#### NICK WILCOX Bethany

Wilcox averaged 21.5 points, 8.0 rebounds, 5.0 assists and 5.0 steals per game for the unbeaten Bison. Bethany continued its best start since 1963-64 with victories over Carnegie Mellon (88-75) and PAC rival Thomas More (89-74), which handed the Saints their first PAC loss of the season. He scored 16 of his 24 points in the second half of the CMU win, then posted his second double-double of the year with 19 points, 11 boards, six assists and four steals vs. TMC.

Also nominated was senior F **Lambros Svingos** of Geneva, junior G/F **Blair Rozenblad** of Thiel, senior SG **Todd Krohman** of Thomas More, freshman G **Andy Carter** of Washington & Jefferson, senior G **Larry Alexander** of Waynesburg, and freshman G **Ben Donlow** of Westminster.

### PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2011-12 - Week 4 Conference Notes

**FOUR IN THE BOOKS:** The December slate of four PAC conference dates is officially in the books, with only two teams remaining unbeaten in conference play ... Defending PAC tournament champion and unbeaten Bethany continued its best start since 1963-64 with a PAC win over Thomas More, who was previously perfect in PAC play ... 2010-11 PAC regular season champion Thiel is 4-0 in league action after topping Westminster and Saint Vincent last week.

**NEWS & NOTES:** Bethany received votes in last week's [D3Hoops.com](http://D3Hoops.com) national Top 25 poll ... Senior SG **Todd Krohman** lifted Thomas More past Washington & Jefferson 67-66 Wednesday on a 30-foot three-pointer as the final buzzer sounded ... Thiel junior G/F **Blair Rozenblad** averaged 16.5 ppg and 9.0 rpg on the week for the 2-0 Tomcats ... Senior F **Lambros Svingos** averaged a double-double with 15.0 ppg and 11.5 rpg while leading Geneva to a 2-0 week vs. PAC opponents.

**AROUND THE LEAGUE:** Freshman G **Andy Carter** buried a 13-foot baseline jumper as time expired Saturday to break a 63-63 tie and lift W&J past Westminster ... Waynesburg senior G **Larry Alexander** poured in a career-high 25 points in a PAC loss at Geneva ... Freshman G **Ben Donlow** averaged a double-double with 18.5 ppg and 10.5 rpg for 0-2 Westminster ... **Kris Verderber** averaged 11.5 ppg for 1-1 Grove City ... **Isaac Turner** paced Saint Vincent with 18 points and six boards in a loss to Grove City.

# PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

## Bethany Bison (8-0, 3-0 PAC)



With two wins last week, the Bison, who received votes in last week's [D3Hoops.com](http://D3Hoops.com) Top 25 poll, remained undefeated and continued its best start since the 1963-64 BC team went undefeated ... Bethany shot 53 percent in the second half against Carnegie Mellon Tuesday to overcome a three-point halftime deficit and claim an 88-75 victory ... **Nick Wilcox** scored 24 to lead the Bison, while **Reece Mabery** tallied 18 ... BC went 7-for-11 from the arc in the first half against Thomas More to build a 16-point halftime lead and went on to beat the Saints 89-74 ... Wilcox was huge in the win with 19 points, 11 rebounds, six assists and four steals ... Mabery matched him with 19 markers and **British Alexander** notched a double-double as well with 18 points and 15 boards.

## Geneva Golden Tornadoes (3-6, 2-2 PAC)



Bringing a six-game losing streak into its game with Waynesburg, the Geneva men got top-notch performances from a trio of players to help put an end to the streak and give the Golden Tornadoes their first-ever PAC victory ... **David Phillips** posted 19 points while teammates **Drew Santarsiero** (17) and **Lambros Svingos** (16) each helped the scoring load ... Geneva's 77-72 win was not only the first PAC win, but it was also the 250th victory at Geneva for head coach **Jeff Santarsiero**, who became only the second head coach in Geneva basketball history to reach the mark ... The GTs used that momentum Saturday for a 64-60 victory at Grove City to even their PAC record at 2-2 ... Svingos picked up his second consecutive double-double with 14 points and 13 rebounds.

## Grove City Wolverines (4-4, 1-3 PAC)



Grove City went 1-1 in PAC play last week and posted a net point differential of zero ... Wednesday night, GCC rallied from a 31-23 halftime deficit to stun host Saint Vincent 58-54 ... Grove City held Saint Vincent to 33 percent shooting from the field ... **Kris Verderber** (11), **Mitch Marmelstein** (10) and **J.T. Schwartz** (10) all scored in double figures for the Wolverines ... GCC owned a 45-36 edge on the glass ... No Wolverine played more than 24 minutes ... Saturday, Grove City allowed Geneva to shoot 65 percent from the field in the second half as the Wolverines fell at home 64-60 ... The Wolverines forced 26 turnovers but yielded 44 second-half points ... Verderber (12) and Schwartz (11) each scored in double figures ... **Brett Matson** added eight points and nine rebounds ... Schwartz had four of Grove City's 13 steals.

## Saint Vincent Bearcats (5-3, 1-2 PAC)



The Bearcats dropped a pair of PAC contests this weekend to fall to 1-2 in league action to begin the season ... In the 58-54 PAC home-opening loss to Grove City, sophomore **Isaac Turner** led all scorers with 18 points while also pulling down six rebounds and collecting four assists. In the game, senior G **Dennis Bassich** saw his streak of 15-straight double-digit point performances snapped as he finished with eight points on just 2-of-11 from the field ... At Thiel on Saturday, Bassich rebounded with 16 points, highlighted by 7-of-8 from the free-throw line and junior **Armani Fountain** chipped in 10 points.

## Thiel Tomcats (6-2, 4-0 PAC)



The Tomcats gained two more PAC wins last week against Westminster (78-61) and Saint Vincent (86-69) ... Against Westminster, junior **Ladell Trotty** had the most impressive performance of his Tomcat career, finishing the game with 22 points on 10-of-14 shooting to go along with 17 rebounds ... His 17 boards are the most for the Tomcats since junior **Blair Rozenblad** notched 18 in Thiel's 77-64 victory over Westminster on Jan. 11 ... Against Saint Vincent, junior **Chace McKinney** scored a career-best 21 points on 6-of-9 shooting from the floor and 7-of-7 from the foul line ... Trotty added 15 points and five assists in 21 minutes while Rozenblad chipped in 12 points, 10 rebounds, three assists and three steals ... Junior **AJ Forbes** finished with eight points, eight assists, six rebounds and a pair of blocks.

## Thomas More Saints (7-2, 3-1 PAC)



Thomas More split a pair of PAC contests last week as it defeated W&J, 67-66, but fell to Bethany, 89-74 ... Senior SG **Todd Krohman** led the Saints in scoring last week as he averaged 11.5 points per game ... He scored six points against W&J, including the game-winning three-pointer from 30-feet out as the buzzer sounded and then followed that up with a career-high-tying 17 points against Bethany ... Sophomore PG **Spencer Berlekamp** averaged 10.0 ppg., as he scored 11 points against W&J and nine points against Bethany ... Senior C **Colt Stafford** recorded his first double-double of the season against Bethany as he had 12 points and 10 rebounds ... For the season, junior SF **Phil Feinberg** leads the team in scoring and rebounding as he averages 13.2 ppg., and 7.1 rpg.

## Washington & Jefferson Presidents (4-5, 1-2 PAC)



W&J earned its first PAC win of the season with a buzzer-beating victory versus Westminster Saturday after falling to Thomas More three days earlier in the same fashion ... Wednesday, W&J led the Saints for nearly the entire game before **Todd Krohman** hit a 30-foot jumper at the buzzer ... Freshman G **Mike Resnik** led the Presidents with a career-high 13 points ... The game featured eight ties and nine lead changes ... On Saturday, freshman G **Andy Carter** received the inbounds pass with 2.4 seconds remaining in regulation and drilled a baseline jumper to give W&J its first league win ... Carter scored 17 second-half points and led the team with 19 overall ... Junior G **Zach Bellhy** added 16 points and five rebounds ... Four of W&J's last five games have been decided on buzzer-beating shots.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (2-7, 0-3 PAC)



The Waynesburg University men's basketball team dropped a pair of road games this past week, including a heart-breaking 77-72 PAC setback at Geneva on Wednesday ... Senior G **Larry Alexander** had a huge game against the Golden Tornadoes, pouring in a game-high 25 points on a 9-of-15 shooting performance from the field that included five made three-pointers ... With 1:43 left to play in the game, Waynesburg took a 12-point deficit all the way down to just two, but Geneva made three clutch free throws to seal the win ... Junior C **Kurt Bonnet** scored a team-high 12 points in an 84-60 road loss at Malone University.

## Westminster Titans (2-6, 1-3 PAC)



Westminster lost two PAC games last week, at home to Thiel, 78-61, Wednesday and at Washington & Jefferson, 65-63, Saturday ... W&J led for only 68 seconds of the game before winning at the buzzer ... Freshman G **Ben Donlow** led the Titans during the week with averages of 18.5 points and 10.5 rebounds, while his 2.0 assists per game ranked second on the team ... Donlow has posted a double-double in three straight games as he logged 19 points and 11 rebounds vs. Thiel and 18 points and 10 rebounds vs. W&J ... Junior F **Adam Carswell** led Westminster with a career-high 22 points and 10 rebounds in the W&J game ... Junior G **Doug Smith** averaged 15 points for the Titans with 17 vs. Thiel and 13 vs. W&J.
