Geneva will play at the Case Reserve Tourney in Cleveland, while Saint Vincent plays in the Smoky Ballinger Tourney at Otterbein.

NEWS & NOTES: Bethany sophomore F Nick Wilcox averaged 13.5 ppg and 5.5 rpg while shoopting 75% (9-of-12) from the floor last week for 2-0 Bethany ... Senior C Brian Muse had 14 points and a pair of blocks for Thomas More in a 67-54 win over Capital in a rematch of the two teams' 2008 NCAA playoff first round contest ... Junior F Jeff Young averaged a team-high 12.3 ppg and 5.7 rpg over three contests for 1-2 Waynesburg ... Freshman G Isaac Turner scored 19 points for Saint Vincent at PS-Fayette.

Washington & Jefferson, which hosts Muskingum this Thursday, is 7-6 in games in December under head coach Glenn Gutierrez ... Geneva was off last week and returns to action Dec. 29-30 at the CWRU Tournament in Cleveland ... Thiel was off as well and returns to the hardwood Dec. 30 at D-II Clarion ... Westminster has dropped 12 straight road games entering the holiday tournaments.

Saint Vincent trailed for the first 36 minutes of the game, before ending the contest on a 16-8 run to ward off the Roaring Lion upset bid, as a Dennis Bassich three-pointer with 3:30 left put the Bearcats ahead to stay ... Isaac Turner led both sides with 19 points, while BJ McGill added 14 and Bassich 13 ... Saint Vincent shot 58.6 percent (17-for-29) over the second half, outscoring the Lions 43-32 over the final 20 minutes ... The victory was the Bearcats' eighth in as many meetings all-time against Fayette, and clinched the season sweep for SVC over the Lions, as the Bearcats defeated them 83-53 in the season opener on Nov. 16th.




