PAC MEN'S SOCCER 2008 - Week 1 Conference Notes

51 AND COUNTING: The 2008 season marks the 51st consecutive season of men's soccer action in the PAC ... Bethany is easily the conference standard-bearer with 28 PAC men's soccer titles, including 22 straight crowns from 1980-2001 ... Washington & Jefferson captured the 2007 title and the PAC's first-ever automatic bid to the NCAA Division III Tournament, while Westminster and Bethany each qualified for the ECAC Division III South Region Tournament.

NEWS & NOTES: Thomas More opened The Bank of Kentucky Field on Sunday with a 5-0 blanking of Hanover ... It was the first on-campus contest for the Saint program in 10 years, as TMC previously played matches at the off-campus Town & Country Complex and Xavier University ... Junior F **Joey Tensing** led the Saints with two goals and an assist in the victory ... Junior M **Mike DiAngelis** of Waynesburg posted a goal and an assist in a 6-0 blanking of Polytechnic on Saturday.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Seven of nine PAC men's soccer programs were in action during the opening weekend of the 2008 season, as conference teams posted a 5-7-1 mark against non-conference competition ... Westminster sophomore M **Aaron Zavora** was named Defensive MVP of the Westminster-Grove City Invitational after spearheading a defense which held opponents to two goals and 12 shots in two games ... Waynesburg GK **Bryan Hunsberger** made one save in a shutout of Polytechnic.
