the second

half ... **Shawn Carr** tied a school record with six three-point goals as all 23 of his points came in the first half ... Grove City had not lost at home to Westminster since 2002 ... Carr again drained six threes Saturday night but Grove City's comeback effort at Saint Vincent fell short ... Carr finished with 21 points ... **Craig Hallman** posted a 14-point, 14-rebound double-double, while **Ryan Gibson** contributed 12 points and six assists ... The Wolverines out-rebounded SVC 39-35 ... It was Grove City's first trip to Latrobe since 1982.



#### Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats' losing streak was extended to 10 games with losses against St. Vincent and Thomas More ... Cory Chaffee led the Tomcats with 21 points against Saint Vincent while Joe Herrmann and Geno Bianco chipped in with 17 and 15 points, respectively ... Bianco also

grabbed 11 rebounds ... Against Thomas More, Bianco scored 17 while Herrmann scored 16 ... Coming off the bench, Bianco, a senior, shot 14-of-25 from the floor in the Tomcats' last two games for 32 points ... He also grabbed 18 rebounds.



#### Thomas More Saints

Thomas More eclipsed last season's win total with a 71-64 victory over Thiel, marking the fourth straight win

over the Tomcats ... Sophomore **Brandon Bolden** scored a season-high 17 points on 4-of-5 shooting in 24 minutes ... Junior **Brad Buckner** added his second double-double of the season with 11 points and 10 rebounds, while freshman **Romell Salone** added 14 points ... The Saints went 22-for-29 at the charity stripe ... Sophomore **Matt Tierney** and Salone each scored nine points as the Saints fell to W&J ... Salone added a team-high four assists.



# Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J can clinch the No. 3 seed for the upcoming PAC Tournament with a victory over Grove City Wednesday ... One more victory will also clinch the school's most victories since the 1997-98 season ... W&J has posted 10 wins three times since that year ... The Presidents opened the week with a victory at Thomas More as senior Gs

Jon Koch (29) and Brandon Studer (25) combined for 54 points in the win ... The victory marked W&J's first three-game road win streak since the 1993-94 season ... W&J rallied from a 16-pont first half deficit to tie Bethany in the final minute Saturday before the Bison pulled out the win ... Sophomore F Wahab Owolabi scored 20 of his game-high 26 points in the first half and added 11 rebounds ... Koch added 20 points, eight rebounds and five assists.



# Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets suffered a pair of losses last week from the top two teams in the conference standings, fall at both Bethany (80-68) and in overtime at Westminster (84-82) ... At halftime against the Bison, Waynesburg

trailed 40-37 and the game remained in single-digits for most of the second half ... Senior G **Beau Wilson** led the team with 16 points, six rebounds and five steals, while classmate **Jeff Nero** added 12 points, five boards and four steals ... The Yellow Jackets lost Saturday to the Titans when a field goal with six seconds left in overtime decided the contest ... Wilson and Nero each bucketed 18 points with Wilson hitting five treys and Nero collecting eight rebounds ... In the loss, senior G **Marc Lodovico** became the 31st player in school history to score 1,000 career points (1,012).



#### Westminster Titans

Westminster won its fourth game in a row by edging Waynesburg in overtime, 84-82, at home Saturday and defeating Grove City, 71-59, on the road Wednesday to remain a half game out of first place in the PAC ... The Titans scored a season-low 71 points in the win over GCC after losing to Grove City in a high-scoring affair, 101-91, in their previous meeting ... Junior G Craig Hannon led the Titans in scoring with 15 points ... Sophomore F Ryan Ricketts grabbed a career-high 11 rebounds ... Ricketts was the hero of the Waynesburg

game as he laid in the game-winner with six seconds left in overtime ... Senior G/F **Dom Joseph** led all scorers with 19 points to go with a game-high six assists ... Junior G/F **Chauncey Whitlow** was on fire from 3-point range as he scored 18 points on six 3-pointers.



#### Saint Vincent Bearcats

The Bearcats closed their home schedule by sweeping PAC rivals Thiel (77-63) and Grove City (84-74) last week ... Senior **Javille Brooks** was named to the ECAC Division II Honor Roll for the week ending February 4 ... Senior **Marc Duncan** starred on Senior Night against Grove

City, scoring a career-high 27 points ... Brooks added 20 markers, while **Raymar Byrd** grabbed a team-high eight rebounds off the bench in just 19 minutes of play ... Against, Thiel earlier in the week, Brooks scored 21 points while Duncan dished out eight assists and **Billy Bains** had six steals.

After hosting Saint Vincent Wednesday, Bethany will travel to Westminster Saturday for a game that will determine the PAC regular season champion ... First will be a rematch of the Jan. 24 thriller with Saint Vincent that BC won 107-105 in double overtime behind 33 points from Brody Jackson ... Saturday's clash between Bethany and Westminster will be the second time in the last four years the teams have faced off in the regular season finale with the regular season title on the line ... The Titans won the 2004 game that was played in Bethany 99-95 on their way to the PAC tournament championship.
