PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

BRODY JACKSON Bethany College 6-0 Senior Guard

Akron, Ohio Manchester H.S.

Jackson averaged 19.5 points, 5.5 rebounds and 5.0 assists per game last week, leading the Bison with a 2-0 mark against PAC opponents Waynesburg

(100-78) and Geneva (96-81). For the week, he shot 67 percent from the field (14-of-21), including 56 percent from threepoint range (9-for-16).

Also nominated was senior G **Shawn Carr** of Grove City, senior F **Joe Herrmann** of Thiel, junior F **Mark Tinklenberg** of Thomas More, junior F **Wahab Owolabi** of Washington & Jefferson, senior G **Tim Drakeley** of Waynesburg, and junior F **Ryne Murray** of Westminster.

Bethany Bison



The Bison got back on track last week with a pair of double-digit victories ... BC saw a 24point second half lead cut to 10 at Waynesburg, but Bethany closed the game with an

18-6 run to secure a 100-78 triumph, their 11th consecutive over the Yellow Jackets ... Seven Bison hit for double figures in the game, led by Brody Jackson's 21 and Tyler Morando's 16 ... Saturday, Aaron Huffman earned his 100th career victory with a 96-81 win over Geneva ... Leading by 14 at the half, BC opened the second period with a 17-6 spurt to build a 25-point lead ... The Bison, who shot 73 percent (16-22) in the second half, were again led by Jackson with 18, while Petre Petkovski tallied 15.

Saint Vincent Bearcats



The Bearcats enjoyed a 3-0 week, defeating Franciscan, Juniata and Waynesburg ... In the double-OT marathon against Juniata Wednesday, four Bearcats scored

in double figures, led by Joey Butler with 21 points while adding eight assists ... Freshman BJ McGill poured in a careerhigh 21, while lan McCollough posted the double-double with 18 points and 12 rebounds ... A strong second half propelled Saint Vincent to a big win over PAC rival Wavnesburg Saturday ... After taking a 38-37 lead into halftime, the Bearcats outscored Wavnesburg 51-29 over the final 20 minutes, shooting a staggering 70 percent (19-27) in the second half.

Washington & Jefferson Presidents



W&J suffered a pair of close losses this week ... The Presidents held a 10-point advantage (46-36) with 15 minutes left at Geneva on Wednesday, but the Golden Tornadoes answered with a

24-6 run over the next eight minutes ... Sophomore G/F Albert Varacallo paced the Presidents with 22 points on 7-of-15 shooting ... Junior F Wahab Owolabi added 18 points and nine rebounds, while sophomore G Matt Drakeley contributed 11 points, four assists and four rebounds ... Shawn Carr nailed an off-balance three-pointer at the buzzer to lift GCC to the win Saturday in Washington ... Junior C Josip Lucic-Jozak finished with 14 points, while junior G Derek Syrylo added 12 points and four assists.


Geneva Golden Tornadoes

Northen's 20-point effort off the bench ... Northen was 6-for-6 from the field in leading Geneva back from eight points down in the second half ... Bryan Hill was 7-for-11 from three-point range and led the Golden Tornadoes with 21 points ... On Saturday, Geneva's offense was held in check as the Golden Tornadoes managed just three treys all night in a 15-point loss at Bethany ... The lone bright spots were Northen's 16 points and Mike Ross, who posted 15 points and six rebounds in the loss.

Herrmann also finished with eight rebounds, while Adams added five rebounds and seven assists ... Sophomore G Cory Chaffee chipped in with 15 while junior G Brandon Mirizio added 10.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets



The Yellow Jackets continued their recent struggles last losing to Bethany, 100-78, and at Saint Vincent, 89-66 ... Against the Bison, se-

nior G Tim Drakeley scored a game-high 28 points with five three-pointers, while senior F Josh Parisi added 22 points and seven rebounds ... Waynesburg shot 41.9 percent (26-of-62) from the field, but committed 17 turnovers which were converted into 27 points ... The Yellow Jackets suffered a 23-point loss to the Bearcats after being down just one point at halftime, 38-37 ... Drakeley led the team with 23 points and five three-pointers in the loss, while Parisi posted 18 points and seven rebounds.

Grove City Wolverines



Grove City ran its win streak to six last week with a pair of PAC wins ... Wednesday, five GCC players scored in double figures in a 102-98 over-

time win over Westminster ... Andy O'Keefe posted career-high totals of 20 points and six assists ... Ryan Gibson also fired in 20 points while Shawn Carr (18), Joe McCoy (17) and Luke Tomaselli (11) reached double figures ... The Wolverines shot 14of-22 from behind the three-point line ... Saturday, Carr's three-pointer at the buzzer gave Grove City a 58-55 win at W&J ... Carr became the program's all-time leader in three-pointers with 160 on his game-winner ... He led all scorers with 16 points ... Gibson added 12 points.


Thomas More Saints

the PAC, and tied its win total of the previous two seasons combined ... He had backto-back double-doubles this week, including a 13-point, 13-rebound effort in the win over Westminster ... The TMC reserves, led by Jeremy Abell and Daniel Ellis, came up big in the two wins ... Abell and Ellis were second and third in scoring with 14.0 and 11.0 points, respectively ... Five Thomas More players averaged double figures as the Saints scored 87 points per game ... Sophomore Romell Salone tallied a careerhigh 17 points in the Westminster victory.

Westminster Titans



Murray averaged 18 points and 8.3 rebounds for the Titans and a team-best four blocks and four steals for the week, including 24 points and 10 boards vs. Allegheny ... Senior G Craig Hannon averaged 16.7 points last week, including 21 at Thomas More to move him into the Top 10 on Westminster's career scoring list with 1,387 points ... Five of Westminster's eight losses this year were by four points or less.
