EARLY STARTS: The 2009-10 PAC men's basketball regular season is now fully underway following the first whole week of play. Defending PAC champion Thomas More started its title defense in a positive fashion, posting a 3-0 non-league record last week and capturing the Case Western Reserve Invitational in Cleveland. Other top PAC teams in non-conference play include Saint Vincent and Washington & Jefferson, as the Bearcats and Presidents have both started 2-1.

NEWS & NOTES: Thomas More had a +11.3 average turnover margin in three victories to open the season last week ... Mike Watkins averaged 19.5 ppg in a pair of wins for Saint Vincent, including 23 points in just 26 minutes vs. Penn State-Fayette ... Rich Colick and Brandon Harvey were both named to the Geneva Tip-Off All-Tournament team for the 1-1 GTs ... Junior G Brian Felker averaged 16.7 points in three contests for 2-1 Washington & Jefferson, shooting 55 percent from thefield.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Grove City senior C Andy O'Keefe averaged 17.7 ppg and 4.7 rpg while shooting 80 percent (20-of-25) from the field for the 1-2 Wolverines ... Thiel freshman G Blair Rozenblad averaged 19.0 ppg in a 1-2 week for the Tomcats ... Bethany senior G Jay Lyonett averaged 13.0 ppg, 3.3 rpg and 2.7 apg for the 1-2 Bison ... Westminster junior G Max Spinner was named to the Buzz Ridl Classic All-Tournament team ... Junior G Stephen Iser averaged 15.0 ppg and 3.3 rpg for 0-3 Waynesburg.
