PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Bushre earned the first PAC Men's Basketball Player of the Week award of the 2002-03 season after averaging 14.0 points and 7.5 rebounds en route to Most Outstanding Player honors at the West Penn Tip-Off Classic this weekend. He tallied a double-double with 15 poins, 10 rebounds and three steals in Grove City's 87-84 win over Allegheny on Friday, then added 13 points, five boards and three assists in the Wolverines' 87-70 victory over Carnegie Mellon on Saturday.

Also nominated was senior center **Derek Hoffman** of Bethany, junior forward **Mike Banach** of Thiel, senior guard **Nolan Larry** of Washington & Jefferson, senior guard **Mike Pamepinto** of Waynesburg, and senior center **Greg Foster** of Westminster.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

Bethany dropped its opening two games of the season at the Virginia Wesleyan Tournament over the weekend ... A 6-0 run to open the second half brought Bethany within five of #25 N.C. Wesleyan, but the Bishops used an 19-4 run to push their lead to 20 and never looked back in a 95-69 victory ... Against the host team in the consolation, a 12-0 spurt put the Bison down early and they never recovered in a 90-63 setback ... G Mike Majzun scored 35 points in the two games and now has 906 for his career ... C Derek Hoffman averaged 13.5 points and 6.5 boards in the tournament, while PG Josh Polantz averaged nine points, 6.5 assists and four rebounds.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J opened 2002-03 with a pair of losses at the West Penn Tip-off Classic ... The Presidents dropped an 82-71 home decision to Carnegie Mellon on Friday ... The Tartans forced 27 President turnovers are came back from a 31-29 halftime deficit to score 53 points in the second half in defeating W&J ... Senior G Nolan Larry battled foul trouble the entire night and scored a game-high 19 points in just 23 minutes ... Sophomore F Michael Chicone added 15 points and seven rebounds, while sophomore F Marcellino Manilla chipped in with 11 points and four boards ... Allegheny raced out to a 46-33 halftime lead and cruised to the 25point triumph on Saturday in Meadville ... Sophomore forward **Steve Button** led the way with 15 points and six caroms.

Grove City Wolverines

For the second straight season, the Wolverines swept their opponents in the annual West Penn Tip-Off Classic ... Center Phil Bushre earned the Classic's Most Outstanding Player award while Nate Maurer earned All-West Penn honors ... Bushre, Maurer and Andy Vlajkovich all scored in double figures both nights, as did sophomore reserves J.D. Collar and Ryan Eller ... Against CMU, Grove City used a 12-0 run to break open a 56-56 game in the second half ... The Wolverines shot 17-for-22 (71 percent) from the floor in the second half against CMU en route to the 87-70 win ... Grove City, the country's second-best rebounding team in 2001-02, outrebounded their opponents by 12 boards per game this weekend.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg lost its first two game of the season at the annual Frostburg State University Tip-Off Tournament over the weekend ... Waynesburg lost the to host Bobcats, 88-77, on Friday, before suffering a 78-54 defeat to Neumann, 78-54, on Saturday ... Senior C Aaron Ankrom led the Jackets against Frostburg State with 15 points and nine rebounds, while classmate Ray Robinson sank 14 points in both games ... Senior guard Mike Pamepinto earned a spot on the all-tournament team with a strong showing against Neumann ... Pamepinto scored 13 points, while grabbing a game-high 12 rebounds ... The Jackets return to action on Dec. 2 at the Wendy's Classic hosted by Ohio University.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats rallied from a six-point halftime deficit to earn a 71-67 victory over St. Johns (MN) at the University of Chicago Midway Classic on Saturday, giving first-year head coach Mike Snell his first win as a collegiate head coach ... Junior F Mike Banach led the Tomcats with a game-high 23 points and five rebounds, while senior F A.H. Davis chipped in 16 points ... Thiel was defeated in the championship by Chicago 84-68 on Sunday, despite having four players score in double-digits ... Davis tallied 25 points and four rebounds and senior F Eddie Mathews helped out with 11 points and four rebounds ... Banach and sophomore G Justin Townsend were both named to the All-Tournament Team.

Westminster Titans

The Titansplaced second in their annual season-opening Buzz Ridl Classic this weekend, topping Lake Erie 78-54 in the opening round before falling to former NAIA rival Geneva 70-66 in the title game ... In the Lake Erie win, senior C Greq Foster posted a "double-double" with game-high totals of 24 points (new career-high) and 12 rebounds ... Sophomore G Justin Crum added a career-high 15 points off the bench, while senior G Jeff Simmons tallied 13 points and a gamehigh five assists ... Crum tallied a gamehigh 17 points against Geneva, while Foster posted a "double-double" for the second consective night with 11 points and a game-high 11 rebounds ... Both Crum and Foster were named to the All-Tournament team.
