PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

MIKE MAJZUN Bethany College

6-3 Senior Guard Youngstown, Ohio/Struthers H.S.

Maizun led the Bison to a 2-1 week, with the lone loss coming at #25 ranked Franklin & Marshall, averaging 24.6 points per game in the three contests. He had a career-high 32 points, including six three-pointers, in a win over Kenyon and had 24 points (including the 1,000thpoint of his career) in a win over Penn State-Altoona. Majzun closed the week with 18 points against F&M. He shot 60 percent (15-of-25) from 3-point range for the week.

Also nominated was sophomore G/F Nate Maurer of Grove City, senior C Aaron Ankrom of Waynesburg, and senior C Greg Foster of Westminster.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bison picked up their first two wins of the year this week before suffering a historic loss at #25 F&M Saturday ... Mike Majzun had a career-high 32 points, while Derek Hoffman (22 points, 14 rebounds) and Josh Polantz (11 points, 11 assists) recorded double-doubles in the Kenyon win, which was Head Coach Aaron Huffman's first at Bethany ... With 24 points in the PSU-Altoona win, Majzun became the 16th Bethany player to score 1,000 for his career ... Hoffman (19 points, 10 rebounds), Polantz (13 points, 10 assists) and Matt Drahos (17 points, 10 rebounds) posted double-doubles ... The loss to #25 F&M was the worst in Bethany history, replacing a 60-point loss against David Robinson and Navy in 1985.

Washington & Jefferson was off last week ... The Presidents return to action on Sat., Dec. 21 at NCAA Division I Davidson.

Grove City Wolverines

The Wolverines improved to 6-0 with two double-digit victories last week ... Sophomore Nate Maurer fired in a career-high 32 points Saturday as Grove City won at Denison ... Maurer also led Grove City with 14 points against La Roche ... In both games, four Wolverines scored in double figures ... Tanner Prosser collected 13 points, eight rebounds and four assists against La Roche, while point guard Mike Lukcic had 10 points and a season-high seven assists at Denison ... Currently, five Wolverine regulars have more assists than turnovers ... Grove City will be tested when the Wolverines face defending national champion Otterbein on Dec. 27.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

A desperation three-pointer by Ray Robinson sailed wide left as Waynesburg could not come back to beat La Roche ... The Redhawks escaped with an 84-83 non-conference win at the Marisa Fieldhouse ... Aaron Ankrom scored 26, which included his 1,000th career points, and a jumper with 28 seconds remaining to pull the Jackets within one point ... The Jackets retained possession with 15 seconds remaining, but could not advance the ball past the threepoint line, as Robinson tracked down a loose ball and attempted a last-second heave ... Robinson scored a game-high 28 points, while teammate Mike King tallied 17 and four assists ... Dom Joseph led the Redhawks (3-3) with 16 rebounds and 17 points.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel fell Saturday at Pitt-Bradford 85-77 in the only contest of the week for the Tomcats ... The Cats held a two-point lead (40-38) at the half but were outscored in the second half by the Panthers 47-32 ... Senior F **A.H. Davis** finished with 21 points and five rebounds while senior G **Shane Manley** scored 19, connecting on 6-of-8 three-pointers ... Junior F **Mike Banach** added 11 points, eight rebounds and a career-high eight assists.

Westminster Titans

The Titans won their second straight game on Monday, as Westminster defeated Penn State-Behrend 54-40 in a non-conference contest at Buzz Ridl Gymnasium ... The Titans led by as many as 14 points in the first half and continued to build the lead early in the second period, leading by as many as 20 points on two occasions ... Leading the way was the duo of senior C Greg Foster and sophomore G Justin Crum with a gamehigh 12 points apiece ... Foster added a game-high 12 rebounds and three blocked shots, giving him his fifth "double-double" in points and rebounds in seven games this season ... Sophomore G Chris Hatch added eight points, while senior G/F Jeff Simmons dished out a team-best three assists.
