## PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

### RYAN ELLER

Grove City College

6-2 Senior Forward Erie, Pa./Iroquois H.S.

Eller led the Wolverines to a 2-0 mark at the West Penn Tip-Off Classic with wins over Carnegie Mellon (81-73) and Allegheny (83-66) by averaging 23.0 points, 4.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists per game, earning All-Tournament honors. He shot 11-of-18 from the field in the two games and set a new GCC single-game record by hitting 13-of-13 free throw attempts in the CMU win.

Also nominated was junior G/F **Mike Drahos** of Bethany, senior G **Daryl Moore** of Thiel, sophomore F **Jeff Nero** of Waynesburg, and junior G **Mark DeMonaco** of Westminster.

### PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

#### Bethany Bison

The Bison lost a heartbreaker to Adrian in their opener, 74-72, but rebounded to defeat Case Western Reserve, 91-82, at the Penn State-Behrend Tournament .. In the Adrian game, Bethany led the entire game until two Brian Schaefer free throws with one second on the clock gave Adrian the win ... With the game tied at 72 with 21 seconds left, Bethany turned the ball over and Schaefer was fouled with one second left ... Mike Drahos led the way with 22 points and nine rebounds, while Matt Drahos added 21 points and nine boards. The Bison did not trail against Case Western, led by Mike Drahos' 28 points and eight rebounds ... Jim Deep and Brandon **Duncan** each hit four three-pointers.

#### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J dropped both contests at the West Penn Tip-Off Classic this weekend ... In Washington on Friday, W&J fought back from a 63-56 deficit with five minutes remaining to tie the game two minutes later ... Sophomore G Jon Koch sent the game to double overtime on a three-pointer with nine seconds remaining in the first extra session, but the Gators outscored W&J. 13-3, in the final five minutes ... Koch led the W&J effort with 22 points and six boards ... Sophomore F Patrick Stewart added 12 points and six rebounds ... Sophomores G Brandon Studer and F Matt Vorndran were the only Presidents in double figures against CMU with 15 points each ... Washington & Jefferson shot 47 percent (23-of-49), but committed 33 turnovers.

#### **Grove City Wolverines**

Grove City went 2-0 in the annual West Penn Classic over the weekend ... Senior C Phil Bushre earned Classic MVP honors after pouring in 37 total points in two games ... Bushre had 23 points and seven rebounds against CMU Friday, then posted 14 points at Allegheny Saturday ... Bushre caused both teams' top post player to foul out ... Senior F Ryan Eller fired in 26 against CMU and added a game-high 20 points against Allegheny, earning All-Classic honors ... Eller set a school record by going 13-for-13 at the foul line Friday night ... GCC was 34-of-40 at the line Friday ... Senior G Mike Lukcic did not turn the ball over in 68 minutes of action ... Sophomore Bobby Glass made his first career start Friday.

#### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg opened its season at the Pizza Hut Tip-Off Tournament at Dickinson College in Carlisle, Pa. ... The Yellow Jackets lost to host Red Devils, 78-68, Friday before losing to Richard Stockton, 73-57, in Saturday's consolation game ... Sophomore Beau Wilson led Waynesburg in the opener with 21 points ... Joining Wilson in double-digits were classmates Marc Lodovico (14 points) and Jeff Nero (10) ... In the consolation game, the Ospreys held a 30-point lead over the Jackets in the second half with 10 minutes left ... Nero was the lone Jacket to score double-digits with 23 points and posted eight rebounds ... Also grabbing eight rebounds was Ryan Bujnowski, who added six points in 23 minutes off the bench.

#### Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats earned a split to open the season the Juniata 2004 Mutual Benefit "Doc" Greene Tip-Off Tournament ... Thiel fell to Muskingum 85-50 in the opener but posted a 91-63 victory over P.S.-Berks-Lehigh Valley in the consolation game ... Senior G Daryl Moore was the Tomcats' top scorer against the Muskies, finishing with 11 points ... Senior G Ryan Singleton and junior F Percy Sweeting each added nine in the loss ... Moore finished with 26 points and six assists against the Lions and was named to the all-tournament team ... Singleton finished with 15, freshman F Max Slater added 13, Sweeting finished with 11 and a gamebest 15 rebounds and freshman F Joe Herrmann added 10 and 11 boards.

#### Westminster Titans

The Titans opened the 2004-05 season by splitting a pair of games and placing second at the annual Buzz Ridl Classic ... Westminster set a new school singlegame scoring record in a 131-101 opening round win over Hiram, breaking the mark of 126 points against Baptist Bible in 1998 ... Fifteen of the 16 Titans who saw playing time scored ... Leading the way was junior G Mark DeMonaco with team-high totals of 22 points, eight assists and three steals, followed by senior G Ed Pagley with 21 points and six assists ... In a 105-96 loss to Olivet in the title game, DeMonaco had team-high totals of 24 points, eight assists and three steals, while junior F Dom Joseph added 20 points and a team-high eight rebounds.
