of wins last week and a share of the PAC regular season as he averaged 18.5 points and 4.0 rebounds per game, while also having six steals and four assists. In the win over Thiel he 20 points and five rebounds, while having one assists and four steals and then he had a game-high 17 points and pulled down three rebounds to go with two assists and three steals at Saint Vincent.

#### PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2009-10 - Week 14 Conference Notes

TOURNEY TIME: Heading into Saturday's contest, the top four tournament spot were up for grabs, however with a win over the Titans, Grove City prevailed as the No. 1 seed in the tournament. Bethany's win over W&J solidified their No. 3 seed, while Thiel's loss to the Saints earned them the No. 4 seed. Geneva earned a berth to the NCCAA regional tournament by finishing the season 14-11 and will host Roberts Wesleyan on Wednesday; if the GTs advance, they may host Nyack College.

NEWS & NOTES: Thomas More was ranked No. 6 in last week's NCAA Division III Great Lakes Regional Rankings, while also ranking first in steals in the nationally, averaging 14.2 per game. W&J ranked second among NCAA DIII teams in free throw percentage, and increased that production this week to 80.4. Saint Vincent's BJ McGill ended the year with 21.7 ppg, and became the school's 28th member of the 1,000-point club. He also was nationally-ranked first last week in steals with 3.8 spg.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Westminster's Ryne Murray moved into eighth place on Westminster's career scoring list with 1,513 points. For the season, Geneva's Rich Colick is averaging 18.4 ppg and sits just 21 points shy of 1,000 for his career. Thiel freshman Blair Rozenblad scored a game-high 24 points to finish the regular season with 24-consecutive double-digit scoring performances. GCC's 8-2 home record is the squad's best since the 1998-99 team went 8-1 en route to the league title.

and clinched the #3 seed in the PAC Tournament...Bethany pulled away in the 2nd half to record a 70-49 victory over Saint Vincent Monday night, as Nick Wilcox tossed in a teamhigh 16 points...James Barton also reached double digits with 11 markers and Jonas **Ankrom** finished with 9 points and 12 rebounds ... BC clinched the #3 seed and a home game in the PAC Quarterfinals by rallying from a 9point halftime deficit to defeat W&J 66-63 ... With 13 points and 8 rebounds, Joe Testa went over 1,200 career points (1,211) and 750 rebounds (753) ... Barton also tallied 13, while senior Ankrom (12) and Jay Lyonett (11) hit for double digits in their final regular season home game.

#### Saint Vincent Bearcats (6-19)

The Bearcats went 0-3 on a tough final week against the top three teams in the PAC...In Monday's 70-49 loss at Bethany, BJ McGill recorded the first double-double of his career, with 19 points and 10 rebounds, but the Bearcats shot just 31 percent (15-47) from the floor, including a 3-13 mark from long range...On Wednesday at Grove City, SVC fell 61-45, despite a career-high 14 points from Stephon Berry, coming via a 7-10 performance from the floor... Berry also added nine rebounds, while McGill scored 13 points...In Saturday's season finale, an 80-65 loss to Thomas More, Armani Fountain led four double-figure scorers for SVC with a career-high 15 points, while McGill added 14, Berry 12, and Alberto Benetti 10. Maurice Hawkins dished nine assists in his final game for the Bearcats.

#### Washington & Jefferson Presidents (11-14, 6-6 PAC)



Washington & Jefferson dropped a three-point decision to Bethany on Saturday and fell

to the No. 5 seed in the PAC Tournament ... The Presidents held a 10-point, second-half lead on the Bison, but **James Barton** scored eight of his 13 points in the second half, including a key three-pointer which gave the hosts the lead for good ... On Wednesday, junior guard **Paul Matthews** fired in 24 points and added nine rebounds as W&J eased past Waynesburg ... W&J hit 27-of-33 foul shots and 7-of-14 three-pointers ... Washington & Jefferson increased its free throw percentage, which ranked second in NCAA Division III last week, to 80.4 percent this week.

#### Geneva Golden Tornadoes (14-11)

post-season...The GTs did themselves one better by sweeping the week and finishing the regular season with a 14-11 overall record...As a result, Geneva will open NCCAA regional play this week and will host Roberts Weslevan in the east regional semi-finals on Wednesday of the upcoming week....The winner of the semifinal game will most likely face Nyack for the right to advance to the NCCAA national tournament...Rich Colick continued to establish himself as one of the finest players in the PAC with 19 points against Westminster and a season high 32 point effort in the victory at Waynesburg...For the season, Colick is averaging 18.4 ppg and sits just 21 points shy of 1.000 for his career.

#### Thiel Tomcats (14-10, 7-5 PAC)

The 6-4 guard has surpassed the 20-point mark 15 times this season... Sean Devinney ended up with 24 points and Devon Adams finished with 13... Alan George and Lance Randall each tossed in 11 points to round out Thiel's offensive leaders...Thiel was idle on Saturday.

#### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (2-21, 0-12 PAC)



The Waynesburg Univer-

sity men's basketball team ended their season with a road loss at Washington & Jefferson and a home defeat at the hands of Geneva... Senior guard Ryan Courneen was a bright spot for the Yellow Jackets, as he averaged a team-high 17.5 points per game over the two-contest stretch...His 24 points against W&J tied for the game high and was the highest individual scoring total for any Waynesburg player this season.

#### Grove City Wolverines (17-8, 9-3 PAC)



Grove City sewed up the top seed in the conference tourna-

ment Saturday by rolling past Westminster 69-47...Brett Matson and Drew Vandermeer both fired in 18 points each to pace the Wolverines ...Matson went 7-for-9 from the field while Vandermeer went 7-for-11...Grove City limited the Titans to one point over the final nine minutes...It is the team's first sweep of the Titans since 2002-03...Wednesday, the Wolverines charged past visiting SVC 61-45 on Senior Night...The win completes Grove City's first sweep of the Bearcats since 1976 ... In the win over Thiel, the Saints were led in scoring by McKeehan with 20 points and rebounding by junior forward Aaron Miller with nine boards... In the win at Saint Vincent, the Saints were once again led in scoring by McKeehan with a game-high 17 pints and were led on the boards by senior point guard Romell Salone with nine rebounds.

#### Westminster Titans (7-18, 3-9 PAC)



Westminster wrapped

up its regular season on a four-game losing streak after suffering two losses last week, an 89-84 setback at Geneva on Wednesday and a 69-47 loss at home to Grove City on Saturday...The Titans were within one point of Geneva with 52 seconds left and they were within three points of Grove City with 8:57 remaining...Senior F Ryne Murray led the Titans with 22.0 points and 9.5 rebounds per game, including 32 points and 11 rebounds at Geneva...Sophomore F Rob Briggs led the Titans with 13 points and nine rebounds, marking the second time this season that he led Westminster in scoring...Murray, who led the team in scoring for 15 of the last 17 games, scored 12 points and pulled down eight rebounds.

#### Washington & Jefferson **Presidents** at #4 Thiel (2/23)

Washington & Jefferson and Thiel meet for the 114th time in history, including the third PAC

Tournament meeting, on Tuesday in Greenville ... W&J leads the all-time series by an 80-33 margin, but the Tomcats snapped a 10-game losing skid to the Presidents with a 78-68 victory at the Henry Memorial Center on Jan. 30th ... On Dec. 12th, W&J won the game played at Greenville by a 78-65 margin ... Since that contest, W&J owns a 6-9 record, while the Tomcats have won 11 of 17 games ... #### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets at #2 Thomas More (2/23)

The Yellow Jackets will travel to Crestview Hills,

Ky. on Tuesday to face Thomas More in the first round of the PAC Championship tournament. If Waynesburg, the seventh-seed, can somehow upset the second-seeded Saints, it would not only avenge a pair of 20-plus point losses from this season, but it would also halt a five-game losing streak against Thomas More.

#### Westminster **Titans** at Bethany (2/23)

The Titans are 72-21 all-time vs. Bethany, including two losses this season, 85-67 at



home on Dec. 2 and 85-73 on the road Jan. 23. Westminster is playing on the road in the first round of the PAC tournament for the first time since it became eligible for the league crown in 2002-03. Last year, the Titans lost at Bethany, 71-67, in the semifinal round last year. Westminster has lost four straight games to the Bison and four straight at Bethany. The last time the Titans won at Bethany was 96-82 on Jan. 20, 2007.
