# TIM DRAKELEY Waynesburg University

5-6 Senior Guard Washington, Pa. Trinity H.S.

Drakeley earned his second PAC Player of the Week honor this season after averaging 22.0 points per game in Yellow Jacket non-league wins over Penn



State-Beaver (86-76) and Franciscan (80-63) last week. For the week, he shot 50 percent from the field (12-of-24), 40 percent from three-point range (4-of-10) and 94 percent from the line (16-of-17). Drakeley tied his career-high with 31 points in the win over Penn State-Beaver.

Also nominated was senior G Marcus Adams of Bethany, junior G Joe McCoy of Grove City, and senior F Joe Herrmann of Thiel.

a pair of threes in the closing seconds in a 68-65 setback to Penn State-Altoona Monday ... **Brody Jackson** led all scorers with 23 points, while **Marcus Adams** had 14 points, four rebounds, four assists and three steals ... **Petre Petkovski** tallied 11 points ... Wednesday, the Bison led La Roche 56-52 with five minutes to play, but the Redhawks closed the game with a 15-4 run to claim a 67-60 victory ... **Joe Testa** had team-highs of 17 points and seven rebounds, while **Tyler Morando** and **Carey Palermo** each had 11.

#### Geneva Golden Tornadoes

Grove City's late-game magic ran out Wednesday as host Hiram pulled out a 78-76 overtime win ... The Wolverines rallied from a 53-41 deficit to

force overtime ... However, Grove City allowed Hiram to shoot 5-of-6 from the floor in overtime ... Four Wolverines scored in double figures, led by **Shawn Carr** with 16 points ... **Joe McCoy** (15), **Andy O'Keefe** (13) and **Ryan Gibson** (11) also reached doubles ... Each of Grove City's last five games have been decided by four points or fewer ... Grove City is now 7-3 in its last 10 games decided by four points or fewer ... The Wolverines will return to conference play Jan. 9 against visiting Thomas More.

#### Saint Vincent Bearcats



The Bearcats split two games this weekend at the Notre Dame College/ Holiday Inn Tournament in South Euclid, Ohio ... Friday, SVC defeated the tournament hosts 73-63,

but the Bearcats were then defeated 76-68 by Union College in the championship game ... In Friday's victory, Ian McCollough recorded 23 points and 12 rebounds - both game highs - while teammates BJ McGill and Billy Bains each added 11 points ... It was the 10<sup>th</sup> win in 11 tries for the Bearcats against former NAIA rival Notre Dame ... Saturday, McCollough led the way once again with 20 points, while teammate Joey Butler scored 19 ... McCollough was tournament MVP, while Butler was all-tournament.

#### Thiel Tomcats



The Tomcats snapped a seven-game losing streak against Allegheny with their 59-55 victory over the Gators Dec. 11 ... Senior F Joe Herrmann finished

with a game-high 19 points, including the final 11 straight ... Herrmann finished 4-of-9 from the field and went 11-for-11 from the free throw line while adding four rebounds, three blocks and three steals, with 13 of his 19 points coming in the second half ... Junior F **Keebo Dowe** added 10 points, four rebounds and a pair of blocks ... The Tomcats shot a season worst 43.5 percent (20-46) from the floor but were able to convert on 18-of-21 free throw opportunities ... They also finished with a 34-29 edge on the glass.

The series is tied 3-3 with the Storm having won two straight over the Bison, including a 79-74 triumph in Painesville last season ... Bethany returns to PAC play on January 5 when the Bison travel to Thiel ... Bethany leads the all-time series 101-43 and has registered nine straight wins over the Tomcats, including a 94-80 win in the PAC Tournament first round to complete a three-game sweep last year.
