BC, W&J ON TOP: The final conference games of 2009 were played this past Saturday, with Bethany and Washington & Jefferson finishing the day tied for the PAC lead at 2-0. The Bison topped Geneva 76-64 in a contest that did not count in the league standings, while W&J was victorious at Thiel, 78-65. In other league action, defending PAC champion Thomas More got its first league win, 95-80, at Westminster, while Grove City kept Waynesburg winless with a 76-59 decision.

NEWS & NOTES: Bethany freshman G/F Nick Wilcox posted 14 points, six boards, four blocks, three steals and two assists in a win over Geneva ... The GTs saw their four-game win streak snapped at Bethany despite 20 points and 10 rebounds by Rich Colick ... Junior G B.J. McGill poured in a game-high 33 points for Saint Vincent in a loss at Hood ... Sophomore G Ben Altmeyer posted 18 points, nine rebounds, three assists and three steals for Waynesburg in a PAC loss to Grove City.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Thomas More's game at Capital Thursday is a rematch of the NCAA Tournament 1st round game between the schools last year, won by the Crusaders 80-77 in overtime ... Grove City senior C Andy O'Keefe averaged 23 ppg and 7.5 rpg in a 1-1 week ... W&J junior G Brian Felker had a career-high 24 points against Kenyon ... Thiel freshman G Blair Rozenblad averaged 16.5 ppg and 5.5 rpg for the 1-1 Tomcats ... Westminster junior G Max Spinner averaged 12.0 ppg for the 0-2 Titans.

The Bison ran their winning streak to three with a 76-64 home victory

A 14-2 BC run just after the midway point of the second half blew open a tied game and Geneva was within single digits just once the rest of the day ... In addition to forcing 21 GT turnovers, Bethany's bench outscored Geneva's 23-9 in the victory and turned 19 offensive rebounds into 19 secondchance points ... A balanced Bison scoring attack featured 5 players with nine or more points, including a trio of 14-point efforts by Nick Wilcox (six rebs., four blks.), Dustin Opalka (six stls., four asst.) and Joe Testa (seven rebs.) ... The BC bench was sparked by Jonas Ankrom with 10 points and Nick Thomas with nine.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (5-4)

In the only action of the week for the Geneva GOLDEN TORNADOES College men's basket-

ball team, the Golden Tornadoes dropped a 76-64 decision at Bethany on Saturday afternoon ... Despite 20 points from **Rich Colick** on 6-9 shooting and ten rebounds, Geneva saw its four-game winning streak come to an end ... The Golden Tornadoes were seeking their first five-game winning streak since 2005 ... **Lambros Svingos** scored 13 points and **Dave Phillips** added 11 points in the loss ... Geneva will enjoy a three-week lay-off before traveling to Florida for games against Florida Tech and Flagler on December 28th and 29th ... The Golden Tornadoes get back into PAC play after the new year at Thomas More on January 2nd.

Grove City Wolverines (4-4, 2-1 PAC)

Grove City moved to 2-1 in the PAC Saturday with a come-

from-behind win at Waynesburg ... Andy O'Keefe paced the Wolverines with a 21-point, 10-rebound double-double ... He also blocked five shots ... Luke Tomaselli (13), Joe McCoy (12) and Brett Matson (10) all scored in double figures ... Grove City went 22-for-23 at the foul line in the second half and 27-of-30 for the game ... Grove City also dominated on the glass, owning a 41-26 rebound edge ... Wednesday, the Wolverines' comeback efforts fell short in a 68-65 setback at Hiram ... O'Keefe matched a career-high with 25 points while senior Andrew DiDonato fired in 12 points on four three-point goals ... Grove City trailed by 11 in the second half before rallying to tie the game in the closing moments.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (3-5)

The Bearcats saw their losing streak extend to four games, dropping their only contest of the week, a 75-70 decision at Hood College on Friday night ... Despite the defeat, junior BJ McGill turned in another strong performance, scoring 33 points to go with nine rebounds and three steals ... Mike Watkins added 15 points and 11 rebounds, while Maurice Hawkins turned in a career-high nine assists ... The Bearcats led 35-27 at halftime, before Hood outscored SVC 47-35 over the final 20 minutes for the comeback win ... Saint Vincent committed 36 fouls, with four players fouling out, and Hood took advantage by scoring 36 points from the free throw line.

Through the first seven games of the season, **McKeehan** leads the team in both scoring and rebounding as he averages 14.1 points per game and 5.9 rebounds per game ... As a team, the Saints are shooting 47.2 percent from the field on 218-of-462 shooting and has a PAC-leading 101 steals.

Westminster Titans (2-6, 0-2 PAC)




Westminster dropped
