PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

JOE HERRMANN Thiel College

6-5 Junior Forward Hartstown, Pa./Jamestown H.S.

Herrmann led the Tomcats to a 1-1 week by averaging 18.5 points, 8.5 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 2.5 blocked shots per game last week. He scored a seasonhigh 30 points and added 15 rebounds,



five assists and a career-high five blocks in a 77-66 non-conference win at Lancaster Bible on Saturday.

Also nominated was senior G **Marc Palermo** of Bethany, senior C **Craig Hallman** of Grove City, and junior G **Craig Hannon** of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

The Bison won two of their three games last week and now stand at 4-2 ... BC opened the week with a 110-87 defeat at D-II West Liberty State ... Five Bison hit for double figures, led by **Chris Stephens**' 16 and **Joe Testa**'s first career

double-double (13 pts., 13 rebs.) ... Bethany bounced back with a 109-80 trouncing of Ohio-Eastern the next night, as all 14 players who saw time scored ... Marc Palermo led the way with a careerbest 16 points, while **Marcus Adams** totaled 13 points, four assists and four steals ... BC completed their three games in three days swing with a 98-62 win over Franciscan ... Palermo led the team with 15 markers and added a career-high eight boards, four assists and four steals, while Stephens had a career-high 13 assists.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City improved to 2-2 with a 74-64 win over longtime rival Geneva Wednesday night ... Sophomore G **Ryan Gibson** fired in a career-high 20 points while senior C **Craig Hallman** added 16 points on 8-of-11 accu-

racy ... Hallman attended his grandmother's funeral that morning ... Freshman C **Andy O'Keefe** went 5-for-5 from the floor for a careerhigh 10 points ... He and Hallman also helped neutralize Geneva's height advantage inside ... The Wolverines limited Geneva to just 18 percent (5-of-29) shooting in the second half ... GCC committed a season-low eight turnovers ... Grove City had not won in Beaver Falls since January 9, 1999 ... The Wolverines now lead the all-time series with Geneva, 80-69.



Thiel Tomcats

Thiel went 1-1 last week, falling at Muskingum 67-43 Wednesday before recording a 77-66 win at Lancaster Bible Saturday ... Junior F Ross Watson led the Tomcats at Muskingum with 13 points and eight rebounds, while junior F Sharron Summerville added nine points ...

Junior F **Joe Herrmann** scored a season-high 30 points to go along with 15 rebounds, five assists and a career-high five blocks in the win at Lancaster Bible ... Thiel converted 72.7 percent (32-of-44) of its field goal attempts and held Lancaster Bible to just 32.1 percent shooting ... Thiel also finished with a 39-20 advantage on the glass ... Summerville posted 15 points, seven rebounds and five assists while Watson added 12 points, five rebounds and three steals.



Thomas More Saints

Thomas More has a tough week dropping two non-conference games to Wilmington (77-57) and Transylvania

(100-64) ... In the loss to Wilmington, three players – **Ed Thornton**, **Michael Selm** and **Erik Marting** – all scored eight points to lead the Saints ... Despite the defeats, TMC was able to outrebound both its opponents – Wilmington by two and Transy by 10 ... Junior **Brad Buckner** led the Saints with 11 points and six rebounds in the loss to the Pioneers.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J dropped a pair of non-league contests last week ... Kenyon used a nine-point run late in the first half Wednesday to post an 11-point victory in Washington ... Senior G Brandon Studer pumped in 18 points to pace the Presidents on 8-of-16 shooting ... Classmate Jon Koch netted 13 points while adding three assists, and sopho-

more C **Josip Lucic-Jozak** finished with 10 points and five rebounds ... The Presidents were limited to 37 percent (23-of-63) shooting, but committed only 11 turnovers ... W&J held a seven-point lead in the first half Saturday in Cleveland, but CWRU finished with 46 percent shooting and drained 27 free throws to earn the win ... Koch was the only W&J player in double figures with 13 points ... Eight different Presidents scored, including six with 7+ points.

Westminster Titans

Westminster lost 83-80 at Geneva Saturday ... The Titans (1-4) had five players score in double figures, but the Golden Tornadoes (6-3) held a 40-23 rebound advantage ... Junior G Craig Hannon led all scorers with 22 points on 8-of-17 shooting from the floor, including 6-of-13 from 3-point range ... The Golden Tornadoes shot 58.3 percent (28-48) from the field, while holding the Titans to 41.5 percent (27-65) ... Senior G Greg Rosatelli finished with 14 points, as did freshman F Ryne Murray ... Senior G/F Dom Joseph buck-

eted 13 points and senior G **Nick Adams** netted 10 ... Westminster led 52-46 with 15:13 remaining when Geneva went on a 17-0 run for a 63-52 lead with 6:38 to go ... Westminster surged back and tied the game 76-76 with 1:14 left, but could not re-take the lead.

Last year, the Tartans, who lead the series 29-24, pulled out an 87-85 victory in Pittsburgh ... Marc Palermo had 12 and James Wallace scored 10 in the loss ... Bethany begins defense of its two consecutive PAC titles Saturday when they host Thiel ... BC will put their record 24-game PAC winning streak on the line ... The Bison won all three meetings with the Tomcats last season and lead the series 97-41.
