JOSH PARISI Waynesburg University

6-5 Senior Forward Ambridge, Pa. Ambridge H.S.

Parisi opened the 2007-08 season with a double-double, as he posted a careerhigh 25 points and 11 rebounds, along



with two assists and two steals for the Yellow Jackets in their 86-78 home win over Cabrini. Parisi was 10-of-16 from the field as he recorded his third career double-double.

Also nominated was senior G Brody Jackson of Bethany, senior G Shawn Carr of Grove City, freshman G Devon Adams of Thiel, junior G Matty Owens of Thomas More, sophomore G Albert Varacallo of Washington & Jefferson, and freshman G Max Spinner of Westminster.

Bethany Bison



Bethany opened the new season by taking third at the Mt. Aloysius Tournament ... In the first round, BC led by 7 with 2:42 to play, but Al-

legheny scored 11 straight points and before holding on for a 69-68 win ... Senior Brody Jackson drilled five treys and scored a game-high 22 ... He was joined in double figures by freshman Dakota Matz with 14 and junior Tyler Morando with 11 ... In Saturday's consolation game, the Bison trailed by one at halftime, but a 14-3 run midway through the second half gave Bethany a 14-point lead en route to a 108-96 triumph ... Junior Petre Petkovski led five in double digits with 26 ... Senior Marcus Adams set career-highs with 15 points, nine assists and six steals.

Saint Vincent Bearcats



The Bearcats won big in their season opener, defeating Penn State-Fayette 105-61 ... Six players scored in double figures, led by junior Tre'sor Kalambay, who

came off the bench for 17 points ... Freshman **B.J. McGill** and junior transfer **Joey Butler** each had strong Saint Vincent debuts, as both scored 10 points and dished out six assists ... Butler also led both sides with seven rebounds and five steals ... Sophomore **Mike Watkins** scored a careerhigh 13 points, while blocking two shots, in just 13 minutes of play ... As a team, SVC shot 53 percent from the field, out-rebounded the Lions 39-28, and forced 24 turnovers, while committing just nine.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents



Washington & Jefferson College split a pair of games at the Doc Greene Tournament hosted by Juniata during the opening weekend ... Sophomore G Albert Varacallo scored a

team-high 16 points in the opening night victory ... The win was the first for W&J in a season opener since the 2002-2003 season ... Junior F Wahab Owolabi added 12 points and 14 rebounds, while sophomore G Matt Drakeley netted 13 points on 5-of-10 shooting ... Freshman G Brian Felker rounded out four Presidents in double figures with 11 ... Felker and Owolabi both had 12 points in the loss to Juniata ... Varacallo also contributed 11 points and six rebounds.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes



Geneva split a pair of games at the Tornado Tip-Off Classic to start the 2007-08 season, as the GTs defeated Franciscan 106-77 be-

fore falling to Malone 83-70 ... **Greg McDivitt** was named to the All-Tournament team as Geneva's leading scorer.

Thiel Tomcats



Thiel went 1-1 at La Roche's Cron's Classic over the weekend ... The Tomcats suffered a 82-78 loss to Marymount (Va.) in the opening round Friday

before posting an 80-52 win over Penn State Beaver in the consolation game Saturday ... Five players finished in double figures against Marymount, led by sophomore G Nick Sefcsik's 13-point, five-rebound effort ... Junior G Brandon Mirizio, sophomore G Cory Chaffee and freshman G Devon Adams each added 12, while junior F Keebo Dowe scored 10 ... Freshman F Tommy Hall totaled seven points to go along with a gamehigh eight rebounds and a team-best four assists ... Adams and Dowe each tallied 13 in the win over Penn State-Beaver.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets



Senior F Josh Parisi posted a doubledouble with 25 points and 11 rebounds, as the Yellow Jackets claimed an 86-78 sea-

son-opening home win against Cabrini College Saturday ... Parisi made 10-of-16 attempts from the field and 5-of-9 from the free-throw line against the Cavaliers ... Junior G/F **Dan Happe** also registered a career high against Cabrini, scoring 23 points on 8-of-14 shots, including 7-of-12 from three-point range ... Senior G **Tim Drakeley** added 17 points and five rebounds in the victory ... The Yellow Jackets shot 47.5 percent (29-of-61) from the filed, including an impressive 46.2 percent (12-of-26) from beyond the arc.

Grove City Wolverines



The Wolverines opened the season last weekend at the Geneva Tip-Off Tournament ... Grove City bounced back from a loss to NAIA Malone

Friday night with a 77-60 win over Franciscan Saturday ... Shawn Carr led the way with 17 points against Franciscan while Joe McCoy, in his first career start, tossed in 15 points ... Carr shot 9-of-16 (56 percent) behind the three-point line during the tournament and averaged 15 points per game ... Eleven different GCC players scored against Franciscan, while 10 Wolverines scored against Malone ... It was the first time since 1991 that Grove City did not open the season with the West Penn Classic.

Thomas More Saints



On Friday night, Thomas More snapped a 30-game non-conference losing streak with a season-opening 84-75 win over

Anderson ... It was the first time since the 2004-05 opener that the Saints won their lid-lifting game ... Junior **Matty Owens** recorded career-highs in points (22) and rebounds (13) in the victory ... On the weekend, Owens averaged 15 points and 11.5 rebounds, while shooting 52 percent from the field ... Senior **Brad Buckner** added 14 points and 14 rebounds in the win ... Junior **Mark Tinklenberg** netted 19.0 points and 8.5 boards for the weekend, including a team-high 22 in the 65-59 loss to Defiance on Saturday.

Westminster Titans



Westminster dropped two three-point games to open the season as hosts of the 16th annual Buzz Ridl Classic ... The Titans lost, 82-79, vs. Bluffton Friday before losing to Eastern, 90-87, Saturday ... Freshman G Max Spinner was named to the all-tournament

team after scoring a career-high 21 points vs. Eastern, while senior G Craig Hannon bucketed a game-high 23 after scoring 18 vs. Bluffton ... Junior G David Richards led the Titans with 20 points in the Bluffton game ... The Titans trailed by as many as 16 in the first half vs. Bluffton before rallying, while vs. Eastern, Westminster led by as many as nine in the first half before surrendering runs of 9-0 and 10-0 in the second half.
