Bellhy averaged 26.5 points, 3.0 rebounds and 1.5 steals last week for the 1-1 Presidents. His game-winning 18-foot jumper as time expired Tuesday lifted W&J to a 66-65 road victory over NCAA D-II provisional member Notre Dame (Ohio) and gave him a career-high 26 points in the win. He surpassed that total with a new career-best 27 markers on 10-of-18 shooting from the field in a 63-48 PAC road loss to Thiel.

Also nominated was junior F **Nick Wilcox** of Bethany, senior G **Dennis Bassich** of Saint Vincent, junior G/F **Blair Rozenblad** of Thiel, s junior SF **Phil Feinberg** of Thomas More, senior F **Larry Alexander** of Waynesburg, and freshman G **Ben Donlow** of Westminster.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2011-12 - Week 3 Conference Notes

PAC PLAY UNDERWAY: The 2011-12 PAC conference schedule got underway this Wednesday and Saturday with a full slate of league contests on each date ... Defending PAC tournament champion Bethany and 2010-11 regular season champion Thiel each opened the new league campaign with a pair of victories, as did Thomas More while Saint Vincent is 1-0 ... Saturday, Saint Vincent heads to Thiel while Thomas More is at Bethany in games that should clarify the early PAC race.

NEWS & NOTES: Junior F **Nick Wilcox** averaged 13.5 ppg, 10.5 rpg, 5.0 apg and 2.5 spg for 2-0 Bethany ... Junior SF **Phil Feinberg** averaged 13.7 points and 9.7 rebounds for 2-1 Thomas More, including a career-best 28 vs. Transylvania ... Thiel junior G/F **Blair Rozenblad** averaged 14.5 points and 9.0 rebounds for the 2-0 Tomcats, including a double-double at Waynesburg ... Freshman G **Ben Donlow** bucketed 29 points and added 11 boards for Westminster in a PAC win at Waynesburg.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Freshman **Andy Carter** had 19 points and 10 boards in W&J's win at D-II Notre Dame (OH) ... **Tauvon Pettiford** led 11 Saint Vincent scorers in a win vs. Franciscan with 12 points ... Freshman G **Mitch Marmelstein** scored a career-high 24 points for Grove City vs. Bethany ... Senior G **Larry Alexander** averaged 12.0 ppg for 0-2 Waynesburg, including 16 markers in a loss to Thiel ... Geneva is 1-6 for the first time since the 1981-82 season, when the GTs finished 1-23.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (6-0, 2-0 PAC)



Bethany opened league play with two wins and have matched the 1966-67 team's 6-0 start to the season ... Playing without two starters, the Bison rallied from a 12-point second half deficit at Grove City and pulled out a 67-63 victory ... **Nick Wilcox** played all 40 minutes and totaled 20 points, 10 rebounds, four assists and three steals, while **Brady Pacific** hit for 15 and **Dylan Gravatt** had 10 ... Saturday against Geneva, Pacific went 6-for-6 from the arc and BC hit 12 three-pointers in an 82-51 victory ... Three hit for double digits, led by Pacific with a career-high 26, **James Barton** notched 15 and **Leslie Addy** chipped in 12 ... Wilcox had another solid all-around game with seven points, 11 rebounds and six assists.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (1-6, 0-2 PAC)



Geneva fell to 1-6 overall and 0-2 in the PAC after dropping games to Thomas More and Bethany ... It has been 30 years since the Golden Tornadoes have started a season at 1-6 ... Not since the 1981-82 season when Geneva finished the year at 1-23 have the GTs won just once in their first seven games ... Despite the slow start, junior **F Matt Lorello** has been quite special through the early going this year ... Leading the Golden Tornadoes with 20.6 points per game and 7.1 rebounds per game, Lorello is shooting an amazing 70% from the field ... Lorello scored a grand total of 65 points all of last year and has posted 144 points through seven games of 2011 ... Geneva will host Waynesburg on Wednesday night in search of its first ever PAC victory.

Grove City Wolverines (3-3, 0-2 PAC)



The youthful Wolverines opened PAC play last week with a pair of hard-fought setbacks ... Late scoreless droughts doomed Grove City in both games ... Wednesday against Bethany, freshman **G Mitch Marmelstein** fired in a career-high 24 points, including four three-point goals ... Classmate **J.T. Schwartz** added 10 points ... **Brett Matson** divvied out six assists ... GCC had 16 turnovers, including 13 in the second half ... Saturday at Thomas More, **Christian Durbin** and **Mike Grist** both made their first start of the season ... Matson paced Grove City with 10 points and Marmelstein contributed nine points and seven rebounds ... A four-minute scoreless period down the stretch proved pivotal, however ... The Wolverines will visit Saint Vincent Wednesday night before hosting archrival Geneva Saturday.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (5-1, 1-0 PAC)



SVC rebounded from a 69-55 loss at Juniata by winning two games this week by double digits ... First, SVC earned a 82-25 win over Franciscan at home on Monday despite its starters averaging less than 17 minutes apiece ... In that game, 11 of the 13 Bearcats scored at least three points, led by senior **Tauvon Pettiford**, who posted 12 points on 6-of-7 accuracy from the floor ... Sophomore **Dillon Stith** added 11 points on 5-of-6 shooting from the floor ... In the PAC opener over Westminster Wednesday, four players chipped in double-figures led by senior **Dennis Bassich's** 25 points and game-high five assists ... Sophomore **Isaac Turner** added 15 points, Pettiford totaled 13 points and junior **Ed Wright** registered 12 points off the bench.

Thiel Tomcats (4-2, 2-0 PAC)



The Tomcats opened PAC play with a pair of victories as they defeated Waynesburg on the road 83-59, and won their PAC home opener over W&J 63-48 ... In the first game of the week, the Tomcats traveled to Waynesburg and defeated the Yellow Jackets 83-59 ... Junior **G Anthony Harvey** led the way for the Tomcats with 17 points and four assists, and junior **F Blair Rozenblad** notched his second double double of the season with 16 points and 12 rebounds ... Thiel held the Yellow Jackets to just a Tomcat season-low 28 percent shooting from the floor ... Tied at 42 going into the half, the Tomcats outscored Waynesburg 41-17 in the second half ... The Tomcats pushed their regular-season home win streak to 12 games with a 63-48 victory over W&J ... Junior **F AJ Forbes** led TC with 13 points and nine rebounds.

Thomas More Saints (6-1, 2-0 PAC)



Thomas More went 2-1 last week as fell to in-state rival Transylvania Monday and then defeated Geneva and Grove City to open PAC play ... Junior SF **Phil Feinberg** led the Saints in scoring and rebounding as he averaged 13.7 points and 9.7 rebounds in the Saints' three games ... He scored a career-high 28 points against Transylvania and then followed that up with his first career double-double as he scored 14 points and pulled down 11 rebounds in the Saints' PAC opening winning over Geneva ... Senior **C Colt Stafford** averaged 11.3 ppg and 7.3 rpg in the Saints' three games, including scoring a game-high 16 points against Grove City ... For the season, Feinberg leads the team in scoring and rebounding as he averages 14.4 ppg., and 7.4 rpg.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (3-4, 0-1 PAC)



Washington & Jefferson took down Notre Dame College at the buzzer before falling in its PAC opener to Thiel last week ... Junior **G Zach Bellhy** nailed an 18-foot jumper as time expired to beat the NCAA Division II provisional member Falcons ... Bellhy set a career-high with 26 points on 9-of-17 shooting ... Freshman **G Andy Carter** contributed 19 points and 10 rebounds ... The game featured 15 lead changes and seven ties ... Bellhy's career-high point total lasted just three days as he scored 27 against Thiel ... Bellhy had 18 of the Presidents' 29 first-half points ... After trailing by only four at the half, W&J missed its first eight shots of the second half and allowed the Tomcats to break the game open with a 17-1 run.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (2-5, 0-2 PAC)



The Waynesburg University men's basketball team opened up PAC play this past week with a pair of home losses to Thiel and Westminster ... The Yellow Jackets stayed right with the Tomcats going into halftime before falling behind in the second half ... Waynesburg erased a double-digit deficit late in their showdown with the Titans, but couldn't quite seal the deal in a three-point loss ... Senior **G Larry Alexander** led all Jacket scorers by averaging 12.0 points per game, while freshman **F Jacob Fleegle** chipped in an average of 10 points per game ... Senior **F Jeff Young** and junior **C Kurt Bonnet** each averaged a team-high 7.0 rebounds per contest.

Westminster Titans (2-4, 1-1 PAC)



Westminster bounced back from a 79-66 home PAC loss to Saint Vincent Wednesday by winning at Waynesburg, 74-71, Saturday ... Freshman **G Ben Donlow** led the Titans with 29 points and 11 rebounds in the win over Waynesburg as he became the first Titan since Feb. 17, 2010, to score at least 29 points in a game ... Donlow finished the week averaging 17.5 points, 9 rebounds, while shooting an efficient 57.7 percent (15-of-26) from the floor ... Junior **F Adam Carswell** scored 11 points and grabbed eight boards vs. Waynesburg ... In the loss to Saint Vincent, sophomore **G Anthony Thomas** led the Titans with 20 points while junior **Doug Smith** bucketed 15 points.

In a 71-66 win at TMC, **Nick Wilcox** had 19 points and 13 boards for Bethany, while the 87-82 victory at BC was highlighted by 25 points and 13 rebounds from **British Alexander** ... **James Barton** averaged 18.5 points and was 8-for-10 from the arc in the two wins.

The Bearcats earned a 56-55 win at the Carey Center later in the season when **Tauvon Pettiford** went coast-to-coast with 4.8 seconds remaining to set the final margin.

So far this season, the Tomcats have owned the glass as they rank first in the conference in rebounds per game with 38.7 rebounds per game and are second in the conference in rebounding margin with a +3.7 advantage over their opponents.
