PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

BEAU WILSON

Waynesburg College

6-0 Junior Guard

Daybrook, W.Va./Clay-Battelle H.S.

Wilson averaged 28.0 points, 3.0 assists, 2.0 rebounds and 2.0 steals per game for Waynesburg this weekend, as the Yellow Jackets went 1-1 at the Mount Aloysius Tip-Off Tournament with a 95-89 win over Galludet followed by a 104-90 loss to the host school. He posted a career-high 35 points in the Galludet win before scoring 21 in the title game. Wilson shot 62 percent from the field (16-of-26), including 47 percent from three-point range (7-of-15) and 90 percent from the line (17-of-19) this weekend.

Also nominated was senior G **Scott Mezyk** of Bethany, senior G **Matt Phillips** of Grove City, senior F **Damien Williams** of Thiel, freshman F **Mark Krebs** of Thomas More, junior G **Jon Koch** of Washington & Jefferson, and senior G **Mark DeMonaco** of Westminster.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES



Bethany Bison

The Bison opened the season by taking second place at the Case Western Tip-Off Tournament ... BC earned a spot in the championship game with an 83-54 triumph over Adrian, which was one of four teams to beat Bethany last year ... **Matt Drahos** led four double-digit scorers with 25 points and added a game-high nine rebounds, while **Mike Drahos** contributed 17 points, seven rebounds and five assists ... PG **Scott Mezyk** gave out eight assists and Chris Stephens had a career-high six steals as well ... In the title game against Case, the Bison lost an 11-point lead over the final 3:45 and lost on a putback at the buzzer ... Mezyk hit five three-pointers for a team-best 15 points and also gave out five assists, en route to All-Tournament team honors.



Thiel Tomcats

Thiel opened its season at the four-team Capital Classic Saturday ... The Tomcats fell in their opening game 92-79 to Capital Friday and lost in the consolation game to Kenyon 92-90 Saturday ... Sophomore G **Ross Watson** and senior F **Damien Williams** paced the Tomcats with 14 points apiece against the Crusaders ... Freshman G **Pete Farley** totaled 11 points and five assists while sophomore F **Joe Herrmann** added 10 points ... In the consolation game, Kenyon's **Tyler Rehm** hit two free throws with one second left, breaking a 90-90 tie ... Thiel had five players in double figures, led by Williams, who finished with 17 points and five rebounds ... Farley totaled 16 points, and nine assists, while Herrmann added 14 points and eight rebounds.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J opened its season with losses to CMU and Allegheny at the West Penn Tip-Off Classic ... The Presidents fell behind by 10 points midway through the first half against CMU and the Tartans never looked back in recording the 28-point victory ... Junior G **Brandon Studer** netted 14 points, while backcourt mate **Jon Koch** added 12 points and seven rebounds ... Freshman C **Josip Lucic-Jozak** added 11 markers ... W&J held a five-point advantage with four minutes left Saturday, but the Gators managed to pull out the win in a game that featured 15 lead changes and 14 ties ... Koch poured in 23 points and grabbed nine rebounds, while Studer (16) and junior F **Matt Vorndran** (15) also scored in double figures ... W&J held a 39-37 rebound advantage and committed only 10 turnovers.



Westminster Titans

Westminster split a pair of contests to open the season at the annual Buzz Ridl Cassic, as the Titans topped Delaware Valley 129-125 in the opener before falling to Baldwin-Wallace 133-113 in the title game ... Senior G **Mark DeMonaco** drained a three-pointer with 13:22 to play in the first half Friday to become the 32nd player in the history of Titan basketball to reach 1,000 career points ... DeMonaco finished with a game-high 28 points, while sophomores **Craig Hannon** and **Brian Urso** added 27 and 26 against DVC (both career-highs) ... DeMonaco posted team-high totals of 26 points and six assists in the loss to B-W ... DeMonaco and senior G **Brian Fadden** (13.5 ppg, 5.5 apg over the weekend) were each tabbed to the Buzz Ridl Classic All-Tournament team.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City went 0-2 in the annual West Penn Classic this weekend ... Senior G **Matt Phillips** earned a spot on the All-Classic Team after averaging 13 points per game ... Sophomore G **Ryan Gerber** fired in a dozen points against CMU Saturday night, making all three of his three-point attempts ... Freshman G **Ryan Gibson** tossed in 10 points off the bench at CMU ... Gibson also had six assists ... The Wolverines were 7-of-13 behind the arc at CMU after a 3-for-16 effort Friday night against Allegheny ... Phillips had a team-high 15 points against Allegheny ... Grove City had won four straight against Allegheny ... This is Grove City's first 0-2 start since the 1996-97 season.



Thomas More Saints

Thomas More dropped a 99-95 overtime decision to host Anderson and an 81-63 loss to Defiance at the Anderson Tournament this weekend ... Freshman F **Mark Krebs** started his collegiate career with 27 points as Thomas More placed five players in double figures in the overtime loss to Anderson ... He finished with 32 points on the weekend and was named to the All-Tournament Team ... Junior C **E.J. Haynes** averaged 15 points and five rebounds in the tournament, while swatting away three shots.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg opened the 2005-2006 with a 95-89 season-opening win over Gallaudet (the first time the team has opened the season with a win since the 1999-2000 season) before losing to Mt. Aloysius in the championship game of the tournament hosted by the Mounties. ... The combined 185 points scored by the Yellow Jackets in their first two contests is their highest two-game output to start a season since 1998-99, when they scored 187, including a single-game school-record 128 in the opener ... Junior G **Beau Wilson** paced the Waynesburg offense this weekend scoring a combined 56 points, including a career-high 35 points in the opener over the Bison ... Wilson and junior F **Jeff Nero** each scored 21 points in the loss to the Mounties.

Bethany Bison

vs. Marietta (11/22 - 7 p.m.)
at CMU Tournament (11/26-27 - 1/3 p.m.)

Bethany opens its home schedule vs. Marietta Tuesday before heading to Pittsburgh to play in the Carnegie Mellon Tournament after the holiday ... Marietta leads the all-time series with Bethany 31-22, but the Bison won last year 109-98 behind double-doubles from **Mike** (22 pts., 13 rebs.) and **Matt** (22 pts., 10 rebs.) **Drahos** ... The first round matchup with Keystone Saturday will be the first between the teams, pitting two squads that both finished 24-4 last season ... BC will face either host CMU or Oberlin Sunday ... The Bison hosted Oberlin last year, posting a 96-69 win to improve to 8-5 all-time against the Yeomen.



Thiel Tomcats

at Indiana (Pa.) (11/21 - 7 p.m.)

The Tomcats step away from Division III competition to take on NCAA Division II member IUP Monday evening ... The Tomcats and the Indians have met 12 times prior to Monday with IUP holding a 11-1 advantage in the series ... Most recently, IUP downed Thiel 83-76 during the 2000-01 season.



Grove City Wolverines

at Penn State-Altoona (11/22 - 8 p.m.)

Grove City looks to pick up its first win of the season against Penn State Altoona ... The Cougars are coached by former Washington and Jefferson assistant **Alan Seretti** ... The teams have not played since Jan. 20, 2003, when Grove City earned a 75-62 win at home.



Thomas More Saints

at Emory & Henry Tournament
(11/26-27)

Emory & Henry runs the now-famed Grinnell style offense and is averaging 133 points per game through two contests ... Thomas More will be trying to avoid its first 0-3 start since 2000 ... It is the first match-up between the two schools.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

vs. Ohio Wesleyan (11/22 - 7 p.m.)

Washington & Jefferson and Ohio Wesleyan will meet for the first time in 54 years Tuesday ... W&J has won all three meetings in history ... The Presidents and Battling Bishops last played on March 4, 1952, as Washington & Jefferson took an 84-69 decision in Delaware, Ohio ... The 1950-51 season marked the only meeting in Washington, Pa., in history ... The Presidents also won that matchup by a 70-49 margin ... Ohio Wesleyan started the season with a 78-66 loss to Haverford, before evening its record with a 91-68 road victory at Swarthmore.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

at Frostburg State (11/22 - 7:30 p.m.)

Waynesburg and Frostburg State meet for the 71st time in history Tuesday with the Yellow Jackets owning a 45-25 advantage in the all-time series ... However, the Bobcats have won the last two meetings, including an 85-80 victory last season in Waynesburg ... In the contest, FSU shot above 50 percent from the field and reserve **Jason Peterson** led all scorers with 33 points, despite five Yellow Jackets scoring in double figures.



Westminster Titans

at Pitt-Bradford (11/22 - 7 p.m.)
vs. Case Western Reserve (11/27 - 6 p.m.)

Westminster and Pitt-Bradford did not play last season ... The last meeting between the two schools came in the 2003-04 campaign in New Wilmington, as the Titans posted a 113-100 victory behind 28 points by **Mark DeMonaco** and nine rebounds from **Pat O'Connor** ... The Titans recorded a 113-109 win against CWRU in Cleveland last season ... O'Connor bucketed a team-high 23 points while **Dom Joseph** snared nine rebounds in the victory ... The last meeting between Westminster and Case in New Wilmington saw the Titans win 111-95 in the 2003-04 season, as DeMonaco posted a career-high 47 points (including 11 treys).
