Okocha led the Presidents to a 2-0 week to clinch the #7 seed for this week's PAC Tournament, averaging 14.5 points, 7.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists per game while shooting 59 percent (13-of-22) from the field in the two victories. He scored a career-high 18 points for W&J in an 89-73 victory over Geneva, before helping the Presidents to a 68-59 decision at Waynesburg.

Also nominated was senior G **Nick Wilcox** of Bethany, senior G **Brett Matson** of Grove City, junior F **Blair Rozenblad** of Thiel, junior PG **Ben Altmeyer** of Waynesburg, and sophomore G **Anthony Thomas** of Westminster.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2011-12 - Week 13 Conference Notes

TOURNEY TIME!: The seeding for the 2012 PAC Men's Basketball Championship Tournament is set following the conclusion of regular season play Saturday .. Defending PAC champion Bethany clinched the 2012 PAC regular season title with a road win at Saint Vincent and will have home court advantage throughout the tourney ... The tournament gets underway Monday night with the first-ever PAC Tournament #8/#9 "play-in" game with #9 Waynesburg at #8 Westminster at 7 p.m.

TOURNEY NEWS & NOTES: Thiel earned the tournament #2 seed tiebreaker over Thomas More via in-region strength-of-schedule by a mere .003 (.493-.490) ... Thomas More enters the tournament on a PAC-best eight-game win streak after a season-ending win over Saint Vincent behind 18 points from **Colt Stafford** ... Geneva, which will be playing in its first-ever PAC Tournament, went into the playoffs with the momentum of a 100-85 home win over rival Westminster behind 31 points by **David Phillips**.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Junior F **Nick Wilcox** helped Bethany clinch the top seed by averaging 15.5 ppg, 7.5 rpg, 5.0 spg and 4.0 apg in a 2-0 Bison week ... Junior F **AJ Forbes** nailed a three-pointer as time expired to lift Thiel to an 80-78 win vs. Grove City Saturday, which clinched the #2 seed for the Tomcats ... W&J was 2-0 on the week to clinch the #7 seed behind 14.5 ppg and 7.5 rpg by senior **Uchenna Okocha** ... Senior G **Brett Matson** averaged 21.0 ppg, 9.5 rpg and 4.0 apg for 1-1 Grove City.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (22-3, 14-2 PAC)



The Bison won a pair of games last week and clinched their first PAC regular season crown since 2007-08 ... Six players scored in double figures to lead BC to a 91-65 win over Westminster, Bethany's 10th straight win over the Titans ... **Brady Pacific** hit for 19 points off the bench and **Nick Wilcox** totaled 18 points, eight rebounds, six assists and four steals ... The Bison clinched the top seed and home court advantage in the PAC Tournament with a 76-64 win at Saint Vincent Saturday ... **Reece Mabery** tallied 16 of his 19 in the 1st half and Pacific recorded 14 of his 16 in the 2nd half in Bethany's 22nd win, which ties the school record for regular season victories ... Bethany shot 59 percent (27-46) in the win, including 50 percent (7-14) from the arc.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (6-19, 5-11 PAC)



It was a long time coming but Geneva put everything together Saturday night and the senior trio of **David Phillips**, **Lambros Svingos** and **Drew Santarsiero** lifted the Golden Tornadoes to a 100-85 victory over Westminster in the regular season finale ... The victory pushed Geneva's record to 6-19, including a 5-11 record in PAC play ... The GTs finished in sixth place and will travel to Kentucky Tuesday night to face Thomas More in a PAC tournament quarter-final match-up ... If Geneva gets the same effort from its seniors as it did on Saturday night, it could make for an interesting contest ... Geneva's senior trio combined for 74 of Geneva's 100 points on Saturday with Phillips scoring 31, Svingos posting 26 and Santarsiero scoring 17.

Grove City Wolverines (11-13, 7-9 PAC)



Grove City went 1-1 in PAC play last week, sewing up the No. 5 seed in this week's conference tournament ... Wednesday night, the Wolverines celebrated Senior Night with an 82-64 win over Waynesburg ... **Brett Matson** paced the Wolverines with 24 points and 11 rebounds in the win while **Mitch Marmelstein** added 14 points ... Grove City shot 52 percent (30-of-58) from the field for the game ... Prior to the game, GCC honored seniors Matson, **Cody Fleeger**, **Mike Grist** and **Kris Verderber** ... Saturday at Thiel, Grove City dropped to 7-9 in the league with an 80-78 setback ... Marmelstein led the Wolverines with 20 points ... Matson had 18 points and five assists while Verderber (11) and **J.T. Schwartz** (10) also scored in double figures ... Grove City shot 59 percent (17 of 28) from the field in the second half.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (18-7, 11-5 PAC)



SVC enters the PAC Tournament on a two-game slide, dropping contests at Thomas More and against Bethany last week ... On Wednesday, the Bearcats built a 14-point, second-half lead against the Saints despite wearing the hosts practice jerseys due to a wardrobe malfunction, but were unable to hold on ... Senior G **Dennis Bassich** and junior G **Chris Klimchock** each scored a game-high 24 points in the loss ... Klimchock again led the way on Saturday against Bethany, scoring a team-high 16 points in the loss ... Sophomore F **Dillon Stith** added 15 points and seven rebounds.

Thiel Tomcats (16-7, 13-3 PAC)



The Tomcats finished the regular season in thrilling fashion as they defeated PAC rival Grove City on a buzzer-beater by junior F **AJ Forbes** to win 80-78 ... Junior G **Anthony Harvey** led the way for the second straight game as he notched a season-high 22 points ... **Blair Rozenblad** added his 12th double-double and 9th in his last 10 contests, as he registered 16 points and 16 rebounds ... Also in double figures were senior G **Devon Adams** (15 points) and junior F **Ladell Trotty** (11 points) ... With the win, the Tomcats locked down the second seed in the upcoming PAC tournament.

Thomas More Saints (18-7, 13-3 PAC)



Thomas More extended its season-high winning streak to eight games as it defeated Saint Vincent, 81-74, in its regular season finale last Wednesday ... Senior C **Colt Stafford** led four Saints in double-figure scoring with 18 points ... Joining him in double-figures was senior PG **Daniel Whelan** and senior SG **Todd Krohman** with 11 points each and junior SF **Phil Feinberg** with 10 ... Stafford and Feinberg led the team on the boards as they each had seven rebounds, while Renken and Whelan led the team in assists with four each ... For the season, Feinberg leads the team in scoring and rebounding as he averages 14.4 ppg., and 8.2 rpg ... Through 25 games, the Saint have a +6.6 scoring margin as they average 75.8 points per game and hold the opposition to 69.3 points per game.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (8-17, 4-12 PAC)



W&J finished its regular season with victories over Geneva (89-73) and Waynesburg (68-59) last week ... W&J's 89 points were the most scored since posting 105 versus Penn State-Fayette on Dec. 7, 2010 ... Five players netted double figures against Geneva, led by senior **Uchenna Okocha's** career-high 19 points ... Freshman **Mike Resnik** scored 12 of his team-high 19 points during the second half ... Classmate **Andy Carter** contributed 15 points and a game-high seven rebounds ... The Presidents rallied from a five-point halftime deficit to defeat Waynesburg on Saturday ... W&J tied the game at 36 early in the second half and then took control with a 12-0 surge ... Carter netted 6-of-11 shots from the field and all six of his free throw attempts to pace W&J with 20 points.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (4-21, 1-15 PAC)



Waynesburg concluded the 2011-12 regular season with a road loss to Grove City and a home defeat vs. Washington & Jefferson ... Though the Yellow Jackets struggled most of the night at Grove City in an 82-64 loss, the tilt with W&J on Senior Night was much closer ... The Jackets led 29-24 at halftime, but fell behind shortly after the start of the second period and trailed by as many as 12 as the game wound down ... However, the home team fought back and pulled within three points with 6:01 to go before finally succumbing to the victors ... A trio of Jacket standouts averaged at least 10 points over the two contests, including PG **Ben Altmeyer**, who averaged a team-best 11.5 points per game ... His 3.0 assists per contest also paced Waynesburg ... Freshman F **Jason Propst** added 11.0 points per game.

Westminster Titans (6-19, 4-12 PAC)



The Titans ended their previous two-game losing streak by defeating Penn State Greater-Allegheny by the score of 78-59 in a great defensive effort ... The Westminster defense did not allow a three-pointer and scored 23 points off of 19 turnovers ... Ten Titans recorded points in the game, while four scored in double figures ... Against Bethany, the Titans stayed even through the first 10 minutes, until Bethany pulled away to a 91-65 victory ... **Anthony Thomas** scored a team-high 23 points in the contests while shooting 10-for-16 from the floor ... Junior **Adam Carswell** and **Ron Martino** added 13 and nine points, respectively ... In their 100-85 loss to Geneva, the Titans were led by career-high scoring performances from Thomas, who scored a team-high 27 points, and Martino, who contributed 19 points.

Bethany is the top seed for the fifth time in the 11-year history of the PAC Tournament ... The Bison will open tournament play Tuesday against the winner of the play-in game between Waynesburg & Westminster ... BC swept both teams this year and have lengthy winning streaks against Waynesburg (20 games) and Westminster (10 games) ... Bethany won the tournament last year by beating Westminster (90-58), Saint Vincent (66-65) and Thiel (74-67) to claim its 13th PAC title ... Last year's results give the Bison a 17-5 all-time record in the conference tourney, including a 14-1 mark at home ... The lone blemish on the Bethany home ledger was a 78-75 defeat to W&J in the 2007 semifinals.
