PAC Men's Soccer Player of the Week

BLAKE ORDELL Westminster College

Sophomore midfielder Clinton Township, Mich/Fraser H.S.

Ordell scored the game-winning goals in both Westminster wins last week. He scored the game's only goal in the 86th minute of a 1-0 win over Medaille, then tallied an overtime game-winner in the 101st minute to top Penn State-Altoona 1-0.

Other nominees included sophomore F **Brian Bajek** of Bethany, junior GK **Joel Gladfelter** of Grove City, senior F **Andy Kumar** of Washington & Jefferson, and freshman GK **Camillo DiLorenzo** of Waynesburg.

Bethany Bison

The Bison opened the 2004 season on the road and defeated Pitt-Greensburg, 1-0, after a second half goal by sophomore Matt Kosta ... The Bison then went 2-0 at the La Roche Tournament, defeating Juniata, 3-2, in overtime, then getting past Albright 3-2 ... With a 3-0 record to start the season, the Bison equaled the total number of wins the team had all last season ... Against Juniata, sophomore Brian Bajek scored two goals and freshman Marc Auger scored the gamewinner 5:00 into the overtime period ... Against Albright, sophomore Ethan Bertschinger netted two goals, while freshman Tim Fratto had the other ... Lavel Williams had two assists at the tournament.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Presidents opened their 2004 campaign this weekend at the Johns Hopkins University Al Tucci Kickoff Classic in Baltimore, Md. ... W&J defeated Shenandoah (Va.) on Friday afternoon by a 2-0 margin ... Senior F Andy Komar broke open a scoreless tie in the 70th minute as he headed home a cross from freshman MF Marc Clayton ... Freshman D Kyle Burnell then scored his first collegiate goal in the 83rd minute to seal the win ... Freshman F Mitchell Riehle assisted on the final goal ... Senior GK Mike Garet made two saves in the shutout ... Host Johns Hopkins blanked W&J in the championship game on Saturday, 2-0 ... Garet made eight stops for the Presidents, who were out-shot, 16-2.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City opened 2004 with a 7-0 home win over Pitt-Bradford ... Forwards Ben Hoffman and Bob McNees each scored twice in the victory while Joel Gladfelter picked up the shutout victory ... Grove City competed in the Johns Hopkins Classic Friday and Saturday ... The Wolverines fell to the hosts, 1-0, despite six saves from Gladfelter ... McNees scored in the 77th minute Saturday to give Grove City a 1-0 win over Shenandoah in Baltimore ... Gladfelter preserved the win by stopping a penalty kick in the final moments ... Grove City opens PAC play at Waynesburg Wednesday ... The teams have played to a 0-0 tie each of the last two years at Waynesburg.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Jackets offense struggled to find the net in the first two games of 2004, before lighting up Hilbert with a 6-3 victory ... Junior Luke Benton and freshman Todd Schollaert scored two goals each in the contest against Hilbert ... Sophomores David Peters and Dave Thorn each contributed two assists against Hilbert, while Thorn added a goal ... This season the Yellow Jackets have a new face in goal, as freshman Camillo DiLorenzo fills the void left by all-PAC goalie Justin Fee ... DiLorenzo has allowed just 5 goals in 250 minutes of action.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel suffered a pair of setbacks to start the season at the SUNY Brockport Men's Soccer Tournament last weekend ... The Tomcats fell to the host Golden Eagles 4-0 in their opener and lost to Lincoln (Pa.) 4-2 in the consolation game of the tournament ... Senior MF Evan Knox and freshman F Nikola Vasilev each scored in the second half for the Tomcats against Lincoln, but it wasn't enough to overcome a 3-0 halftime deficit ... Freshman GK Ryan Lewis and sophomore GK Mark Coney combined to make eight saves in the game.

Westminster Titans

The Titan kickers opened the 2004 season with a pair of 1-0 wins over Medaille and Penn State-Altoona at the WC/AmeriHost Inn Soccer Classic ... Westminster scored both goals on the same combination, with sophomore MF Blake Ordell finding the back of the net off an assist by senior MF Sebastian Driver-Salazar ... Ordell scored in the 86th minute against Medaille, then scored 11 minutes into the first extra period against Altoona ... Sophomore GK Anthony Beilstein opened his Titan career with a pair of shutout wins, making 11 saves in the two victories.
