PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

TIM DRAKELEY Waynesburg University 5-6 Senior Guard

Washington, Pa. Trinity H.S.

Drakeley posted career-highs with 31 points, eight rebounds and five steals while also grabbing five rebounds in a

78-66 home win against La Roche in Waynesburg's only game of the week. He was 11-of-16 from the floor, including 4-of-6 from three-point range while playing all 40 minutes.

Also nominated was junior F **Petre Petkovski** of Bethany, senior G **Shawn Carr** of Grove City, freshman F **Tommy Hall** of Thiel, and sophomore F **Ryne Murray** of Westminster.

Bethany Bison



In their only game last week, the Bison shot 53 percent from the floor in routing Pitt-Greensburg 93-59 ... A 13-3 run to close out the first half

gave BC a 42-29 lead at the break ... Bethany then used a 12-2 run early in the second half to take a 71-46 lead and their advantage was never smaller than 23 the rest of the night ... F Petre Petkovski totaled 21 points and eight rebounds, while F Joe Testa came off the bench for 16 markers and seven boards and G Brody Jackson had 15 points ... G Marcus Adams did a little of everything with five points, nine assists, four steals, two blocks and two rebounds.

Saint Vincent Bearcats



The Bearcats won their second straight to open the season, defeating Franciscan University 96-48 on Tuesday ... Saint Vincent held the Barons to just 26 percent from the

field for the game, and forced 23 turnovers while committing just 10 ... Sophomore F Mike Watkins came off the bench to lead the Bearcats with 18 points, going 7-11 from the field and 4-6 from three-point range while grabbing a game-high eight rebounds ... lan McCollough and Joey Butler each added 11 points for Saint Vincent, with Butler also leading both sides in steals (4) and assists (6) ... As a team. Saint Vincent outrebounded Franciscan 63-35.

Washington & Jefferson was idle last week, but returns to action with a pair of non-conference games this week ... W&J opens its 2007-2008 home schedule on Monday versus Penn

Rvan Burns led the way with 17 points in the win at Penn State-Beaver and followed that up with a 16-point performance against La Roche ... Grove City Wolverines



Grove City improved to 2-1 Tuesday by rallying for a win at Penn State-Altoona ... Senior G Shawn Carr fired in a season-high 21 points

while junior Ryan Gibson had 14 points and four assists ... The Wolverines took just 37 shots from the field ... Grove City scored 26 of its 44 second-half points at the foul line ... For the game, GCC shot 29-of-37 (78 percent) at the line ... The Wolverines open their home schedule Wednesday against Juniata before playing at Geneva Friday night ... Waynesburg Yellow Jackets



Senior G Tim Drakeley scored a career-high 31 points Wednesday, as Waynesburg registered a 78-66 victory over La Roche College Drakeley made 11-of-16 attempts from

the floor, including 4-of-6 from long range ... He played all 40 minutes and also set career-highs with eight rebounds and five steals ... Senior G Jered Gamble and senior F Josh Parisi each added 12 points, while junior G/F Jason Clark added a career-high 11 points ... Waynesburg shot 52.2 percent from the field, including 58.3 percent in the second half ... Grove City's 80 wins against Geneva are the Wolverines' second-most against any one opponent ... The Wolverines won at Geneva last year, 74-64, as Ryan Gibson fired in 20 points.

at Wilmington (11/28) at Bethany* (12/1)

Thomas More continues its four-game road swing with contest at Wilmington be-

fore kicking off PAC action Saturday at Bethany ... Thomas More leads the all-time series with Wilmington, 17-5, but the unbeaten Quakers have won the last two ... Bethany leads the all-time series 4-3, and has won the last four meetings with the Saints - all in PAC action.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents



vs. PS-Favette (11/26) at Denison (11/28)

W&J and Penn State-Fayette will meet for the first time in history ... Denison and W&J are meeting for the 19th time in history with

the Big Red holding a 10-8 lead in the series ... Last year, W&J earned its first victory of the season at home after routing the Big Red, 71-49 ... The Presidents shot 51 percent and forced 30 Denison turnovers.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets



at Frostburg St. (11/26) at Thiel* (12/1)

The Yellow Jackets are off to their first 2-0 start of a season since 1986-87, when they reached

the NAIA playoffs ... Senior G Tim Drakeley leads the team in scoring at 24.0 points/ game in his first year as a starter ... The Yellow Jackets posted a 97-72 victory over Frostburg State last season with Drakeley scoring a game-high 19 points in 21 minutes off the bench ... Waynesburg and Thiel split the season series last year with the road team winning each game ... The Yellow Jackets hold a 42-26 lead in the alltime series against the Tomcats that dates back to the 1921-22 season.

Westminster Titans

at Juniata (11/26) vs. Saint Vincent* (12/1) (Both games on WWNW-FM (88.9); <u>www.titanradio.net</u>)

The Titans last played Juniata on Jan. 8, 2005, at home, as Craig Hannon scored 26 points in the 109-102 loss ... Westminster won both games

against Saint Vincent last year, winning 94-86 at home on Jan. 31 and at Saint Vincent, 93-89, on Jan. 10 ... Hannon scored a season-high 29 points in the win at SVC, while Nick Adams bucketed a team-high 24 in the home game ... Currently, Saint Vincent is leading the PAC with 100.5 points per game, while the Titans are sixth averaging 76.5 and giving up 82.5 points per game in four losses.

Wednesday before opening PAC action
