PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL CO-PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

MATT DRAHOS

Bethany College

6-6 Junior Forward Wheeling, W.Va./John Marshall H.S.

JOE HERRMANN Thiel College

6-5 Freshman Forward Jamestown, Pa./Jamestown H.S.

Drahos averaged 30.5 points and 16.0 rebounds per game for the Bison, who remained in first place in the PAC with wins over W&J (89-64) and Westminster (110-99). He posted new career-highs with 40 points and 19 rebounds in the win over the Titans.

Herrmann led the Tomcats to a 2-0 PAC week, their first conference wins of the season, by averaging 29.0 points, 9.5 rebounds and 4.0 assists per game in league victories over Westminster (119-114 in OT) and Waynesburg (78-76). He posted a career-high 44 points (PAC season-high and third highest all-time at Thiel) against Westminster, tying the school single game field goal record by shooting 21-of-26 from the field.

Also nominated was senior C **Phil Bushre** of Grove City, freshman C **Tony Lewis** of Washington & Jefferson, and senior G **Ed Pagley** of Westminster.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

Bethany has now posted seven straight wins, including two last week over conference foes W&J (89-64) and Westminster (110-99) ... Against Westminster, Matt Drahos exploded for career-highs in points (40) and rebounds (19) Twin brother Mike Drahos notched a double-double with 26 points and 11 rebounds as the men won for the second time this season over the Titans ... The Bison earned a measure of revenge in downing W&J, the only PAC team to date that has beaten Bethany (66-64 on Jan. 19 at W&J) ... Matt Drahos led all scorers with 21 points and a game-best 13 boards ... Scott Mezyk added 16 points - one shy of his career high - while Mike Drahos added 19 points and four assists.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Presidents dropped a pair of league contests last week, falling to Bethany, 89-64, and Grove City, 56-54 ... The Bison ran out to an early 10-0 lead, but the Presidents closed to with two points at the 12:02 mark before another 10-0 BC run helped Bethany hold a large enough cushion for the rest of the game ... Sophomore G Brandon Studer led W&J with 12 points on 4-of-6 shooting, while freshman C Tony Lewis made 5-of-6 shots for 10 points ... A Phil Bushre layup with 37 seconds remaining proved to be the difference on Saturday for Grove City in a three-point victory ... Studer led all scorers with 15 points on 5-of-13 shooting and Lewis added 13 points and three boards in 14 minutes ... Freshman G Tyler Trutza dished out six assists.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City remained in second place in the PAC by earning a pair of wins last week ... Freshman Shawn Carr fired in a career-high 21 points Wednesday as Grove City rolled past Waynesburg ... The win was Grove City's 12th straight when scoring at least 90 points in a regulation game ... Phil Bushre added a 15-point, 12-rebound double-double while Ryan Eller added 12 points ... Saturday at W&J, Bushre scored the eventual gamewinner with 37 seconds left, breaking a 54-54 tie ... He and Eller each had 14 points for Grove City, which trailed by as many as 11 in the first half ... Eller moved into 19th place on Grove City's all-time scoring list with 1,031 points ... Bushre now has 910 career points.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg fell to Grove City, 93-79, and Thiel, 78-76, last week, extending its losing streak to six games ... The Yellow Jackets received 20 points from sophomore F Jeff Nero and freshman reserve G Jered Gamble in the loss to the Wolverines ... Gamble scored his career-high 20 points in a career-best 21 minutes off the bench ... Nero scored his 20 points on 7-of-14 attempts from the field, including 6-of-12 from three-point range ... Nero has scored 20+ points four times this season and reached double digits 14 times ... Waynesburg lost to Thiel when a potential game-winning shot occurred after the end of regulation ... Nero and guards Ray Gillespie and Beau Wilson all scored a team-high 13 points in the loss.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats strung together a pair of wins for only the second time this season, downing Westminster at home in overtime 119-114 Wednesday before beating Waynesburg 78-76 on the road Saturday ... Freshman F Joe Herrmann poured in a career-high 44 points against Westminster, tying the school record for most field goals in one game with 21 ... His 44 points are the third-most tallied in a single game in program records ... He added 12 rebounds and dished out five assists ... The 119 points scored is the third-most in a single game in program history ... Junior G C.J. Hunt knocked down a three-pointer with seven seconds to go in the game to push the Tomcats past Waynesburg.

Westminster Titans

The Titans dropped a pair of PAC road contests last week, falling at Thiel 119-114 in OT Wednesday and at Bethany 110-99 Saturday ... Westminster overcame a 16-point deficit with eight minutes to play to lead by three (99-96) in the final seconds at Thiel, but Tomcat freshman F Joe Herrmann hit a threepointer with one second left to send the game to overtime (99-99) ... Freshman G Nick DiNatale led the Blue & White with 24 points on 8-of-13 accuracy from three-point range ... Senior G Ed Pagley added 23 points on six treys, while junior F Dom Joseph added 16 points and a game-high 13 rebounds ... Pagley led six Titan double-digit scorers at Bethany with 19 points, including five three-pointers.

Upcoming Game Notes: Bethany goes into the week looking to earn their first PAC championship in **Aaron Huffman**'s three-year tenure at the school ... The Bison men last claimed the PAC title in 2002 under then-head coach **Rob Clune** ... Twin brothers **Matt** and **Mike Drahos** are averaging an identical 21.1 points per game in conference play ... Matt does hold a slight advantage over his brother in the rebounding department, notching 11.3 caroms per game compared to Mike's 9.8 ... Matt was honored by <u>D3hoops.com</u> on its National Team of the Week thanks to his 28.5 points and 16.5 rebounds per game last week.

The Yellow Jackets shot a season-best 56 percent in a 113-98 loss in the first meeting.
