Wilcox led the Bison to a pair of PAC victories last week, including a road win at Thiel which allowed the Bison to take over the top spot in the PAC standings from the Tomcats. For the week, he averaged 15.5 points, 8.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 2.5 steals per game. Wilcox had 13 points in Bethany's 75-44 win over Waynesburg Wednesday, then recorded 18 points, 12 rebounds, four assists and three steals in a 70-67 road victory over Thiel Saturday, which snapped the Tomcats' 19-game regular season home winning streak.

Also nominated was senior G **Brett Matson** of Grove City, junior G **Chris Klimchock** of Saint Vincent, junior G **Anthony Harvey** of Thiel, junior PG **Ben Altmeyer** of Waynesburg, and sophomore G **Anthony Thomas** of Westminster.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2011-12 - Week 12 Conference Notes

BISON ON TOP: As we enter the final week of the 2011-12 regular season, the race for the top tournament seeds remains tight ... Defending PAC champion Bethany is now in control of the top spot, following a 70-67 Bison road win at Thiel Saturday ... Thomas More and Saint Vincent have each locked up quarterfinal home games on Feb. 21 and will face each other in a key game Wednesday in Kentucky, before SVC hosts Bethany Saturday to finalize tournament seeding.

NEWS & NOTES: Thomas More junior SF **Phil Feinberg** averaged a double-double for 2-0 Thomas More (which has won seven straight) with 19.5 ppg and 10.0 rpg ... Bethany junior F **Nick Wilcox** averaged 15.5 points and 8.0 rebounds during the Bison's 2-0 week ... Junior PG **Chris Klimchock** averaged 15.0 ppg, 3.0 rpg and 4.0 apg for 2-0 Saint Vincent, which has won six straight ... Grove City senior G **Brett Matson** had a near triple-double with 22 points, 10 rebounds and seven assists in a GCC win at W&J.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Junior G **Anthony Harvey** averaged 18.5 ppg for 1-1 Thiel, including going 17-of-18 at the free throw line ... Junior G **Zach Bellhy** bucketed 21.5 ppg on the week for 0-2 Washington & Jefferson ... Junior F **Matt Lorello** averaged 18.0 ppg for 0-2 Geneva ... Junior PG **Ben Altmeyer** averaged 11.0 ppg for 0-2 Waynesburg, including 17 markers against Thomas More ... Sophomore G **Anthony Thomas** also bucketed 17 points for Westminster in a loss to Thomas More.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (20-3, 12-2 PAC)



Bethany moved into first place in the PAC with two road wins last week and now has 20 wins in a year for the fifth time in program history ... The Bison led Waynesburg 34-32 with 17 minutes left before BC outscored the Jackets 41-12 the rest of the way to register a 75-44 victory, their 20th straight over Waynesburg ... **James Barton** had 13 of his 18 in the second half and **Brady Pacific** and **Nick Wilcox** both scored 13 ... In a first place showdown at Thiel, the Tomcats led Bethany 50-37 in the second half, but a 23-4 BC run helped propel the Bison to a 70-67 victory ... Wilcox led the way with 18 points and 12 rebounds, while Pacific tallied 16 ... **British Alexander** returned after missing two games to total 12 points, 11 boards and three blocks in the Bison victory.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (5-17, 4-10 PAC)



Geneva men's basketball dropped a pair of PAC games last week to Thiel and Saint Vincent, two of the conference's top clubs ... The Golden Tornadoes led most of the night against the Tomcats but couldn't close the deal in the second half, as Geneva suffered a 78-75 loss despite another double-double from **Matt Lorello** with 20 points and 10 rebounds ... Lorello scored 16 points in a 76-56 loss to Saint Vincent on Saturday night ... Geneva sits with a 5-17 overall record and a 4-10 mark in league play ... Currently tied with Westminster for the sixth spot in the PAC standings, Geneva will host the Titans on Saturday night in a game that could ultimately decide the sixth seed for next week's PAC tournament.

Grove City Wolverines (10-12, 6-8 PAC)



Grove City earned its third straight PAC win Saturday afternoon by rolling to an 87-67 victory at W&J ... **Kris Verderber** tied a career-high with 23 points and **Brett Matson** recorded a near triple-double with 22 points, 10 rebounds and seven assists ... GCC used a 43-14 run in the first half to break open the game ... **Christian Durbin** recorded a career-high seven assists ... Matson moved into 23rd place on Grove City's all-time scoring list with 1,043 points ... The 20-point win marked the Wolverines' largest margin of victory in a road conference game since a 71-50 win at Thiel February 21, 2009 ... Grove City and W&J split their regular-season series for the second straight season ... Grove City hosts Waynesburg Wednesday night in the home finale before visiting Thiel Saturday to close out the regular season.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (18-5, 11-3 PAC)



The Bearcats have won six straight and 10 of their last 11 games after posting a pair of wins last week ... Wednesday at W&J, SVC hit a season-high 12 three-pointers, including six from junior G **Chris Klimchock** ... With the Bearcats leading by four at the half, Klimchock made three-straight triples to begin the second half and open up the eventually 77-62 win ... Three other Bearcats scored in double figures ... In Saturday's 76-56 win over Geneva, senior G **Dennis Bassich** led the team with 15 points while sophomore F **Dillon Stith** added 14 ... Freshman F **Sean Kett** came off the bench to post a season-best 13 points with six boards and four steals.

Thiel Tomcats (15-7, 12-3 PAC)



The Tomcats fell out of first place in the regular season for the first time in two seasons as they split a pair of games winning at Geneva 78-75, before falling at home to Bethany 70-67 ... The Tomcats erased a 13-point second half deficit to come from behind and defeat the GTs ... A trio of Tomcats led the way as junior F **Blair Rozenblad** notched 20 points and nine rebounds; senior G **Devon Adams** added 19 points; and junior G **Anthony Harvey** added 16 points, including a 14-of-15 day at the free-throw line, making the most free throws by a Tomcat player since the 2007 season ... In the second contest, the Tomcats dropped a regular season home contest for the first time in 19 games when they were defeated 70-67 by Bethany ... Harvey led the way again for the Tomcats with a season-high 21 points.

Thomas More Saints (17-7, 12-3 PAC)



Thomas More extended its season-high win streak to seven games as it defeated Westminster and Waynesburg both on the road last week ... Junior SF **Phil Feinberg** averaged a double-double last week as he averaged 19.5 points per game and 10.0 rebounds per game ... Senior C **Colt Stafford** just missed averaging a double-double with 16.5 ppg, and 9.5 rpg ... Junior PG **Ryan Hamm** averaged in double-figure scoring last week as he averaged 10.5 ppg. ... For the season, Feinberg leads the team in scoring and rebounding as he averages 14.6 ppg, and 8.2 rpg ... Through 24 games, the Saints have a +6.5 scoring margin as they average 75.6 points per game and hold the opposition to 69.1 points per game ... Thomas More is shooting 47.1 percent from the field (622-of-1,320).

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (6-17, 2-12 PAC)



Washington & Jefferson lost two home PAC contests to Saint Vincent (77-62) and Grove City (87-67) last week ... The Presidents have lost eight-straight games for the first time since the end of the 2003-04 season ... Junior **Zach Bellhy** paced W&J with 19 points against Saint Vincent ... Senior **Uchenna Okocha** grabbed eight rebounds and dished out three assists ... Bellhy tallied 24 points to lead the Presidents versus Grove City ... Freshman G **Andy Carter** recorded 14 points and 10 rebounds for his second double-double of the year.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (4-19, 1-13 PAC)



Waynesburg dropped a pair of home contests to two of the top teams in the PAC ... Following a 75-44 loss to Bethany Wednesday, the Yellow Jackets gave Thomas More a terrific fight Saturday before the Saints completed a 69-60 victory ... The Yellow Jackets trailed Bethany by just two points early in the second half, but the Bison were able to pull away with several big runs down the stretch ... The story was a similar one during Saturday's tilt as Waynesburg trailed the Saints by two points (44-42) with 13:40 left to play ... The Yellow Jackets actually out-scored Thomas More 57-44 from the floor, but the Saints knocked down 25 free throws, while the Jackets made just three ... Junior PG **Ben Altmeyer** averaged a team-high 11.0 points per game and poured in a team-high 17 points against Thomas More.

Westminster Titans (5-17, 4-10 PAC)



Missed opportunities in the second half overshadowed its highest shooting performance of the year as the Westminster men's basketball team lost to Thomas More 75-71 Wednesday ... A missed free throw and two turnovers with under a minute and a half in the second half stalled the Titans, who shot 52.7% (29-for-55) from the floor ... Sophomore **Anthony Thomas** led Westminster with 17 points, while shooting 8-for-12 from the floor ... Junior **Ron Martino** followed with 14 points (6-for-11) to go along with a team-high three steals ... Also scoring in double digits were junior **Adam Carswell** and senior **Max Spinner**, who earned 13 and 11 points, respectively.
