Rozenblad averaged

22.5 points and 9.0 rebounds last week, while leading Thiel to its seventh- and eighth-consecutive victories. He poured in 18 points against Grove City on Wednesday. The 6-4 freshman guard notched his 14th 20-plus point outing and his eighth double-double of the season with 27 points and 11 rebounds against Westminster on Saturday.

Also nominated was senior F Joe Testa of Bethany, sophomore G Brett Matson of Grove City, senior PF Daniel McKeehan of Thomas More, senior G Albert Varacallo of Washington & Jefferson, junior G Erik Noone of Waynesburg, and senior F Ryne Murray of Westminster.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2009-10 - Week 13 Conference Notes

TOURNEY LOGJAM: Following the loss at home to Bethany, Thomas More is tied with Grove City for the No. 1 tourney spot, though the Wolverines have the head-to-head tiebreaker in their favor. GCC can safely clinch the No. 1 seed with a win at Westminster. The Saints still have a chance at the top spot, but needs a win over Thiel, plus a GCC loss to the Titans. While Bethany and Thiel are battling for the No. 3 and 4 right now but, withTMC & GCC losses, have a fighting chance at the top.

NEWS & NOTES: The only two seeds locked for the PAC tournament are the No. 6 seed (Westminster) and No. 7 seed (Waynesburg). The Tomcats' current eight-game streak ties the program record for consecutive victories set during the 1939-40 season. Geneva remains one victory shy of clinching a .500 season, which in turn qualifies it for the NCCAA post-season. TMC has three averaging double-figure scoring: Daniel McKeehan (15.4), Aaron Miller (12.9), Daniel Neeley (10.3).

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Westminster's Ryne Murray moved into ninth place on Westminster's all-time career scoring list with 1,469 points following the game versus Thiel. For the week, Murray shot an impressive 14-24 from 3-point range as he made six 3-pointers before finishing with 24 points vs. W&J. Thiel's Sean Devinney poured in a career-high 30 points — including a perfect 10-for-10 from the free throw line — and dished out a game-high tying three assists against Westminster.

Bethany Bison (15-7, 7-4 PAC)

Due to last week's winter storms, the Bison played just one game, as

their match-up with Saint Vincent was pushed back to Feb. 15 ... Bethany travelled to firstplace Thomas More Saturday and came out with a 91-75 victory, snapping a 4-game losing streak to the Saints...After taking a 3-point halftime lead, BC shot 59 percent in the second half to pull away and led by as many as 23 ... F Joe Testa posted a huge game with 19 points and 13 rebounds for his eighth doubledouble of the season and added a career-high 5 assists and 3 steals...Nick Wilcox was big as well, with 14 of his 17 points coming in the second half, and he chipped in with 7 rebounds, a career-high 6 steals and 5 assists...Jay Lyonett (15) and James Barton (13) also reached double digits for the Bison.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (6-16)

The Bearcats went 1-1 on the week, falling 72-52 to Geneva

on Monday before regrouping for a 51-49 win over Waynesburg on Saturday, as freshman Armani Fountain hit a lay up with under two seconds left to snap the Bearcats' nine-game losing streak...BJ McGill led the Bearcats with 16 points, to go with eight rebounds and six steals, while Stephon Berry grabbed a gamehigh nine boards...In the Bearcats' loss to Geneva on Monday, McGill scored 27 points, including a 10-11 showing at the foul line, but the remainder of the SVC offense struggled, as the team shot just 26 percent from the floor (15-58)...The Bearcats' Wednesday night contest at Bethany was postponed to this Monday (Feb. 15th) due to snow.

Washington & Jefferson **Presidents** (10-13, 5-5 PAC)



The Washington & Jefferson College men's basketball earned a key 61-60 victory

over Westminster Thursday in New Wilmington ... After forcing a turnover with 29 seconds left, W&J's Paul Matthews was fouled and knocked down both free throws to lift the Presidents' to the one-point conference victory ... The Presidents are first in the PAC and third in the nation in free throw shooting, connecting on 80 percent (444-of-555) of their attempts from the line ... W&J still maintains a chance to host a PAC Tournament Quarterfinal game with victories over Waynesburg and Bethany this week.
