Varacallo was named Tournament MVP of the 2008 Al Van Wie/Wooster Rotary Classic after leading W&J to back-to-back wins over a pair of nationally-ranked Top 25 teams: 72-70 over tournament host #21 Wooster and 71-64 over #14 Randolph-Macon. He averaged 14.5 points and 3.0 rebounds while shooting 57% (12-of-21) from the field in the invitational, including 80% (4-of-5) from three-point range.

## PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2008-09 - Week 1 Conference Notes

**SEASON UNDERWAY:** The 2008-09 PAC men's basketball season got underway on November 15 ... Washington & Jefferson was picked to capture the 2008-09 PAC men's basketball title in the coaches/media poll released at PAC Basketball Media Day at the Heinz History Center in Pittsburgh on October 23 ... Bethany, the defending men's champion, has the only new head coach in the league in **Mike Summey**, a former assistant coach at Division II North Florida.

**WHO'S HOT:** With a 3-0 start, Saint Vincent has won 16 of its last 17 games dating back to last season ... Thomas More sophomore P **Brian Muse** was named MVP of the Buffalo State Tournament after averaging 15.5 points and 7.0 rebounds ... Senior F **Petre Petkovski** averaged 15.3 points and 8.0 rebounds for 2-1 Bethany ... **Richard Colick** fired in a career-high 34 points for Geneva in an 85-69 loss to Mount Union ... Grove City senior G **Joe McCoy** averaged 16.0 ppg at the Dickinson Tip Off Tournament.

**AROUND THE LEAGUE:** The bright spot in Westminster's 0-4 start has been junior F **Ryne Murray**, who averaged 22.5 points and 10.3 rebounds in the four contests ... W&J senior C **Josip Lucic-Jozak** is averaging 17.5 ppg and 8.8 rpg through four contests this season ... Sophomore G **Ryan Courneen** averaged 13.5 points and 5.5 rebounds for 1-1 Waynesburg, including 22 against La Roche ... Thiel sophomore G **Devon Adams** averaged 18 ppg for the 1-1 Tomcats last week.

# PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

## Bethany Bison (2-1, 0-0 PAC)



The Bison opened up their season by taking two of three last week ... In Monday's lidlifter, Bethany notched a 77-61 victory over La Roche to make new head coach **Mike Summey** the first Bison coach since **Pat Stewart** in 1990 to win his initial game ... **Joe Testa** scored 21 and **Petre Petkovski** recorded his first double-double with 20 markers and 11 boards ... BC took 3<sup>rd</sup> place at the Behrend Tournament over the weekend ... **Tyler Morando's** 17 wasn't enough in a 71-66 setback to the host school on the opening night ... The Bison bounced back the next day to beat Nazareth 91-82 behind a career-high 23 from Testa and 15 points each from Petkovski and Morando ... Petkovski was named All-Tournament team after averaging 13 points and 6.5 rebounds over the two games.

## Geneva Golden Tornadoes (1-1)



Geneva opened its season by splitting a pair of games at its own Tip-Off Tournament ... The Golden Tornadoes opened the season with an offensive explosion that saw 15 players reach the scoresheet ... Geneva shot 53% on its way to a 46 point victory over Philadelphia Biblical ... Junior transfer **Brandon Harvey** made his Geneva debut with 18 points on 6-of-9 shooting, including a 4-of-6 effort from three-point range ... In Saturday's championship game, **Richard Colick** posted a career-high 34 points in a losing effort against Mount Union ... **Dave Phillips**, who was playing his first college action over the weekend, scored 14 points in the loss ... Both Colick and Phillips were named to the All-Tournament team.

## Grove City Wolverines (1-1, 0-0 PAC)



Grove City opened the 2008-09 season with a pair of games in Carlisle, Pa. ... Saturday, senior **G Joe McCoy** rifled in 21 points, including five threes, in a 76-67 win over Salisbury ... Senior **Ryan Gibson** added 14 points while frosh **Drew Vandermeer** had 11 points and eight boards in his first start ... The Wolverines led by 22 at halftime ... Friday night, the Wolverines fell to Dickinson, 69-65 ... The Wolverines made just six first-half field goals ... **Andy O'Keefe** led Grove City with 12 points while McCoy added 11 ... Freshman **Brett Matson** fired in 10 points in his collegiate debut ... Each of Grove City's next three games are at home.

## Saint Vincent Bearcats (3-0)



The Bearcats have begun the season 3-0, and have won 16 of their past 17 games dating back to last season ... This weekend, SVC captured the championship of the Juniata/Doc Greene Invitational with wins over Penn State-Dubois and Alfred ... In the tournament opener Friday, the Bearcats overcame a sluggish first half to defeat PSU-D 83-61 ... **Joey Butler** led all scorers with 20 points, while **Mike Medved** scored 18 and **Tre'sor Kalambay** 13 ... SVC shot 54 percent from the field, and forced 20 turnovers while committing just eight ... In Saturday's 85-54 win over Alfred in the tournament championship, **BJ McGill** led both sides with 25 points, connecting on 7-of-9 tries from beyond the arc ... Butler again scored 20, to go with 10 assists, while Medved scored 14 points and grabbed nine boards.

## Thiel Tomcats (1-2, 0-0 PAC)



Thiel won its first game of the season on Saturday via an 86-78 victory over Penn State-Beaver in the second round of the Chrons Classic at La Roche ... Sophomore **Devon Adams** scored 26, senior **Brandon Mirizio** scored 21, and freshman **Roddy Fuller** scored 19 points to lead the Tomcats ... Thiel fell to La Roche in the tournament's opening round, 46-43 ... Sophomore **Tommy Hall** and Fuller each scored 10 points in the setback ... Fuller also pulled down a game-high seven rebounds.

## Thomas More Saints (2-0, 0-0 PAC)



The Saints opened the season with a 75-71 win over Buffalo State and then defeated Rutgers-Newark, 75-55, to win the Buffalo State Tip-Off Tournament ... In the win against Buffalo State, the Saints had four players score in double-figures led junior **W Daniel McKeehan** who had 16 points ... Joining McKeehan in double-figures were senior **F Mark Tinklenberg** with 12 points, sophomore **P Brian Muse** with 11 points and sophomore **PG Kurt Bovard** with 10 points ... In the championship game against Rutgers-Newark, Muse paced the Saints with 20 points and seven rebounds, while Tinklenberg and sophomore **W Eddie Brown** each finished with 10 points ... At the conclusion of the tournament, Muse was named the tournament's MVP and was joined on the All-Tournament Team by Tinklenberg.

## Washington & Jefferson Presidents (3-1, 0-0 PAC)



The W&J men's basketball program is off to one of the hottest starts in the program's history, as it has knocked off back-to-back nationally ranked squads, defeating No. 21 Wooster and No. 14 Randolph-Macon at the 2008 Al Van Wie/Wooster Rotary Classic ... The Presidents ended Wooster's streak of six consecutive Al Van Wie/Wooster Rotary Classic Championships, earning W&J its first regular-season tournament title in 14 years ... Senior **C Josip Lucic-Jozak**, who comes off the bench for W&J, has led the offense this season, averaging 17.5 points and 8.8 rebounds ... Junior **G Albert Varacallo** was named Tournament MVP and was joined on the All-Tournament Team by Lucic-Jozak and senior **F Wahab Owolabi**.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (1-1, 0-0 PAC)



The Waynesburg University men's basketball team earned a two-game split at the CRONS Classic, which was held by La Roche College ... On Friday, Nov. 21, the Yellow Jackets opened their season with an 80-75 victory over Penn State-Beaver ... The Jackets utilized a balanced scoring attack, which featured six players with at least eight points, to grab the victory ... On Saturday, the Jackets fell to the host Red Hawks by the final of 74-66, despite 22 points and eight rebounds from junior **G Ryan Courneen** ... Senior **G Dan Happe** added 18 points in the loss.

## Westminster Titans (0-4, 0-0 PAC)



Westminster went 0-4 to start the season with a road loss at Penn State-Behrend, 77-55, on Nov. 15, followed by three home losses to Pitt-Bradford, 81-74, on Tuesday, Carnegie Mellon, 70-65, on Thursday, and Wesley, 101-85, on Saturday ... The latter two home games were part of the 17<sup>th</sup> Annual Buzz Ridl Classic ... Junior **F Ryne Murray** averaged 22.5 points and 10.3 rebounds in the four games, including a career-high 28 points vs. Carnegie Mellon and a season-high 15 rebounds vs. Wesley as he was named to the all-Buzz Ridl Classic team ... Tuesday vs. Bradford, senior **G David Richards** and freshman **G Cameron McCleary** joined Murray as double-figure scorers with 20 and 13 points, respectively ... Senior **G Bobby Glass** scored a career-high 12 points on Thursday against Carnegie Mellon.

BC will face Ohio-Eastern Tuesday, who they have won their last five match-ups by an average of 29 points ... Bethany leads the series with OU-E 9-1 ... BC returns from break Saturday to host Penn State-Fayette at 1 p.m. in the programs' first-ever meeting ... Fayette is coached by Bethany alum **Adam Checton**, a member of the 2001 and 2002 PAC championship teams.
