PAC Men's Basketball Player of the Week

KEITH SCHUBERT Bethany College

6-4 Senior Forward Girard, Ohio/Girard H.S.

Schubert earned PAC Player of the Week honors for a league-best fifth time this week, as he led the Bison to the top regular season record in the PAC and the top seed for this week's PAC Tournament. He averaged 31.5 points and 8.0 rebounds per game last week, as Bethany went 2-0 with home wins over Thiel (75-59) and Grove City (96-91 in overtime). His 43 points in the overtime win over Grove City was the second-highest single game scoring total in school history. He also became the first player in Bethany history to surpass the 2,000-career point plateau, finishing the regular season with 2,009 career points. He also broke the school record for points in a season with 641, previously set by **Bill Gallagher** (633 in 1988-89).

Also nominated was junior forward **A.H. Davis** of Thiel, junior guard **Nolan Larry** of Washington & Jefferson and junior guard **Ray Robinson** of Waynesburg.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

Bethany wrapped up the regular season and tied the College record for single-season wins with a pair of victories ... In the Thiel win, which sealed the #1 seed in the PAC Tournament, guard Nevada Smith tallied 18 of his 24 points in the second half as Bethany pulled away for a 75-59 victory ... Guard Scott Johnson (eight points, 12 rebounds, six assists) and forward Todd McGuinness (eight points, eight rebounds and four assists) also had solid games ... In a thrilling come-from-behind win over Grove City, forward Keith Schubert carried the Bison to the triumph ... He scored 31 points, including 16 in the final five minutes, in the second half. Included in that were three free throws with eight seconds left in regulation that sent the game to OT.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J concluded its regular-season schedule with a 65-63 victory over Westminster on Saturday ... The win marked just the 16th victory in 55 all-time meetings versus the Titans ... The Presidents fought back from a 17-point second-half deficit ... Nolan Larry scored 17 of his game-high 20 points in the second half, including four three-pointers ... W&J fell 86-71 to Waynesburg on Wednesday ... The Presidents held an early 22-16 lead, but an 11-0 run to end the half for the Yellow Jackets gave WC a 43-32 halftime advantage ... Larry led W&J with 19 points, while Scott Chodor netted 16 ... Mike Drevitch added 10 points on 3-of-6 three-point shooting ... LaRoche evened the season series with W&J on Monday by defeating the Presidents, 80-64 ... Franz led W&J with 14 markers.

Grove City Wolverines

The third-seeded Wolverines will open the 2002 PAC Men's Basketball Championship Tournament at second-seeded Thiel on Thursday ... Grove City enters the tournament coming off back-to-back losses for the first time this season ... Sophomores Tanner Prosser and Jim Fetzner scored 13 points apiece in the Wolverines' 76-69 loss to Westminster last Wednesday ... Junior Andy Vlajkovich fired in a team-high 24 points in Saturday's overtime loss at Bethany, matching his career single-game high set early this year ... The Wolverines continue to rank among the nation's best in rebound margin (+12.0) and field-goal shooting defense (37.4 percent).

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Jackets will host Tuesday night the Washington & Jefferson Presidents in the preliminary game of the PAC Tournament ... With the double-overtime loss at Thiel College Saturday (95-91), the Jackets enter the tournament as the fourth seed ... Junior **Ray Robinson** led the Jackets with 23 points while four other Jackets reached double figures: **Rob Strcula** (15), **Mike King** (13), and **Ryan Vance** and **Aaron Ankrom** (12 each) ... The winner of the preliminary game will travel to Bethany on Thursday to face the Bison in the conference semifinals.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats have earned the second seed in the 2002 PAC Men's Basketball tournament, going 1-1 against PAC foes last week ... After suffering a 68-56 loss at Waynesburg on Jan. 30, the Tomcats welcomed the Yellow Jackets to Rissell-Beeghly on Feb. 16 for their final PAC contest and defeated the visitors 95-91 in double OT ... Junior forward Durrell Hackett scored a season-high 21 points while grabbing four rebounds ... Junior forward A.H. Davis scored all 17 of his points after halftime and finished with a season-hig 18 rebounds ... Thiel hit the boards well against Waynesburg, outrebounding the Yellow Jackets 51-40 ... Bethany topped Thiel 75-59 in the Tomcats' other game.

Westminster Titans

The Titans closed the 2001-02 season at 10-15 after splitting a pair of games against PAC opponents last week, topping Grove City 76-69 on Wednesday before falling at Washington & Jefferson 65-63 on Saturday ... Against the Wolverines, three true freshmen led the Titans in scoring: Pat O'Connor (careerhigh 23 points), Craig Bohyer (15) and Chris Hatch (nine) ... Westminster led W&J by 15 points at halftime (41-26) before succumbing to a second half Presidents rally ... Junior guard Jeff Simmons led Westminster with 14 points in the loss ... Junior center Greg Foster posted his fourth "double-double" of the season in the loss at W&J, posting 10 points and 13 rebounds.

Upcoming Game Notes: Bethany, who has won back-toback regular season titles for the first time since winning three in a row from 1965-68, has home-court advantage throughout the PAC Tournament ... The Bison swept each team in the league, with the exception of potential semifinal opponent Waynesburg, who beat Bethany at the buzzer on Feb. 9 ... The PAC did have a tournament back in 1992, on a trial basis, and the Bison won it, defeating Thiel and W&J ... The Conference still recognized the regular season leader as the league champion that season.

THIEL TOMCATS (11-14 Overall, 5-3 PAC) vs. Grove City (2/21 - 7:30 p.m.)

Upcoming Game Notes: The Tomcats will enter the PAC Men's Basketball Tournament as the number two seed.
