### PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2011-12 - Week 5 Conference Notes

**HOLIDAY BREAK:** PAC teams will take a break from conference play over the next two weeks, as several will take part in holiday tournament action against non-conference competition ... Geneva travels to California over the holidays and will compete in the Cal Lutheran tournament on Dec. 29-30, opening play against Carthage ... Bethany will play NCAA qualifier Illinois Wesleyan at Staten Island ... PAC league play re-starts with a full slate of games on Wednesday, Jan. 4, 2012.

**NEWS & NOTES:** Junior F **Nick Wilcox** averaged 19 points, 7.5 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game for Bethany, which improved to 10-0 with a pair of non-league wins ... Junior G **Zach Bellhy** of Washington & Jefferson tied his career-high with 27 points while adding four rebounds, three steals and two assists vs. Hiram ... Senior G **Tauvon Pettiford** averaged 17.0 ppg on the week for 2-0 Saint Vincent ... Freshman **Rob Zewe** fired in a career-best 15 points for Grove City vs. Hiram.

**AROUND THE LEAGUE:** Juniors **Ladell Trotty** (19 points) and **Anthony Harvey** (17) helped lead Thiel to a non-league win over Allegheny ... Westminster is at the St. John Fisher Invitational in Rochester, N.Y. next week, while Waynesburg heads to Cleveland to compete in the Bill Sudeck Tournament at Case Western Reserve ... Thomas More was off last week and returns to action with their first-ever meeting with SLIAC member and Kentucky state rival Spalding on Dec. 21.

# PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

## Bethany Bison (10-0, 3-0 PAC)



Bethany won a pair of road games last week and in addition to remaining undefeated, continued its longest winning streak since 2005-06 ... A 14-point halftime lead slipped away from the Bison at Frostburg Stae, but a free throw by **Nick Wilcox** with three seconds left provided the winning margin in a 74-73 victory ... Wilcox hit for 20 in the win, while **James Barton** tallied 19 and **British Alexander** had 10 ... Leading Olivet by only two points at halftime, BC forced 19 Comet turnovers in the second half to pull away for a 68-46 triumph ... Wilcox notched his third double-double of the year with 18 points and 10 boards, while Alexander and **Brady Pacific** scored 13 apiece and Barton, who shot 78 percent (7-of-9) from the arc for the week, was 3-for-3 and had 11 markers.

## Geneva Golden Tornadoes (3-6, 2-2 PAC)



Geneva did not play last week and will have no games until it travels to California Lutheran next week for a pair of games at the Cal Lutheran Tournament ... The Golden Tornadoes will open that tournament against Carthage on December 29<sup>th</sup>.

## Grove City Wolverines (4-5, 1-3 PAC)



Grove City closed the first semester with a 92-64 setback at Hiram Wednesday night in non-conference action ... Hiram made seven of its first nine three-point attempts in the win ... **Mitch Marmelstein** led GCC with 16 points and fellow freshman **Rob Zewe** came off the bench to fire in a career-high 15 points ... **Josh Patterson** grabbed a team-best five rebounds and senior G **Brett Matson** recorded four assists ... The Wolverines return to action December 29-30 by competing in the McDonald's of Bluffton Tournament ... Grove City meets Muskingum at 6 p.m. on the 29<sup>th</sup> in one semifinal game ... The next afternoon, Grove City plays either Bluffton or Ohio State-Lima ... Grove City returns to PAC play January 4 at Westminster.

## Saint Vincent Bearcats (7-3, 1-2 PAC)



Junior **Chris Klimchock** joined the team prior to Friday's game against UP-G ... The Edinboro transfer played 45 minutes in his first two games, recording 11 points, 5 rebounds 4 assists and 5 steals, all off the bench ... Chris is the brother of **Laura Klimchock**, a 1300+ point scorer for the SVC women's team ... **Armani Fountain** has been the team's top rebounder the last two games, totaling 15 ... He leads the team on the season with 6.2 rpg.

## Thiel Tomcats (7-2, 4-0 PAC)



For the second game this season, the Tomcats exacted revenge on a regional opponent that they were defeated by last season, as they took down the Gators of Allegheny 88-78 in their lone game of the week ... Junior **Blair Rozenblad** led all scorers in the game with 24 points and he also posted his fourth double double of the season adding 11 rebounds to his total ... Joining Rozenblad in double figures were junior F **Ladell Trotty** (19), junior G **Anthony Harvey** (17), and junior F **Austin Forbes** (10) ... As a team, the Tomcats once again outrebounded their opponent as they gained a 41-32 advantage on the glass ... The win was also the fifth straight double-digit victory for Thiel.

## Washington & Jefferson Presidents (4-6, 1-2 PAC)



Washington & Jefferson saw juniors **Zach Bellhy** and **R.J. Pilato** bucket career-high scoring totals on Sunday, but the Presidents dropped a 85-66 decision to Hiram ... Bellhy tied a career high set earlier this season with 27 points, while Pilato posted 17 points ... Pilato's previous career high was 12, achieved once in each of his previous two seasons ... Senior G **Uchenna Okocha** added seven points, six rebounds and three assists for the Presidents ... Bellhy continues to lead the PAC in scoring at 19.4 points per game.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (2-8, 0-3 PAC)



The Waynesburg University men's basketball team fell 86-54 at Heidelberg in its final game before breaking for Christmas on Thursday ... Senior G **Larry Alexander** continued to enjoy a strong final season with the Yellow Jackets as he poured in a game-high 17 points in the loss ... Freshman F **Jacob Fleegle** added nine points and six rebounds.

# PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL PREVIEWS

## Bethany Bison at Staten Island Tournament (12/29-30)



The Bison are off until after Christmas break before returning to the court at the Staten Island Tournament Dec. 29-30 ... Bethany will face perhaps its stiffest test of the season in the first round with a match-up against Illinois Wesleyan, who has reached the NCAA Tournament two straight years and is off to a 7-2 start this year ... The Titans have won three in a row since losing to 13<sup>th</sup>-ranked Wisconsin-Whitewater ... The next day will see a match-up with either Staten Island, who is 6-3 this year, or Vaughn, who has a 4-5 record to this point ... The Bison also played in the Staten Island Tournament in 2002-03 and won the title, beating Elmira (68-67) and King's Point (89-83).

## Geneva Golden Tornadoes at Cal Lutheran Tournament (12/29-30)



Geneva will not be in action again until a pair of games at the California Lutheran Tournament on December 29-30 ... The Golden Tornadoes will not be back at Metheny Fieldhouse until a meeting with Saint Vincent on January 11<sup>th</sup>.

## Grove City Wolverines at Bluffton Tournament (12/29-30)



Grove City will compete in the McDonald's of Bluffton Tournament December 29-30 ... It is Grove City's first appearance in the tournament since 2008 ... GCC also played at Bluffton in 2006, 2004 and 1999 ... The Wolverines open the tournament by facing Muskingum in the semifinals ... The all-time series is tied 3-3 ... Grove City topped the Muskies November 20, 2010, 64-52, at the Penn State-Behrend tournament last season ... The other competing teams are host Bluffton and Ohio State-Lima ... Grove City is 1-2 all-time against Bluffton and 1-0 against OSU-Lima ... The Wolverines played both teams in '08 at Bluffton.

## Saint Vincent Bearcats at Miami Classic (12/30-31)



Saint Vincent will open the Miami Classic with a 5:30 p.m. tip-off against Plattsburg State on Dec. 30.

## Thiel Tomcats at Wooster Invitational (12/29-30)



The Tomcats will face one of their biggest tests of the season as they travel to Wooster, Ohio to compete in the "Mose" Hole/Kiwanis Classic ... In the first contest of the tournament, Thiel will take on the #19-ranked Wooster Fighting Scots ... In the second game, the Tomcats will face the Terriers of Hiram College ... The Tomcats will go into the tournament ranking first in the PAC in field goal percentage (.486) and second in field goal percentage allowed (.395) ... Thiel also tops the conference in rebounding margin, outrebounding opponents by seven rebounds per game ... Individually, **Blair Rozenblad** ranks third in the PAC in points per game (17.1) and is first in rebounds per contest (9.1) ... Three Tomcats also rank in the top five in the conference in field goal percentage.

## Thomas More Saints

at Spalding (12/21)

This will be the Saints' first meeting with Spalding on the hardwood ... For the season, junior SF **Phil Feinberg** leads the team in scoring and rebounding as he averages 13.2 ppg., and 7.1 rpg ... Through nine games, the Saints have a +11.7 scoring margin as they average 77.8 points per game and hold the opposition to 66.1 points per game ... Thomas More is shooting 48.1 percent from the field on 242-of-503 shooting from the floor.

## Washington & Jefferson Presidents at Kenyon (12/29) vs. Denison (12/31)



W&J and Kenyon will meet for the 27<sup>th</sup> time in history on Dec. 29 with the Presidents leading by a 14-12 margin ... The two schools have met every season since 1993-94 and have split those 18 meetings ... The Lords won last year in Washington by a 75-67 margin ... Denison and W&J meet for the 22<sup>nd</sup> time in history on New Year's Eve ... DU holds a slight 11-10 edge in the series, but the Presidents have claimed three of the last four meetings, including a 79-69 win two years ago in Ohio.

## Waynesburg Yellow Jackets at Case Western Reserve Tournament (12/29-30)



The Waynesburg University men's basketball team is off until Dec. 29 when it will travel to Cleveland, Ohio to take part in the Bill Sudeck Holiday Tournament, which is hosted by Case Western Reserve ... The Yellow Jackets will face the host team to open their two-day run. The two teams have met one other time, but the contest, which Waynesburg won 35-23, occurred all the way back in the 1932-33 season and was actually against the Case School of Applied Science ... Case eventually merged with Western Reserve University in 1967 to create its modern incarnation.

## Westminster Titans at Hiram (12/22) at St. John Fisher Tournament (12/29-30)



Westminster lost to Hiram, 99-81, at home last year ... Prior to that, the Titans beat Hiram, 131-101, at home in the 2004 opener ... The last eight meetings were either in New Wilmington or at a neutral site ... The Titans are making their first trip to Hiram since winning 60-28 in 1942.
