PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2011-12 - Week 2 Conference Notes

PAC PLAY ON TAP: The 2011-12 PAC conference schedule gets underway this Wednesday and Saturday with a full slate of league contests on each date ... Defending PAC tournament champion Bethany and 2010-11 regular season champion Thiel each open PAC play on the road Wednesday, as the Bison head to Grove City while Thiel travels to Waynesburg ... Geneva hosts Thomas More Wednesday in the first PAC game for the GTs as an active NCAA Division III member.

NEWS & NOTES: Bethany junior G **James Barton** averaged 21.0 ppg as the Bison posted a 4-0 start for the first time since 1966-67 ... Senior G **Brett Matson** recorded 19 points, nine rebounds and four assists in Grove City's double-OT win over Kenyon ... Senior PG **Daniel Whelan** posted 17 points, five boards and four steals for Thomas More in its win at city rival Mount St. Joseph ... Senior F **Jeff Young** recorded 12 points and nine rebounds in just 18 minutes for Waynesburg in a win vs. Mount Union

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Senior G **Dennis Bassich** averaged 20.7 ppg for 2-1 Saint Vincent ... Junior G/F **Blair Rozenblad** averaged a double-double (17.5 ppg, 10.0 rpg) in a 1-1 week for Thiel ... Freshman **Zac Rorick** scored 22 points off the bench for Geneva in a home loss to La Roche ... Freshman G **Andy Carter** averaged 20 points, 6.5 rebounds and 2.0 assists in a pair of losses for W&J last week ... Sophomore G **Anthony Thomas** led Westminster with 16 points in a loss at Mount Union.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (4-0, 0-0 PAC)



The Bison improved to 4-0 for the first time in 45 years with two home wins last week ... Bethany raced to a 48-31 halftime lead and held off a late Muskingum rally for a 71-67 triumph last Tuesday ... **James Barton** scored 16 of his team-high 19 in the opening half, while **Reece Mabery** went 4-for-5 from the arc for 18 points and **Brady Pacific** dropped in 12 off the bench ... The Bison led Pitt-Greensburg by only a basket at halftime Saturday, but a 31-2 run in the second half propelled BC to an 86-61 victory ... Barton was once again the high scorer with 23 points and also hauled down seven boards, while Pacific hit for 18 and Mabery (11 points, six steals, four assists) and **Nick Wilcox** (11 points, eight rebounds, six assists, four steals) had big all-around games.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (1-4, 0-0 PAC)



Junior **Matt Lorello** was close to unstoppable last Tuesday night at Penn State-Beaver ... Despite an 89-83 loss to the Lions, the Golden Tornadoes featured Lorello's career-best 37 points on 15-of-19 shooting from the field ... Geneva watched its second half lead disappear as it dropped only the third game ever to PS-B ... Saturday, Lorello scored 19 points, **Dave Phillips** 20 and freshman **Zac Rorick** chipped in 22 points off the bench but it was still not enough to slow down La Roche in an 84-69 loss ... After opening the season with a victory over Penn State-Greater Allegheny, Geneva has dropped four straight and will welcome Thomas More to Metheny Fieldhouse Wednesday ... The GTs have been seriously hit by the injury bug and will slowly be getting some key components back into the rotation.

Grove City Wolverines (3-1, 0-0 PAC)



Grove City opened the home portion of the schedule Tuesday night by rallying for an 84-75 double-overtime victory over Kenyon ... The Wolverines erased a 54-46 deficit over the final eight minutes of regulation ... **Kris Verderber** led GCC with 20 points while **Brett Matson** fashioned a 19-point, 9-rebound, 4-assist effort ... **Nate Rambacher** added 11 points and seven rebounds ... Grove City had just 11 turnovers in 50 minutes of action ... GCC last won in double overtime December 14, 2005, when Grove City nipped Hiram 77-76 ... The Wolverines last won a double-OT game at home January 14, 2004 when GCC downed Geneva, 87-85 ... Grove City has now won six straight home openers and owns a 12-2 mark under head coach **Steve Lamie** in home openers ... Grove City opens PAC play Wednesday vs. Bethany.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (3-1, 0-0 PAC)



Saint Vincent began the season on a three-game winning streak before suffering a 69-55 set-back at Juniata on Saturday ... Monday, SVC cruised to a 92-51 victory over Penn State-Fayette behind senior G **Dennis Bassich**'s game-high 26 points ... Sophomore **Isaac Turner** and senior **Tauvon Pettiford** added 19 and 17 points, respectively ... Bassich again led all scorers with 23 points on Tuesday at La Roche as the Bearcats avenged last season's 72-66 loss with a 71-66 victory ... SVC closed the week by suffering a 69-55 setback to unbeaten Juniata on the road Saturday ... Bassich and Pettiford paced the Bearcats with 13 points apiece while Turner added 11.

Thiel Tomcats (1-1, 0-0 PAC)



The Tomcats split a pair of games last week, defeating Penn St.-Behrend in their home opener 65-47 before dropping a 95-75 decision at D-II Edinboro Sunday ... In the first contest, the Tomcats had big performances by senior G **Devon Adams** and junior G **Blair Rozenblad** to defeat Behrend ... Adams led the team with 14 points, seven assists, and five rebounds ... Rozenblad led the Tomcats in the point column with 17 and also notched eight boards ... Thiel's stout defense held the Lions to 30 percent shooting, including just 10 percent from behind the arc ... In the second game of the week at Edinboro, Rozenblad notched his first double-double of the season as he scored a team-high 18 points and added 12 boards ... Junior G **Anthony Harvey** had his best game of the year with 17 points on 7-of-14 shooting.

Thomas More Saints (4-0, 0-0 PAC)



Thomas More extended its season-opening win streak to four games as it defeated city rival Mount St. Joseph, 52-44, in its lone game last week ... Senior PG **Daniel Whelan** led all scorers with 17 points, while junior SF **Phil Feinberg** joined him in double-figures with 16 points ... Feinberg and senior C **Colt Stafford** just missed double-figure rebounding as they each pulled down nine rebounds and **Whelan** led the team in steals with four ... For the season, Whelan leads the team in scoring with 17.0 points per game, while Feinberg and Stafford lead the team in rebounding with 5.8 rebounds per game ... Through four games, the Saint have a +25.0 scoring margin as they average 84.0 points per game and hold the opposition to 59.0 points per game ... Thomas More is shooting 51.1 percent from the field.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (2-3, 0-0 PAC)



Washington & Jefferson looks to snap a three-game losing streak this week following losses to Juniata (74-66) and Muskingum (54-53) last week ... Freshman **Andy Carter** led W&J against Juniata with 22 points, nine rebounds and two steals ... Sophomore G **Brett Rubin-Goldstein** dished out a career-high nine assists ... Saturday, W&J missed a potential game-winning layup just before time expired after cutting the Muskingum lead from 13 points in the second half ... Neither team was able to muster a point in the last 2:42 of the game ... Carter again led the Presidents' offense with 18 points, while adding four rebounds and three assists ... W&J fell despite shooting 49 percent (21-43) from the field.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (2-3, 0-0 PAC)



Waynesburg split a pair of home games against Ohio Athletic Conference (OAC) opponents last week ... After suffering a loss to Baldwin-Wallace, the Yellow Jackets rebounded with a thrilling 55-52 victory over Mount Union ... Senior G **Larry Alexander** gave the Jackets a 51-50 lead on a clutch three-pointer late in the game and freshman G Casey Hope calmly knocked down four straight free throws to seal the victory ... Senior F **Jeff Young** made his season debut after wrapping up his senior season with the Waynesburg football team and promptly recorded game highs in points (12) and rebounds (nine) against the Purple Raiders ... Alexander led all other players with an 8.0 points per game average.

Westminster Titans (1-3, 0-0 PAC)



In its only game last week, Westminster lost 88-64 at Mount Union Tuesday after the Titans led at halftime. Sophomore G **Anthony Thomas** led the Titans with 16 points, followed by junior G **Ron Martino** and freshman G **Torrell Grier** with 10 points apiece ... Grier's 10 points were a career-high ... Grier also tied a career high with four steals ... Junior F **Adam Carswell** led the Titans with seven rebounds to go with two points ... The Purple Raiders shot a sizzling 67.4 percent (31-of-46) from the floor compared to Westminster's 33.3 percent (19-of-57) ... The Titans shot 48.1 percent (13-of-27) in the first half as they led 41-39 at halftime and by as many as eight points (35-27) in the first half ... The teams traded baskets to open the second half and Westminster's final lead occurred with 17 minutes left.
