

Senior Ed Thornton scored a season-high 15 points in the MSJ game ... Freshman Eddie Tyree had a solid week with 7.5 points and 3 rebounds ... The Saints were able to do some good things statistically against the Div. II Norse, as TMC was even on the boards, 37-37, and went to the foul line more than NKU.

The Presidents' season-opening losing streak reached five games after dropping contests to Ohio Wesleyan, Rochester and Buffalo State ... The Battling Bishops shot 56 percent Tuesday in a 26-point victory over W&J ... Senior G Jon Koch netted a game-high 23 points, while adding five rebounds ... The Presidents were limited

Sophomore C Josip Lucic-Jozak totaled 17 points and seven rebounds to lead W&J ... Buffalo State became the third straight team to shoot over 50 percent against W&J Sunday at Rochester ... Senior G Brandon Studer collected a season-high 24 points, while Koch added 16.



#### Westminster Titans

Westminster went 1-1 during the week, losing to Pitt-Bradford at home Tuesday, 86-82, and winning its first game of the season Sunday at La Roche in overtime, 92-89 ... Junior G Craig Hannon led the Titans vs. Pitt-Bradford with 23 points, while senior G Nick Adams and senior G Greg Rosatelli each had 16 points ... Adams led the Titans with 21 points in the win over La Roche, while Rosatelli netted 19 markers ... Westminster was up by 27 points in the first half only to see the Redhawks go on a remarkable 27-0 run span-

ning seven minutes between the two halves ... Senior F/G Dom Joseph hit a key 3-pointer in overtime and Rosatelli drained four straight free throws to guide the Titans to the win.



## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets took an 11-point lead into halftime in their contest against Southern Virginia on Tuesday, but fell to the NAIA Knights by score of 91-80 ... Seniors Jeff Linden and Jeff Nero both scored a game-

high 24 points in the loss ... Senior G Marc Lodovico added 10 points and four rebounds in defeat ... Waynesburg collected a season 37 rebounds, paced by Nero with seven ... As a team, the Yellow Jackets shot 45.5 percent (30-of-67), including a 9-for-15 performance by Linden.



#### Saint Vincent Bearcats
