# PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### TANNER PROSSER

Grove City College 6-4 Senior Forward Pittsburgh, Pa./Brentwood H.S.

Prosser became the 20th player in Grove City men's basketball history to surpass 1,000 career points as he posted 19 markers in a 67-62 loss to Denison last week. He also added a 10-point, 10-rebound double-double in a 67-59 win over Kenyon.

Also nominated was sophomore G/F Mike Drahos of Bethany, senior F D.J. Gambridge of Thiel, senior G Mike King of Waynesburg, and sophomore G Mark DeMonaco of Westminster.

## PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

#### Bethany Bison

Sophomore Matt Drahos pulled down a career-high 15 rebounds in the 61-51 win over D'Youville on Tuesday ... His previous best had been 13, accomplished last year ... Matt's twin brother, Mike Drahos, tied his careerhigh with 13 boards in the same game ... He had come close to breaking his career-best rebound total on numerous occasions this year, recording 12 rebounds in a game three times.

#### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J was idle this past week, but returns to action on Wednesday evening by traveling to Greensburg, Pa., to take on Pitt-Greensburg at 7 p.m. ... The Bobcats have posted a 3-4 record so far this season, but hold a two-game winning streak ... The Presidents round out the 2003 portion of their schedule on Dec. 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> at the Randolph-Macon Tournament in Ashland, Va.

### Grove City Wolverines

Grove City continues its roller-coaster start to the 2003-04 season having no win or losing streak longer than one game this year to date as the Wolverines went 1-1 last week ... Senior F Tanner Prosser became Grove City's 20th 1,000-point scorer with a 19-point effort against Denison Friday night ... Prosser helped Grove City erase a 14-point hole in the second half but the Wolverines could not hold on for the win ... Prosser is 20th all-time in Grove City history with 1,003 points ... Junior F Ryan Eller added 18 points, including a career-best four three-point goals ... Eller also had his first career doubledouble Tuesday at Kenyon with 18 points and 10 rebounds while Prosser also posted 10 points and 10 rebounds ... G Mike Lukcic tossed in a season-high 15 points in the win.

#### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg remained unbeaten on its home court Saturday night with an unlikely 78-72 win over visiting Notre Dame College of Ohio, the same team that defeated the Jackets by 28 points in both teams' last games on Dec. 6 ... The Jackets, out-rebounded by a combined 100-44 in both games against the Falcons this year, managed to erase a 15point first-half deficit for the win ... Mike King scored a season-high 27 points ... King sank a three to tie the game, 43-43, with 16:54 remaining in the game ... He scored again on a jumper with 14:38 to give Waynesburg its first lead of the game, 45-43 ... Both teams went back-and-forth until King's threepointer with 3:22 left gave Waynesburg a six-point lead ... Freshman guard Beau Wilson led the Jackets with a mere four rebounds, to go with his 19 points.

#### Thiel Tomcats

The Thiel men's basketball team was dealt a staggering blow Thursday with the passing of freshman F Shawn Walton, but the team decided to stay the course and play Saturday's game against Hiram ... The Tomcats battled all evening and eventually rallied to deal Hiram a 76-73 loss... Thiel had five players score in double figures, led by senior F D.J. Gambridge's 14-point, sevenrebound effort ... Senior F Mike Banach was just two rebounds shy of his first doubledouble of the season, finishing with 13 points, eight rebounds and six assists ... Senior G Ryan Singleton continued his terrific play off the bench with 12 points, while junior G Daryl Moore and freshman G Chris Kwolek each added 11 ... The Tomcats shot 51 percent (27-of-53) from the floor.

#### Westminster Titans

Westminster dropped to 1-5 as the Titans suffered their fifth consecutive setback since a season-opening win with an 80-61 nonconference loss at Wooster ... Wooster, who advanced to the NCAA Division III Final Four before finishing third in the nation a year ago, improved to 6-1 with the win ... The Scots never trailed in the contest, taking a 38-29 halftime lead ... Wooster held a double-digit lead for the final 19:16 of the contest ... For Westminster, sophomore G Mark DeMonaco led the way with a gamehigh 21 points including six three-pointers, while adding team-best totals of six rebounds and five steals ... Junior Gs Ed Pagleyand Chris Hatch added 12 and 10 points, respectively, for the Titans, while Pagley tied junior forward Pat O'Connor for team assist honors with three each.
