**PAC PLAY UNDERWAY:** The 2010-11 PAC men's basketball conference schedule got underway with a full slate of games on both Wednesday (Dec. 1) and Saturday (Dec. 4) ... Bethany and Thiel each posted two wins against league foes, as the Bison nipped Westminster 75-74 and rolled past Waynesburg 87-59, while the Tomcats dispatched Saint Vincent 80-60 before recording an 84-73 win over Geneva ... Thomas More topped Grove City 65-44 in a 2010 PAC title game rematch.

**NEWS & NOTES:** Geneva senior G **Bryan Hill** scored 27 points on 7-of-8 three-point shooting and scored his 1,000th career point against W&J on Wednesday ... Junior C **Colt Stafford** of Thomas More had a career-high 17 points along with six boards in the Saint win over defending PAC champion Grove City ... Senior PG **Devon Adams** scored a game-high 26 points for Thiel in a PAC win vs. Geneva ... **Isaac Turner** bucketed a team-high 21 points for Saint Vincent in a road PAC win at Westminster. AROUND THE LEAGUE: Monday's win at Oberlin allowed Waynesburg to equal its win total for all of last season (2-22) ... Bethany has now won 17 consecutive meetings against Waynesburg, while Grove City has won 16 consecutive regular season home games against Washington & Jefferson ... Sophomore F Doug Smith averaged 19.5 ppg last week for 0-2 Westminster ... Sophomore G Zach Bellhy averaged 15.5 ppg and 4.5 rpg for the week for 0-2 Washington & Jefferson.

BC lost a 21-point first half lead, they regrouped to claim a 75-74 triumph over Westminster Wednesday ... **Ryan McFadden** led five double digit scorers with 16 points and also grabbed nine rebounds, while **British Alexander** scored 14 and also hauled down nine boards and **Reece Mabery** totaled 12 markers and 7 assists ... The Bison extended their win streak over Waynesburg to 17 games with an 87-59 decision Saturday ... Wilcox turned in 18 points and seven rebounds and was joined in double figures by Alexander and **Evan Webster** (14) as well as Mabery (11), as the Bison shot 52 percent from the floor, 56 percent from the arc and caused 27 Yellow Jacket turnovers.

Hill was 7-of-8 from long-distance in scoring a game-high 27 points and reaching the 1.000 point plateau for his career ... Lambros Svingos and Drew Santarsiero each scored 14 points in the victory ... In the men's game on Saturday, Geneva fell behind early and trailed by 24 points in the first half ... A desperate comeback that pulled the GTs within five points could not be completed in an 84-73 loss at Thiel ... Geneva had five players reach double figures in scoring, including a team best 14 points from Rich Colick ... The Golden Tornadoes finished the week at 4-2 with three games coming up this week.

#### Thomas More Saints vs. Westminster\* (12/11


