PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

MARK DEMONACO

Westminster College 5-8 Sophomore Guard New Castle, Pa./New Castle H.S.

DeMonaco, in his first games at Westminster after transferring from La Roche College, was named to the All-Tournament team after leading the Titans to a second place finish at the Buzz Ridl Classic. DeMonaco postedteam-high averages of 21.5 points and 7.0 rebounds per game, with 21 points and five boards in a 94-80 win over Philadelphia Bible and 22 points and nine rebounds in an 81-65 loss to Centre.

Also nominated was sophomore F Mike Drahos of Bethany, junior F Ryan Eller of Grove City, junior G Daryl Moore of Thiel, freshman G Brandon Studer of Washington & Jefferson, and freshman G Beau Wilson of Waynesburg.

Bethany Bison

The Bison won the consolation game of the Capital Classic for their first win of the season, as Bethany rallied from a 16-point deficit in the game's final nine minutes ... Freshman C Joe Sprumont recorded a game-winning dunk with three seconds to play ... Mike Drahos had 20 points and 12 rebounds in the win, while Josh Polantz (18 points) and Matt Drahos (16 points) also scored in double figures.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J opened its 2003-2004 season with an 88-78 victory over Allegheny on Friday at Grove City ... Junior forward Steve Button led the way off the bench with 22 points, six rebounds and three assists ... Freshman guard Jon Koch added 15 points and seven rebounds, while classmate Brandon Studer netted 11 points and dished out five assists ... On Saturday night, the Presidents built an 11-point first-half lead and led by as many as six points in the second half only to drop an 82-60 decision ... Studer poured in 14 points to be the only player in double figures out of 12 W&J scorers ... Koch added nine points and five boards ... Both Studer and Button were named to the West Penn Classic All-Tournament Team.

Grove City opened the 2003-04 season by splitting two games at the West Penn Classic ... Following a loss to CMU in the opener, Grove City bounced back to drill Allegheny Saturday night behind 22 points from junior Ryan Eller ... Eller also hit a career-high three triples ... Junior center Matt O'Brien scored a career-high 10 points in his first start Saturday night while freshman center Eric O'Brien added 10 points off the bench ... Grove City shot 18-for-25 from the floor in the second half ... Tanner Prosser had a double-double with 14 points and 10 rebounds Friday night in the loss to CMU ... It was Grove City's worst loss in an opener since 1991.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg lost two close games at the Frostburg State Tip-Off Tournament over the weekend, including a 79-74 loss to the host and eventual champion Bobcats, before an overtime 78-73 loss to Salisbury in the consolation game ... Freshman PG Beau Wilson was impressive in his debut as a Yellow Jacket making all-tournament team and averaging 15.5 points per game in the tourney, including a game-high 22 points against Salisbury ... Wilson and senior G Mike King nailed back-to-back three-pointers to tie the game with Frostburg, before the Bobcats hit 4-of-6 free throws to seal the win ... King and Gillespie led Waynesburg with 18 and 14 points apiece against FSU ... Against Salisbury, Waynesburg missed four field goals in the final minute of regulation before being outscored in overtime, 9-4.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel started the 2003-04 season on a sour note, losing both of its games as the Franklin Savings Tip-Off Tournament at Mount St. Joseph ... The Tomcats fell to the host Lions 78-68 in the opening round ... Senior F Mike Banach had 17 points and four rebounds, while junior G Daryl Moore added 15 and five rebounds... Sophomore F Percy Sweeting chipped in with seven points and a pair of rebounds off the bench ... A 28-12 Tomcat run over the final 8:59, fueled by 12 points from Moore, closed the Denison lead to 75-73 ... A last-second Banach jumper to tie the game and send it into overtime wouldn't fall ... Sophomore F Stephen Laird had 16 points and six rebounds to pace the Tomcats ... Moore added 15 points and was named to the All-Tournament Team.

Westminster Titans

Westminster opened the season by splitting a pair of games at the Buzz Ridl Classic, as the Titans topped Philadelphia Bible 94-80 in the firstround before falling to Centre 81-65 in the finals ... The opener gave first-year head coach Larry Ondako his first career win ... Five Titans hit double figures in the opener, led by sophomore G Mark DeMonaco with a team-high 21 points ... Sophomore F Micah Delo added 17, followed by junior F Pat O'Connor with 12, sophomore F Dom Joseph with 11, and freshman G Ryan Hauck with 10 ... Joseph also grabbed a team-best eight rebounds ... DeMonaco posted teamhigh totals of 22 points and nine rebounds against Centre ... Sophomore G Brian Fadden added 19 points, while freshman F Randall Poindexter added 10 ... DeMonaco and Fadden were named to the All-Tourney team.
