PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

MIKE KING

Waynesburg College 5-11 Senior Guard Paden City, W.Va./Paden City H.S.

King averaged 22.5 points per game as Waynesburg went 1-1 last week, while adding 3.5 steals and 2.0 assists per game. He tallied 21 points in the first win of the season for the Jackets, an 87-70 decision over Penn State-Altoona in Waynesburg's home opener. He then tallied a game-high 24 markers in a loss at Notre Dame (Ohio).

Also nominated was sophomore G/F Mike Drahos of Bethany, junior F Ryan Eller of Grove City, sophomore F Damien Williams of Thiel, freshman G Jon Koch of Washington & Jefferson, and junior G Ed Pagley of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

Sophomore Mike Drahos tied his careerhigh point total on Dec. 2 against Ohio-Eastern, with 23 points ... He then eclipsed that total with 27 points, on 8-of-11 shooting from the floor and a 9-of-11 performance from the free throw line, against the College of Mount St. Joseph on Dec. 6.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J split a pair of contests last week, defeating Case Western Reserve in overtime in Washington before falling to No. 19 Capital in Columbus, Ohio ... Junior forward Steve Button scored 21 of his 22 points after halftime in leading the Presidents to the comefrom-behind win on Monday ... CWRU led by as many as 14 points in the second half and held an 80-70 advantage with five minutes left ... After forcing overtime, sophomore guard Billy Zopf hit a three-pointer with 3:01 remaining to give W&J the lead for good ... Freshman reserve guard Anthony Hairston added 17 points and three steals, while freshman guard Jon Koch netted 17 markers ... Koch dropped a career-high 20 points in the loss to Capital, while freshman guard Brandon Studer scored 12 of his 19 points in the first half.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City continues its roller-coaster start, having no win or losing streak longer than one game this year to date ... GCC evened its record with a win over Medaille as Tanner Prosser led the way with 22 points and six assists ... Junior G J.D. Collar added 19 points and five assists ... Grove City scored 30 points off turnovers ... Ryan Eller led the Wolverines against Case Western with a game-high 17 points ... Eller and frontcourt starters Nate Maurer and Phil Bushre did not play against Medaille while Matt Phillips, who started in Eller's place against Medaille, joined Maurer and Bushre on the sideline at CWRU ... Grove City is in the middle of a five-game stretch against Ohio schools ... Prosser has 974 career points ... Grove City has used four different lineups in five games.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Interim head coach Frank Ferraro recorded his first career collegiate coaching win on Thursday as Waynesburg defeated Penn State-Altoona, 87-70, in its home-opener ... The Jackets trailed at the half before going on a 14-0 run during an 8:15 stretch midway through the second half ... Senior guard Mike King and freshman guard Jeff Nero had 21 points apiece, while Nero was a perfect 5-for-5 from three-point range ... Waynesburg then traveled to Notre Dame of Ohio Saturday and lost 94-66 ... The Falcons out-rebounded the Jackets by an astounding 58-20 margin, as Waynesburg was without junior guard Ray Gillespie, the team's leading rebounder ... King did have a game-high 24 points, despite six Notre Dame players scoring in double figures.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel won its home opener last week, upending Pitt-Bradford 92-71 in front of a capacity crowd at Rissell-Beeghly Gym ... Sophomore F Damien Williams had an impressive first collegiate start, finishing with 14 points on 6-of-9 shooting ... Four other Tomcats finished in double-figures: junior G Ryan Singleton (13), junior G Daryl Moore (11), freshman G Chris Kwolek (10) and senior F D.J. Gambridge (10) ... Senior F Mike Banach added a career-high 15 rebounds in the lopsided win ... The Tomcats shot a season-best 58.7 percent from the floor and 50.0 percent from three-point range ... They also finished with a 44-28 advantage in rebounds

... The Tomcats limited the Panthers to just 33.7 percent from the floor and 14.3 percent from beyond the arc.

Westminster Titans

After road non-conference losses at Penn State-Behrend (91-63) and Frostburg State (90-62), the Titans have dropped four straight since a season-opening win ... At PS-B, three players scored in double figures led by junior F Pat O'Connor with a team-high 16 markers on 8-of-14 shooting from the floor ... Junior Gs Chris Hatch and Ed Pagley each added 10 points in the loss, with Pagley also collecting a team-best five rebounds in his first action of the season after missing the first three games due to injury ... At Frostburg, sophomore F Dom Joseph came off the bench to tally a team-high 16 points, while sophomore F Micah Delo and Pagley added 11 and 10 points, respectively ... Sophomore G Brian Fadden dished out a team-high five assists in the loss.
