# PAC Men's Basketball Player of the Week

#### **NOLAN LARRY**

#### Washington & Jefferson College

6-2 Junior Guard Greensburg, PA/Greensburg Salem H.S.

Larry earned PAC Player of the Week honors for the second time this season after scoring a career-high 35 points on 10-of-18 shooting from the field and 14-of-16 accuracy from the foul line, leading Washington & Jefferson to a come-from-behind 87-82 road win at Cincinnati Bible. Larry added five assists, five rebounds and five steals in the victory. He currently leads the PAC in scoring at 29.0 ppg.

Also nominated was senior forward Keith Schubert of Bethany, sophomore forward **Tanner Prosser** of Grove City, and junior guard **Ray Robinson** of Waynesburg.

# PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

#### **Bethany Bison**

The Bison started the week with a pair of wins at the Wheeling Jesuit Tournament before dropping a home contest to Frostburg State ... In a 108-100 victory over D-II Wheeling Jesuit, the first Bethany win over the Cardinals since 1981, Keith Schubert scored 34 and Nevada Smith fired in 23 as the Bison shot 91 percent (29-32) from the foul line ... The next night, Bethany held on for a 95-87 win over Ohio-Eastern ... Schubert again led the way with 36 points, which included a 17-18 performance from the line, while Mike Majzun added 17 and Smith canned 14 in the victory ... Against Frostburg, the Bison shot just 37 percent ... Schubert had 23 points and nine boards, while Majzun tossed in 21 markers.

#### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J bounced back from a 45-44 half-time deficit to defeat Cincinnati Bible, 87-82, on Thursday evening in Cincinnati, Ohio ... Junior guard Nolan Larry led all scorers with 35 points, while sophomore center Tony Franz added a double-double with 22 markers and 10 rebounds ... Larry also added five rebounds, assists and steals in the win, while going 10-of-18 from the floor and 14-of-16 from the charity stripe ... Sophomore forward Scott Chodor also added 10 points and nine rebounds.

### **Grove City Wolverines**

The Wolverines led NAIA-rival Geneva, 53-52, with under five minutes left, but were outscored 12-2 the rest of the way and lost, 64-55 ... Grove City rebounded with a 74-55 victory at Case Western Reserve as **Tanner Prosser** and **Andy Vlajkovich** netted 14 points apiece and **Pat Roberts** recorded his second double-double of the season with 10 points and 10 boards ... Roberts hit 7 of 10 shots from the floor last week, blocked three shots and averaged 10 rebounds per game ... The Wolverines were 5-2 after seven games last year.

#### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Jackets raced to an early 20-point lead over the Mount Aloysius Mounties to run their winning streak to three games with a 79-61 victory on Wednesday ... Junior **Aaron Ankrom** led the Jackets on the boards with 13 rebounds, while adding 11 points for a "double double" ... Junior **Ray Robinson** led all scorers with 22 points.

#### Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats picked up their first victory of the 2001-02 season last Wednesday, defeating Carnegie Mellon 71-69 in overtime at CMU's Skibo Gym ... **Erik Hemsing** hit 5-of-11 threes for 19 points to lead the Cats ... **Shane Manley** added 10 in the win ... As a team, Thiel hit 10-of-22 (45.5%) from behind the three-point arc.

#### Westminster Titans

Westminster posted an 82-67 win over Mount Aloysius in its only game of the week ... Westminster led 40-25 at the half and by as many as 21 in the second half before emptying the bench ... The Mounties, who dressed only eight players, played the final 2:51 with four players after four players had fouled out ... Junior center Greg Foster posted career-high totals of 14 points and nine rebounds for the Titans in his second career start ... Senior forward Ryan Oman tied Foster for team-high scoring honors with 14 points, including 12 in the second half on four three-pointers ... Junior guard Jeff Simmons added 11 markers off the bench, while Rick Giordano added a team-high six assists.
