He posted 17 points and five blocks against the Bearcats at Saint Vincent, before tallying his fifth double-double of the season with 25 points and 13 boards in the home victory over the Saints.

Also nominated was senior F **Luke Tomaselli** of Grove City, junior G **Dennis Bassich** of Saint Vincent, senior F **Lance Randall** of Thiel, senior SG **Aaron Miller** of Thomas More, senior G **Paul Matthews** of Washington & Jefferson, junior F **Jeff Young** of Waynesburg, and sophomore G **Doug Smith** of Westminster.

THIEL CLINCHES #1 SEED: The Thiel Tomcats earned at least a share of the 2010-11 PAC regular season title and also clinched the top seed and home court advantage throughout next week's PAC Tournament last week ... The Tomcats went 2-0, including an 80-64 road win at Westminster Saturday, to secure the top spot ... Bethany is in the driver's seat for the #2 seed following an 87-82 win at Thomas More Saturday, while the Saints are currently tied with Saint Vincent for the #3 seed.

NEWS & NOTES: Thiel senior F **Lance Randall** scored a career-high 23 points for the Tomcats in their PAC-clinching win at Westminster ... Geneva senior F **Richard Colick** continues to shine for Geneva, as he averaged 21.5 ppg in a pair of GT victories last week ... Junior G **Dennis Bassich** averaged 19.5 ppg and 5.5 rpg for 1-1 Saint Vincent, including 28 points in a win at Waynesburg ... Senior SG **Aaron Miller** averaged 17.5 ppg, 7.0 rpg, 3.5 spg and 2.5 apg for 1-1 Thomas More.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: **James Barton** scored 21 points, including 5-of-5 accuracy from three-point range, for Bethany vs. Thomas More ... Senior F **Luke Tomaselli** of Grove City scored a career-high 28 points in a loss to Geneva Saturday ... Senior G **Paul Matthews** posted 15 points and six rebounds for W&J in a win over Westminster ... Junior F **Jeff Young** averaged 15.5 ppg and 3.0 spg last week for 0-2 Waynesburg ... Sophomore G **Doug Smith** averaged 13.0 ppg for 0-2 Westminster.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (17-6, 10-3 PAC)



The Bison won a pair of tough games last week to tighten their grip on second place in the PAC ... Bethany led Saint Vincent by 17 at half, but the Bearcats trimmed it to 60-57 with two minutes to play before BC iced the win from the foul line ... **James Barton** led all scorers with 19, while **British Alexander** tallied 17, **Reece Mabery** totaled 13 points and six steals and Nick Wilcox had 12 points and 11 rebounds ... Saturday, Bethany overcame losing a 19-point first-half lead and a season-high 25 turnovers to escape with an 87-82 win over Thomas More ... The Bison shot 59 percent (30-51) and dominated the glass by a 42-24 margin ... Alexander notched his 5th double-double of the year with a season-high 25 points and 13 boards, while Wilcox compiled 16 points, six rebounds and three assists.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (17-6)



Richard Colick could easily be considered the PAC men's basketball player of the year ... He won't win that distinction because of Geneva's D-III provisional status, but Colick stepped up big time again this past week with a pair of solid performances ... On 9-of-13 shooting Monday, Colick posted 23 points in Geneva's 84-62 victory over Penn State Beaver ... Saturday, the Golden Tornadoes escaped a frantic Grove City rally for a 61-58 victory ... Colick scored 20 points in the victory, including six of the last eight points and a perfect 7-of-7 from the foul line ... **Lambros Svingos** chipped in with his second double-double of the season with 11 points and 14 rebounds against Grove City ... Geneva takes a 17-6 overall record into the final week of the regular season.

Grove City Wolverines (5-18, 2-10 PAC)



Grove City came within a whisker of stunning Geneva Saturday on Hall of Fame Day in the Grove City College Arena ... Senior **Luke Tomaselli** scored a career-high 28 points for the Wolverines, who had just eight turnovers ... Freshman **Matt Roush** scored a season-best eight points in 20 minutes of action ... Wednesday, the Wolverines fell at Thiel, 70-36 ... A slow start hampered the Wolverines ... **Steve Battaglia** made his first start of the season Wednesday ... Eleven different Wolverines have started a game this year ... That's the most since the 1997-98 team used 11 different starters ... Grove City can clinch the No. 6 seed in next week's PAC Tournament with a pair of wins this week ... A win over Westminster and a W&J win over Waynesburg would also give the Wolverines the sixth seed.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (16-7, 8-4 PAC)



The Bearcats went 1-1 on the week, falling 65-57 to Bethany Wednesday before regrouping with an 82-62 road win at Waynesburg Saturday ... In the Bethany contest, SVC was down 35-18 at half-time, before mounting a rally to pull to within three (60-57) with two minutes left ... The comeback stalled, however, as Bethany scored the game's final five points at the line ... **BJ McGill** led SVC with 14 points, while **Tauvon Pettiford** scored 13 and **Dennis Bassich** 11, while **Grant Latus** grabbed 10 rebounds with four blocks ... At Waynesburg, the Bearcats again trailed at the half, 33-32, before erupting to out-score the 'Jackets 50-29 over the game's final 20 minutes ... Bassich tied a career-high with 28 points, while Pettiford posted a double-double with 18 points and 12 rebounds in the victory.

Thiel Tomcats (17-6, 12-1 PAC)



Thiel clinched the regular season PAC title and home court advantage throughout the PAC tournament with a 2-0 week last week ... The Tomcats had a decisive 70-36 victory over visiting Grove City Wednesday ... Senior G **Devon Adams** scored 19 points in just 23 minutes of play and sophomore G **Anthony Harvey** added 13 ... Balanced scoring was key, as 11 players posted points in the score book ... Freshman G **John Pecchia** added 10 points off the bench ... As a team, the defense had one of the most solid performances in the history of the program as they held Grove City to just 11 field goals and 36 points, the lowest single-game point total allowed by the team since 1998 ... In game two of the week, Thiel again won comfortably as they defeated Westminster 80-64.

Thomas More Saints (12-11, 8-4 PAC)



Thomas More split a pair of PAC games last week as it defeated Waynesburg, but fell to Bethany ... The Saints had four players average in double figures scoring last week as senior SG **Aaron Miller** averaged 17.5 points per game, junior C **Colt Stafford** averaged 15.0 ppg., junior PG **Daniel Whelan** averaged 14.0 ppg., and junior SG **Todd Krohman** averaged 12.0 ppg. ... Miller led the team on the boards with 7.0 rebounds per game, while Whelan led the team assists with eight, Stafford led the team on blocked shots with five and Krohman led the team in steals with eight ... For the season, the Saints are shooting 42.6 percent from the field on 589-of-1,383 shooting ... The Saints are led in scoring by Miller and Stafford, who are averaging 15.4 ppg., and 11.5 ppg., respectively.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (9-14, 6-6 PAC)



W&J evened its PAC record at 6-6 after sweeping the season series from Westminster following a 64-56 win Wednesday at the Henry Memorial Center ... Senior G **Paul Matthews** scored a team-high 15 points, including nine in the final five minutes to help W&J secure the win ... Four Presidents scored in double digits, including senior G **Brian Felker's** 13 ... Felker moved into seventh place on the college's all-time scoring list after upping his career total to 1,277 (108 games) ... Sophomores **Ben Cecchini** (13 points, seven rebounds) and **Zach Bellhy** (12 points, six rebounds) also helped the Presidents fight back from a seven-point halftime deficit.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (5-18, 2-11 PAC)



The Waynesburg University men's basketball team dropped a pair of games to conference opponents this past week ... After falling to Thomas More by the final score of 105-82 on Wednesday, the Yellow Jackets returned home on Saturday to face Saint Vincent ... The Jackets led at halftime, but couldn't put their opponents away as they fell 82-62 ... Junior F **Jeff Young** led all Waynesburg scorers by averaging 15.5 points per game ... He also added 4.5 rebounds per game and swiped a total of six steals ... Senior G **Steven Iser** and junior F **Lou Galante** added 10.5 points per game.

Westminster Titans (5-18, 2-11 PAC)



Westminster lost two PAC games last week, falling 64-56 at W&J Wednesday before suffering an 80-64 home setback to first-place Thiel Saturday ... Sophomore G **Doug Smith** averaged 13.0 points, junior F **Rob Briggs** averaged 10.0 points and 6.5 rebounds, freshman **Anthony Thomas** averaged 9.0 points and 5.5 assists and sophomore F **Adam Carswell** averaged 5.0 points and 7.0 rebounds ... In the loss to Thiel, sophomore G **Matt Shiner** made his second career start and scored a career-high 13 points to lead the Titans ... Westminster trailed by only two points at halftime vs. Thiel, but the Tomcats went on a 24-3 run early in the second half ... The Titans led W&J by nine points with 10 minutes remaining but the Presidents went on a game-ending 13-1 run ... Briggs led the Titans vs. W&J with 16 points and 10 rebounds.
