PACTOURNAMENT FIRST ROUND GAMES - 2/22/05 First Round Game #1 - Washington, Pa.

#3 WASHINGTON & JEFFERSON 88, #6 Waynesburg 64 Washington & Jefferson raced out to a 28-9 advantage in the first 10 minutes en route to capturing its first-ever PAC Tournament victory. Sophomore G Jon Koch (New Kensington, PA/Plum H.S.) led 11 different Presidents in the scoring column with 18 points. He also added five rebounds and three assists. Sophomore G Brandon Studer (Johnstown, PA/Conemaugh Valley H.S.) notched 13 points, while freshman G Tyler Trutza (Bay Village, OH/Bay H.S.) totaled 11 points, six assists and five rebounds. Sophomores Marc Lodovico (Beaver Falls, PA/Blackhawk H.S.) and Jeff Nero (New Castle, PA/Union H.S.) led Waynesburg with 11 points each.

First Round Game #2 - New Wilmington, Pa. #5 Thiel 110, #4 WESTMINSTER 107

Freshmen Ross Watson (Pittsburgh, PA/Central Catholic H.S.) and Joe Herrmann (Linesville, PA/Jamestown H.S.) scored 32 and 30 points, respectively, as the Tomcats upset the defending PAC champion Titans. Senior G Daryl Moore (Pittsburgh, PA/Westinghouse H.S.) and junior F Stephen Laird (Galion, OH/Galion H.S.) each added 20 points in the win. Westminster was paced by junior G Mark DeMonaco (New Castle, PA/New Castle H.S.) with team-high 24 points and six assists, while junior F Dom Joseph (New Castle, PA/New Castle H.S.) added 16 points and a team-best four steals.

PACTOURNAMENT SEMIFINAL GAMES - 2/24/05 Semifinal Game #1 - Grove City, Pa.

#3 Washington & Jefferson 69, #2 GROVE CITY 57
The Presidents snapped a 10-game losing streak to the Wol-

verines and posted their first win in Grove City since 1994, as W&J advanced to the PAC Tournament title game by outscoring GCC 44-33 in the decisive second period. Sophomore G Brandon Studer (Johnstown, PA/Conemaugh Valley H.S.) led W&J with 24 points, including five treys. Sophomore F Matt Vorndran (Fort Wayne, IN/Carroll H.S.) added 14 points, while sophomore G Jon Koch (New Kensington, PA/Plum H.S.) posted a double-double with 12 points and a game-high 10 rebounds. For Grove City, senior F Ryan Eller (Erie, PA/Iroquois H.S.) scored 17 points while senior C Phil Bushre (Swartz Creek, MI/Swartz Creek H.S.) added 10.

Semifinal Game #2 - Bethany, W.Va.

#1 BETHANY 126, #5 Thiel 86

The top-seeded Bison steamrolled their way to the PAC title game with a 40-point home win over the Tomcats. Bethany shot 64 percent from the field (45-of-70), including 60 percent from three-point range (15-of-25). Five Bison scored in double figures, led by sophomore G Brandon Duncan (New Salem, PA/Uniontown Area H.S.) with a team-high 27 points on 8-of-9 shooting, including 7-of-8 three-pointers. Junior brothers Matt Drahos (Wheeling, WV/John Marshall H.S.) and Mike Drahos (Wheeling, WV/John Marshall H.S.) added 22 and 21 points, respectively, with Mike grabbing a team-high eight rebounds. Thiel was paced by senior G Daryl Moore (Pittsburgh, PA/Westinghouse H.S.) with a game-high 30 points.

PACTOURNAMENT CHAMPIONSHIP - 2/26/05 Bethany, W. Va.

#1 BETHANY 94, #3 Washington & Jefferson 78

The top-seeded Bison never trailed as they rolled to a 16-point halftime lead (55-39) against the Presidents. W&J cut the lead to nine points (59-50) early in the second half, but would get no closer. Bethany placed four scorers in double figures, led by junior F Mike Drahos (Wheeling, WV/John Marshall H.S.) with a team-high 24 points and 12 rebounds. Brother Matt Drahos (Wheeling, WV/John Marshall H.S.) added 19 points in the win, while junior G Scott Mezyk (Johnstown, PA/Westmont-Hilltop H.S.) dished out seven assists. For W&J, freshman G Tyler Trutza (Bay Village, OH/Bay H.S.) led all scorers with 26 points while adding seven assists. Sophomore G Jon Koch (New Kensington, PA/Plum H.S.) added 19 markers for the Presidents.
