#### PACTOURNAMENT FIRST ROUND GAMES - 2/24/04 First Round Game #1 - Grove City, Pa.

#3 GROVE CITY 71, #6 Washington & Jefferson 61
Grove City opened defense of its 2003 PAC title, as the Wolverines had five players score in double figures in a 10-point home win over Washington & Jefferson. Junior F Ryan Eller (Erie, PA/Iroquois H.S.) led GCC with 16 points, while senior F Tanner Prosser (Pittsburgh, PA/Brentwood H.S.) and sophomore G Matt Phillips (Chagrin Falls, OH/Kenston H.S.) each posted double-doubles in the win. Prosser posted 15 points and 10 rebounds, while Phillips added 11 markers and 10 boards. W&J was paced by freshman G Brandon Studer (Johnstown, PA/Conemaugh Valley H.S.), who scored a game-high 25 points in the loss, including six three-pointers.

### First Round Game #2 - Waynesburg, Pa. #4 WAYNESBURG 65, #5 Thiel 62

Freshman G Beau Wilson (Daybrook, WV/Clay-Battelle H.S.) buried a three-pointer with just two seconds to play, breaking a 62-62 tie and lifting the Yellow Jackets into the PAC semifinals with an opening round win over the Tomcats. Junior G Nick Tomsko (McKees Rocks, PA/Montour H.S.) led the Jackets with 16 points off the bench, followed by Wilson with 15 and junior C Phil McLaughlin (Wheeling, WV/Wheeling Park H.S.) with 11 and a team-high nine rebounds. For Thiel, sophomore F Stephen Laird (Galion, OH/Galion H.S.) posted team-best totals of 16 points and 13 rebounds, while junior G Daryl Moore (Pittsburgh, PA/Westinghouse H.S.) added 15 markers.

PACTOURNAMENT SEMIFINAL GAMES - 2/26/04 Semifinal Game #1 - New Wilmington, Pa. #1 WESTMINSTER 86, #4 Waynesburg 72 Westminster never trailed in the contest, as the Titans took a 44-34 halftime lead en route to advancing to the PAC title game for the first time on Saturday. Junior G Ed Pagley (New Castle, PA/New Castle H.S.) and sophomore F Dom Joseph (New Castle, PA/New Castle H.S.) tied for game-high scoring honors with 23 points apiece, with Joseph also grabbing a game-high 11 rebounds for his second double-double of the season. For the Yellow Jackets, freshman F Shawn Coleman (Pittsburgh, PA/Peabody H.S.) came off the bench to record a team-high 14 points, while classmate Beau Wilson (Daybrook, WV/Clay-Battelle H.S.) dished out a game-high seven assists.

#### Semifinal Game #2 - Bethany, W.Va.

#2 BETHANY 78, #3 Grove City 71

The homestanding Bison advanced to the PAC title game, as Bethany raced to a 45-34 halftime lead before withstanding a late Grove City charge. Five Bethany players reached double figures in scoring, led by freshman G Jim Deep (Aliquippa, PA/Center H.S.) with a game-high 18 points off the bench, while sophomore F Mike Drahos (Wheeling, WV/John Marshall H.S.) added 12 points and a team-high 10 rebounds. The defending PAC champion Wolverines also produced five double-digit scorers in the loss, while senior F Tanner Prosser (Pittsburgh, PA/Brentwood H.S.) and junior F Ryan Eller (Erie, PA/Iroquois H.S.) each posting 14 points and Prosser grabbing a game-high 11 boards.

### PAC CHAMPIONSHIP - 2/28/04 - New Wilmington, Pa. #1 WESTMINSTER 97, #2 Bethany 88

Bethany appeared poised for the upset, leading by 12 late in the first half and seven (49-42) at halftime. However, the top-seeded Titans rallied to capture their first ever PAC crown by outscoring the Bison 55-39 in the second half. Five Titans reached double figures in scoring led by junior G Ed Pagley (New Castle, PA/New Castle H.S.) with 23 points, including 20 in the second half. Sophomore G Mark DeMonaco (New Castle, PA/New Castle H.S.) added 20 points, while sophomore F Dom Joseph (New Castle, PA/New Castle H.S.) posted 14 points and 13 rebounds. Sophomores Matt Drahos (Wheeling, WV/John Marshall H.S.) and Mike Drahos (Wheeling, WV/John Marshall H.S.) each recorded double-doubles for Bethany in the loss, with Matt posting 23 points and 13 rebounds and Mike adding 20 points and 12 boards.
