KEITH SCHUBERT - Bethany College

6-4 Senior Forward Girard, Ohio/Girard H.S.

ANDY VLAJKOVICH - Grove City College

6-0 Junior Guard Canfield, Ohio/Canfield H.S.

Schubert averaged 33.0 points and 7,0 rebounds as Bethany went 1-1 at the York Yournament. He scored 25 points on 11-of-18 shooting in a 92-72 win ober Gwynedd-Mercy, then tallied 41 markers on 14-of-26 shooting in a 90-84 loss to York.

Vlajkovich led the Wolverines to the team title at the 2001 West Penn Classic, while helping Grove City post its first 2-0 start since the 1988-89 season. He averaged 16.5 points and 4.0 assists in the two wins, including a career-high 24 points in the tournament title game against Carnegie Mellon.

Also nominated was junior forward **A.H. Davis** of Thiel, junior guard **Nolan Larry** of Washington & Jefferson, and junior guard **Ray Robinson** of Waynesburg.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bison took second at York's White Rose City Classic this weekend ... Forward Keith Schubert scored 25 points in the win over G-M, and came back with 41 markers in the York loss ... It's the second highest point total of his career ... The 6-4 senior tied a college record with 45 points in a double overtime victory at Ohio-Eastern on Dec. 14, 1999 ... Guard Nevada Smith fired in 23 points on 7-9 shooting from the arc in the victory over G-M, while Mike Majzun added 19 and Scott Johnson chipped in with 10 points and seven assists ... Center Derek Hoffman averaged 6.5 points and 9.5 rebounds in the two games.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J began the 2001-02 season with a pair of losses in the West Penn Classic ... In the loss to CMU on Friday, junior guard Nolan Larry scored 27 points and added eight rebounds, two assists and two steals ... The Presidents shot just under 40 percent from the floor and hit 7-of-15 three-point field goals ... On Saturday, Larry once again led W&J with 24 points on 7-of-20 shooting ... Sophomore center Tony Franz added 10 points and four boards for W&J ... The Presidents managed to shoot just 33.7 percent in the game, but made 20-of-27 foul shots ... W&J maintained a four-point lead on the Gators with 14 minutes left in the second half, however, AC went on a 15-0 run over the next four minutes to escape with the eight-point victory.

Grove City Wolverines

The Wolverines are 2-0 for the first time since the 1988-89 season ... Grove City shot 62% (13-21) from outside the arc at the 2001 West Penn Classic ... The Wolverines hit 8 of 11 threes against Allegheny to stop a six-game slide against the Gators ... Sophomore G lan Dean scored a team-high 15 against Allegheny and junior G Andy Vlajkovich netted a career-high 24 in the CMU win, hitting 4 of 6 threes ... Senior F Pat Roberts grabbed 21 rebounds in the two games ... Sophomore C Phil Bushre and sophomore F Tanner Prosser were named to the All-Tournament Team.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Junior guard **Ray Robinson** returned to lead the Jackets in scoring in the first two games ... Robinson, who sat out the 2000-2001 season, posted 41 points, eight rebounds, four steals and four assists while shooting 17-of-33 (51.5%) from the field in the two Waynesburg losses ... Junior center **Aaron Ankrom** was named to the All-Tournament team at the FSU Tip-Off Invitational ... Ankrom scored 33 points, recorded 16 rebounds, two blocks and five steals.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats were defeated by Texas Lutheran 82-81 Friday afternoon when TLU's **Zeke Rodriguez** hit two free throws with just 15 seconds remaining on the clock to give the Bulldogs the victory ... Junior forward **A.H. Davis** scored 22 points, 5 rebounds and 3 steals in Friday's loss to Texas Lutheran and had 31 points and five boards in Saturday's 93-76 consolation-game loss to St. Olaf (Minn.).

Westminster Titans

Westminster split a pair of games over the weekend at the Buzz Ridl Classic in New Wilmington, topping Notre Dame (OH) 74-62 in the opening round before falling to Geneva 63-54 in the title game ... The Titans led Geneva 32-19 at the half, but were victimized by 6-of-30 shooting (20.0%) in the second half as the Golden Tornadoes outscored Westminster 44-22 ... Sophomore F Andy Podbielski posted his first career "double double" with 14 points and 12 rebounds vs. Notre Dame, then grabbed a career-high 15 boards vs. Geneva ... Junior G Jeff Simmons bucketed a career-high 19 points against Geneva ... Both Simmons and Podbielski were named to the All-Tournament team.
