He tallied a team-high 22 points in a 77-71 non-league loss at Allegheny Monday, then posted a double-double with 24 points and 10 rebounds in an 84-73 road PAC victory at Washington & Jefferson.

Also nominated was junior F British Alexander of Bethany, freshman G Willis Fleming of Thomas More, sophomore G Zach Bellhy of Washington & Jefferson, junior F Jeff Young of Waynesburg, and sophomore G Doug Smith of Westminster.



PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2010-11 - Week 4 Conference Notes

WRAPPING UP 2010: The final slate of conference basketball games prior to the Christmas/New Year holiday break took place on Sat., Dec. 11 ... Thiel and Thomas More joined Bethany atop the PAC standings at 2-0, as the Tomcats defeated W&J 84-73, while the Saints edged visiting Westminster 79-77 ... Bethany was also victorious over Geneva 76-62, while Waynesburg upset defending PAC champion Grove City 63-57 ... Saint Vincent had the weekend off.

NEWS & NOTES: Geneva upset #22-ranked NAIA member Malone 81-77 behind 26 points by senior Rich Colick on Wednesday ... Waynesburg (3-3) eclipsed last year's win total (2-22) with its win at Grove City, which ended a 22-game skid vs. PAC opponents for the Yellow Jackets ... Junior F British Alexander posted 19 points, nine rebounds and four assists for Bethany in its win over Geneva ... Freshman SG Willis Fleming paced Thomas More vs. Westminster with a career-high 18 points.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Grove City limited Penn State-Altoona to 37 points Wednesday, the program's fewest points allowed in a game since 1999 ... Sophomore G Zach Bellhy averaged 23.5 ppg and 3.0 apg for 1-1 Washington & Jefferson ... Senior PG Devon Adams scored a game-high 29 points for Thiel at W&J ... Westminster sophomore G Doug Smith bucketed a game-high 23 points in a two-point Titan loss at Thomas More ... Saint Vincent will end a 14-day break at Penn St.-Fayette Saturday.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (6-3, 2-0 PAC)

In their only action of the week, the Bison shot 54 percent (14-of-26) in the



second half, including 67 percent (6-of-9) from the arc, to pull away for a 76-62 win at Geneva ... British Alexander had 13 in the opening period, as the game was tied at 36 going into halftime ... With the game tied 52, Brady Pacific scored five straight, which was followed by a Dustin Opalka trey and six consecutive markers by Nick Wilcox and the 14-0 run gave BC control of the game ... Alexander finished the night with 19 points, nine rebounds and four steals, while Wilcox posted 18 points, six assists and six rebounds and Opalka fired in 11 of his 14 in the second half ... The Bethany defense forced 18 Geneva turnovers and held the top scoring team in the PAC to 28 percent (7-of-28) shooting after halftime.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (6-2, 1-1 PAC)

After playing seven games in a 15-day span, the Bearcats

were off on the week, and will return to action this Saturday at Penn State-Fayette ... Through their first eight games, SVC ranks second in the PAC in scoring defense, allowing just 66.2 points per game, while offensively, freshman Isaac Turner leads the PAC in scoring, averaging 18.9 points per game, just ahead of teammate BJ McGill's average of 17.8 points ... McGill is also second in assists in the conference, averaging 6.13 apg, while freshman Grant Latus tops the PAC with 18 blocked shots.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (6-3)

The week opened with Geneva's men cruising GOLDEN TORNADOES past Penn State Beaver


in Monaca by the score of 79-56 ... It was another long distance party for the Golden Tornadoes with 11 three-point field goals ... David Phillips was a perfect 5-for-5 in the game and scored a team-best 17 points ... Wednesday. Geneva shocked 22nd-ranked Malone in Canton 81-77 ... Playing their former NAIA rivals, the GTs used a 52-point second half to upset the Pioneers ... Rich Colick scored 26 points and Lambros Svingos posted a doubledouble with 15 points and 10 rebounds ... The winning did not continue Saturday as the GTs dropped a 76-62 decision to visiting Bethany for their first home loss of the season ... A 14-0 second half run by the Bison proved to be the difference.

Grove City Wolverines (4-4, 1-2 PAC)

Grove City dropped to 1-2 in the PAC Saturday with a 63-57 set-

back against visiting Waynesburg ... The Wolverines led 55-53 late but Waynesburg rallied for the win ... Luke Tomaselli led GCC with 16 points ... Brett Matson and Sam Barnhill both had 11 points each ... Wednesday, the Wolverines rolled to a 61-37 win over Penn State Altoona ... The 37 points are the fewest allowed by the Wolverines since 1999 ... Grove City broke the game open with a 24-5 run in the first half ... Matson led Grove City with 16 points ... Mike Grist made his first collegiate start and scored a career-high 13 points ... Along with allowing just 48 points against W&J on Dec. 4, Grove City assembled a two-game stretch of allowing just 85 points ... That's the lowest two-game point total allowed since the introduction of the shot clock.

Thiel **Tomcats** (6-3, 2-0 PAC)



to push their overall record to 6-3 on the season and 2-0 in PAC play... In the first game of the week, the Tomcats were defeated by Allegheny, 77-71 ... Three Tomcats scored in double figures ... Sophomore G Blair Rozenblad led the way, scoring 22 points ... Sophomore Fs Ladell Trotty and Aundra Jones added 19 and 12 points, respectively ... Shooting was the downfall of the Tomcats, as they were 2-14 from three-point range in the game and just 11-20 from the line in the second half ... Game two saw better fortune for the Tomcats as they defeated the Presidents of W&J, 84-73 ... Senior G Devon Adams led the team in scoring with a seasonhigh 29 points ... Rozenblad registered his fifth double-double with 24 points and 10 rebounds.

Thomas More Saints (4-2, 2-0 PAC)

Thomas More defeated Westminster, 79-77 in its

lone game last week ... Freshman SG Willis Fleming led the Saints with a career-high 18 points in the game ... Joining him in doublefigures was freshman PG Spencer Berlekamp and junior SG Ross Renken with 11 points each and junior C Colt Stafford with 10 points ... Stafford led the team in rebounds with eight and steals with four, while **Berlekamp** and Renken led the team in assists with five each ... For the season the Saints are led in scoring and rebounding by senior SG Aaron Miller, who is averaging 16.3 points per game and 7.5 rebounds per game.

Washington & Jefferson **Presidents** (3-7, 0-2 PAC)

... The Presidents reached the 100-point mark for the first time since Feb. 4, 2006 ... W&J shot 59 percent (39-of-66) and were led by career-high scoring efforts from senior Brian Felker (25) and sophomore Zach Bellhy (23) ... Senior G Paul Matthews had a solid overall game with 16 points, nine rebounds, six assists, four steals and two blocks in only 26 minutes of action ... Bellhy recorded another career-high four days later with 24 points in the loss to Thiel ... The Tomcats held the Presidents without a basket for seven minutes in the second half and used an 18-1 run to take command ... Matthews finished with 22 points, four rebounds and four assists, while Felker contributed 15 points and six boards.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (3-3, 1-1 PAC)

sity men's basketball team had plenty to celebrate after its 63-57 PAC victory at Grove City on Saturday ... It was the first conference win for first-year head coach Mark Christner and it halted a 22-game PAC losing streak for the Yellow Jackets, who are now 3-3 on the season and 1-1 in PAC play ... With victory number three secured, Waynesburg has already surpassed last year's two-win total and it ended an eight-game losing streak to the defending PAC champions ... Junior F Jeff Young and junior G Luke Baker each tallied a team-high 14 points as reserves ... For Baker, it was the most points he's put up as a Yellow Jacket ... Young also led Waynesburg with six rebounds ... Another non-starter, sophomore C Kurt Bonnet, chipped in 10 big points to the winning effort.

Westminster has now




