Testa led the Bison to a 94-90 double-overtime win at Denison in Bethany's only game of the week by posting 15 points and a game-high 20 rebounds, including 10 offensive boards. He scored four consecutive points in the second OT session to break an 88-88 tie and give BC a lead it would not relinquish. The 20 rebounds was a career-high and the most by a Bison player since **Matt Drahos** tied the school record with 26 vs. Westminster in January, 2006.

Also nominated was junior F **Luke Tomaselli** of Grove City, senior PF **Daniel McKeehan** of Thomas More, junior F **R.J. Pilato** of Washington & Jefferson, and sophomore F **Lou Galante** of Waynesburg.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL 2009-10 - Week 6 Conference Notes

BISON WIN THRILLER: PAC co-leader Bethany posted a thrilling win at Kenyon last week, as the Bison edged the Lords 94-90 in double overtime ... It was the fourth consecutive win for Bethany, who overcame a 10-for-22 performance at the foul line in the victory ... Trailing by three in the closing second of the first extra session, a three-pointer at the buzzer by **Jay Lyonett** sent the game to the second OT, where **Jonas Ankrom** scored six of his 17 points en route to the win.

NEWS & NOTES: Senior F **Daniel McKeehan** bucketed a team-high 25 points for Thomas More, which fell at Capital 94-76 in a rematch of last year's NCAA Tournament first round matchup ... Sophomore F **Lou Galante** scored 14 points off the bench to lead Waynesburg to its first win of the year, 80-56, at Penn State-Fayette ... Junior F **Luke Tomaselli** fired in a career-high 20 points to lead Grove City past Kenyon ... Junior F **R.J. Pilato** recorded 12 points and five rebounds for W&J in a win over Juniata.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Geneva will travel to the Sunshine State to face a pair of D-II opponents in Florida Tech and Flagler over the holiday break ... Westminster heads to California for four games over the break, including a pair at the Westmont Tournament ... Thiel will compete in the Case Western Reserve Tournament in Cleveland, while Saint Vincent returns to action at the St. John Fisher Tournament in Rochester, N.Y. and Grove City competes at the Marietta Shrine Classic in Marietta, Ohio.

PAC MEN'S BASKETBALL NOTES

Bethany Bison (6-3, 2-0 PAC)



Bethany shook off shaky free throw shooting and used a buzzer beater at the end of the first OT to keep the game alive, as they pulled out a 94-90 triumph at Denison last Tuesday in their final outing before the Christmas holiday ... Although they made just 10-of-22 from the foul line in regulation, the Bison forced OT and a trey by **Jay Lyonett** at the horn of the first extra session tied the game again at 78 ... In the final OT period, **Jonas Ankrom** scored six of his 17 to help BC, who was 7-for-10 from the charity stripe in overtime, claim their 4th straight win ... Lyonett and Ankrom led the scoring with 17 points each, while **Joe Testa** had 15 points and 20 rebounds ... Also reaching double digits was **Damien Green** with 14 and **Dustin Opalka** with 13, as well as a career-high eight assists.

Geneva Golden Tornadoes (5-4)



Following a 17-day lay-off, the Golden Tornadoes will begin play in the sunshine state with back to back games against a pair of NCAA Division II programs ... Geneva will face Florida Tech on December 29th and then visit Flagler the next night ... The Golden Tornadoes will get back into PAC action after the new year with a stop in Kentucky on their way home from Florida ... Geneva will face Thomas More on January 2nd as the Golden Tornadoes look to continue a positive start to the 2009-10 season ... Geneva last took the court on December 12th with a loss at Bethany College despite a 20-point effort from leading scorer **Rich Colick** ... Colick is averaging over 18 points per game to lead the Geneva offensive attack.

Grove City Wolverines (5-4, 2-1 PAC)



Grove City capped the first semester Tuesday night with a 79-68 home win over Kenyon ... Grove City shot 13 of 21 on three-point attempts in the win ... Junior **Luke Tomaselli** fired in a career-high 20 points, including four three-pointers ... **Joe McCoy** had 16 points, including five threes ... Senior C **Andy O'Keefe** also recorded 16 points and pulled in eight rebounds ... Grove City shot 53 percent from the field ... The Wolverines opened the second half with a 19-2 ... Each team had 31 rebounds ... Grove City is 2-0 at home now.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (3-5)



Idle since a 75-70 defeat at Hood College on Dec. 10th, the Bearcats limp into Christmas on a four-game losing streak, their longest since the 2000-01 campaign ... Despite their 3-5 start, the team boasts two of the PAC's top eight scorers in junior **BJ McGill** (23.9 ppg/1st in PAC) and senior **Mike Watkins** (14.8 ppg/8th in PAC) ... McGill also leads the league in assists per game (4.25) and steals (37), and is second in three-point field goals (19) ... The tandem is also fourth and fifth in rebounding, with McGill pulling down 6.6 caroms per game and Watkins 6.5.

The Thiel College men's basketball team (3-5; 0-1) was idle last week.

Thomas More Saints (5-3, 1-1 PAC)



The Saints lost, 94-76, to Capital last Thursday in their lone game of the week ... Senior PF **Daniel McKeehan** led the team in scoring with a career-high 25 points ... Junior F **Aaron Miller** joined him in double-figures with 10 points ... McKeehan and junior F **Eddie Brown** led the team in rebounding with seven each ... For the season, McKeehan leads the team in scoring (15.5 points per game), rebounding (6.0 rebounds per game) and assists (18).

Washington & Jefferson Presidents (6-5, 2-0 PAC)



Washington & Jefferson extended its win streak to four games Sunday with a 75-57 victory over Juniata on Sunday at the Henry Memorial Center ... The Presidents' defense limited the Eagles to 5-of-33 shooting in the second half ... W&J made 29-of-34 free throws during the win ... Freshman F **R.J. Pilato** posted season-high totals of 12 points and five rebounds, while junior G **Brian Felker** netted a team-high 13 points.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets (1-7, 0-2 PAC)



The Waynesburg men's basketball team earned its first win of the season on Saturday by downing Penn State Fayette, the Eberly Campus 80-56 ... Eight different Yellow Jackets scored at least five points each in the win ... Sophomore **Lou Galante** scored a team-high 14 points off the bench on 7-of-8 shooting from the field, while junior **Steven Iser** chipped in 13, and freshman **Ben Altmeyer** added a dozen ... Junior **Erik Noone** pulled down a game-high nine rebounds as Waynesburg out-worked the Roaring Lions 41-36 on the boards ... The Jackets also held a big advantage in turnovers (25-14).

Westminster Titans (2-6, 0-2 PAC)



Westminster was off last week and returns to action with three games in California during the holiday break, starting with a pair of contests at the Westmont Tournament on Dec. 29-30.

BC forced 25 turnovers, but shot a frigid 28 percent from the floor, including only 4-for-28 from the arc ... Bethany hosts John Carroll on Jan. 2 in the team's first meeting since the 2005 NCAA Tournament ... The Blue Streaks, who lead the series between old PAC rivals 34-31, eliminated BC in '05 with a 76-48 decision, which was Bethany's first of five straight postseason appearances ... John Carroll was ranked 2nd in the nation by D3Hoops.com until two recent losses dropped them to 11th.
