He scored 16 points in the W&J win, hit the game-tying shot with 4.8 seconds left to force overtime against Geneva, then tallied 22 points and seven rebounds in the OT win at Westminster. Gibson was a perfect 9-of-9 at the foul line for the week.

Also nominated was junior F Joe Testa of Bethany, junior W Daniel McKeehan of Thomas More, senior F Wahab Owolabi of Washington & Jefferson, senior G Dan Happe of Waynesburg, and junior F Ryne Murray of Westminster.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2008-09 - Week 3 Conference Notes

CONFERENCE PLAY UNDERWAY: League action in the PAC got underway last week, as both Grove City and Thomas More went unbeaten in league play ... The Wolverines won three contests against PAC opponents (W&J, Geneva, Westminster), while the Saints swept Bethany and Thiel ... The final slate of PAC contests in 2008 will take place with two games this Saturday (December 13), while Westminster will host Thomas More on December 20.

WHO'S HOT: Saint Vincent went 4-0 on the week, culminating with a 96-87 win at No. 24 North Carolina Wesleyan, to improve to a perfect 8-0 on the season ... Thomas More junior W Daniel McKeehan recorded a double-double with 24 points and 11 rebounds for the Saints in a 75-61 home win over Bethany ... Westminster senior F Ryne Murray averaged 24.7 ppg in three Titan losses ... Senior F Wahab Owolabi averaged 11.5 points and 6.5 rebounds for 1-1 Washington & Jefferson.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: With OT wins over Geneva and Westminster, Grove City won back-to-back games in overtime for the first time since joining the NCAA in 1956 ... Geneva has dropped five consecutive games for the first time since the 1998-99 season ... Bethany junior F Joe Testa averaged 16 points and eight rebounds while shooting 65 percent (11-of-17) for the 1-1 Bison ... Freshman Roddy Fuller averaged 20 ppg for 0-2 Thiel last week, including 24 markers in a double-ot loss to Waynesburg.

The Bison opened PAC play with a loss at Thomas More but bounced

back by holding off Waynesburg Saturday ... BC led the Saints 40-29 at the half, but shot just 29 percent and was out-rebounded 25-11 in the 2nd half as TMC rallied for a 75-61 victory ... Dakota Matz led the Bison with 16 and Joe Testa finished with 14 ... A 48-38 rebounding advantage helped Bethany overcome 15 percent (3-of-20) shooting from the arc and escape with a 78-76 triumph over Waynesburg, their 13th straight win over the Yellow Jackets ... Four players scored in double figures, led by Testa with 18 points and a career-high tying 13 rebounds, his second double-double of the year ... Matz added 16, Lance Beckwith chipped in with 14 and Tyler Morando had 10 in the win

Tornadoes (1-5)

Geneva Golden

Geneva opened its PAC schedule last week with GOLDEN TORNADOES losses at Grove City

and Washington & Jefferson ... The Golden Tornadoes have dropped five straight for the first time since the 1998-99 season ... The 14 point loss to Washington & Jefferson was a larger margin than Geneva's previous three losses combined ... In Geneva's 68-64 overtime loss to Grove City, the Golden Tornadoes shot just 25% in the second half and in overtime ... Geneva did feature three players in double figures, while freshman Lambros Svingos picked up a season-high 13 rebounds ... Richard Colick continued his strong early season with a 19 point effort at W&J ... Bryan Hill scored all of his 13 points in the second half against the Presidents.

Grove City Wolverines (5-1, 2-0 PAC)

Grove City picked up the proverbial hat trick in PAC play by

going 3-0 ... Grove City's week began with a 58-44 win over W&J Monday ... The 44 points is the lowest total surrendered by GCC since allowing 28 to D'Youville Feb. 17, 1999 ... It is also Grove City's 14th straight regular-season home win over the Presidents ... Ryan Gibson led the Wolverines with 16 points ... Wednesday, Gibson's jumper with 4.8 seconds left against Geneva tied the game at 57 and sent the game to OT ... In OT, Grove City held the GTs without a field goal over the final 4:37 en route to a 68-64 win ... Saturday, the Wolverines earned a second straight OT win by earning an 89-81 triumph at Westminster ... Gibson and Joe McCoy both had 22 points ... The senior guards combined for 19-of-20 marksmanship at the foul line.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (8-0)

The Bearcats continued their torrid start to the season, win-

ning all four of their games on the busy week ... Monday, the team came from behind to defeat NAIA member Notre Dame (OH) 78-75 ... Four SVC players scored in double-figures, led by 25 points from Joey Butler and 20 from Billy Bains ... SVC picked up its second comeback victory in as many games Wednesday, beating Westminster 67-58 ... SVC trailed for the first 32 minutes before embarking on a 23-14 run to end the game ... Butler turned in a monster performance of 17 points, 14 rebounds, nine assists, and seven steals ... SVC capped off the week by capturing the Taylor Invitational Tournament championship in Rocky Mount, NC, defeating York College 82-66 on Friday and then beating host NC Wesleyan, ranked 24th in the country, 96-87.

Thiel **Tomcats** (1-6, 0-2 PAC)

Wavnesburg outlasted Thiel. 105-104, Wednesday in a

double-overtime affair at Beeghly Gymnasium ... The Tomcats led by as many as 16 in the second period, but the Yellow Jackets 37-of-44 performance from the free throw line erased the advantage ... Freshman Roddy Fuller led Thiel with 24 points and a game-high eight rebounds ... Sophomore Devon Adams poured in 20 points while pacing both teams with seven assists ... Saturday, Thiel fell to 0-2 in PAC play with an 80-65 loss to Thomas More ... The Saints out-rebounded the 'Cats, 34-17, on the afternoon ... Fuller led Thiel in scoring for the fourth time this season by tossing in 16 points ... Senior Brandon Mirizio and junior Cory Chaffee also broke into double-digits with 13 and 11 points, respectively.

Thomas More Saints (5-1, 2-0 PAC)

Thomas More opened PAC play last week as it

defeated the defending league champions, Bethany, 75-61, and Thiel, 80-65 ... Against Bethany, junior W Daniel McKeehan led the way with a double-double as he scored 24 points and pulled down 11 rebounds ... In the win over the Tomcats, the Saints were led by 17 points from senior F Mark Tinklenberg ... Through the Saints' first six games, they are 5-0 when they hold the opposition to 71 points or less and are 0-1 when the opponent scores more then 71 ... McKeehan leads the team in scoring (12.3 ppg.) and rebounding (5.5 rpg.) through the first six games ... Sophomore PG Kurt Bovard leads the team in assists with 14, while junior G Romell Salone leads the team in steals with 10.

Washington & Jefferson **Presidents** (5-3, 0-1 PAC)
