PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

MIKE PAMEPINTO

Waynesburg College 6-3 Senior Guard Swanton. Md./Southern Garrett H.S.

Pamepinto averaged 20.6 points per game while leading the Yellow Jackets to a 2-1 week, with the lone loss coming to NCAA D-II Wheeling Jesuit. He scored a career-high 35 points in a 109-91 win over Ohio-Eastern, including a school-record seven three-pointers, and shot 76 percent (13-of-17) from 3-point range for the week.

Also nominated was freshman forward **Matt Drahos** of Bethany, junior C **Phil Bushre** of Grove City, junior forward **Mike Banach** of Thiel, senior guard **Nolan Larry** of Washington & Jefferson, and senior center **Greg Foster** of Westminster.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

Bethany fell to 0-5 for the first time since the 1997 season following a 76-62 loss at Baldwin-Wallace ... A 12-0 Yellow Jacket run broke open a tie game and proved to be too much to overcome for the Bison ... Freshman forward **Matt Drahos** posted his third consecutive double-double with 16 points and 11 rebounds ... Guards **Mike Majzun** and **Josh Polantz** fired in 14 apiece as a 37-29 Bison advantage on the boards was nullified by 25 Bethany turnovers, including 16 in the second half.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Senior G Nolan Larry hit a jumper as time expired to give W&J a 59-57 victory over Penn State-Behrend Wednesday ... The win was the first of the season and head coach Karel Jelinek's first at W&J ... Junior C Tony Franz led the way for the Presidents with 15 points on 6-of-9 shooting off the bench ... Sophomore F Chris Houser added 12 points in 22 minutes, while Larry and sophomore G Jesse Mullen scored nine markers each ... Larry added five rebounds and three assists ... On Monday, Case Western shot 58 percent from the floor and outrebounded the Presidents, 38-26, in recording the 11-point victory ... Larry led the way with 26 points for the Presidents, making 15-of-16 foul shots and 5-of-11 attempts from the floor.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City is 4-0 for the first time in 20 years after thumping Case Western Reserve 70-46 on Dec. 4 at the GCC Arena ... Phil Bushre led Grove City with 17 points and four assists in only 19 minutes on the floor ... The Wolverines held Case Western to just 6-of-24 shooting in the first half and forced 21 turnovers for the game ... Grove City has 50 total assists over the past two games ... Case Western was the first team to out-rebound Grove City this season, holding a 35-32 edge on the glass ... The Wolverines led 33-15 at the half ... Grove City has not lost a non-conference home game to a Division III opponent since December 9, 1999, a string of 13 games.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg's offense exploded for consecutive 100-point games over Ohio-Eastern (109-91) on Tuesday and a 61point blowout of Medaille (104-43) at Saturday's home opener ... The Jackets began the week with a 102-86 loss to Wheeling Jesuit on Monday ... Against Ohio-Eastern, Waynesburg head coach Rudy Marisa recorded his 550th career win, while senior Mike Pamepinto scored 35 points en route to tying the school-record with seven three-pointers in the game ... Against Medaille, the Jackets took a 14-0 lead to open the game and never looked back ... Ray Robinson led the Jackets with 24 points, while Mike King tallied 21 ... Pamepinto completed his week with 13 points against Medaille, capping off a week averaging 20.6 ppg.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel went 1-1 in non-conference matchups last week, defeating LaRoche 87-76 on Dec. 2 and falling by one at Allegheny, 82-81, on Dec. 4... Senior F **A.H. Davis** led five Tomcats in double digits, scoring 21 points ... Junior F **Mike Banach** added 15 markers, senior F **Eddie Mathews** finished with 14 and nine rebounds and junior F **D.J. Gambridge** scored 13 points and grabbed a gamehigh 11 rebounds in 14 minutes of action

... Banach was on fire in the Tomcats onepoint loss at Allegheny, pouring in a career-high 32 points on 11-of-15 shooting from the field and 8-of-10 from the free throw line, while senior G **Shane Manley** added 17 points on 5-of-10 shooting from beyond the three-point line.

Westminster Titans

The Titans split a pair of non-conference games at home this week, falling to undefeated Mount Union 83-73 in overtime on Wednesday, then snapping a fourgame losing streak with a 72-65 win over Frostburg State on Saturday ... Senior C Greg Foster led Westminster against MUC with team-high totals of 19 points, 11 rebounds and five blocked shots ... Sophomore G Justin Crum came off the bench to add 16 points and dish out a team-high four assists ... Sophomore G Chris Hatch had a season-high 17 points against FSU, including five three-pointers ... Freshman F Micah Delo added career-high totals of 10 points and six rebounds in 15 minutes off the bench, all in the decisive second half.
