PAC Men's Soccer Player of the Week

MATT ELBAN Waynesburg College

Sophomore midfielder Westminster, Md./Carroll Christian H.S.

Elban scored four goals on nine shots in two games last week, as Waynesburg went 1-1 on a weekend road trip. He scored both goals in a 2-1 win at Hilbert on Friday, then added both Yellow Jacket goals in a 5-2 loss at Pitt-Bradford on Saturday.

Other nominees included senior F Justin Kosta of Bethany, freshman B Phil Bresson of Grove City, senior GK Jeremy Rotzell of Thiel, freshman MF Luis Rosales of Washington & Jefferson and senior GK Kevin Humberston of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

Bethany opened defense of its PAC title with a 2-2 tie against visiting W&J ... Forward **Justin Kosta** put the Bison ahead 1-0 with a goal in the 5th minute ... After the Presidents tied the game later in the half and took the lead early in the second half, forward **Ehren Grill** tied the contest with a score in the 59th minute ... Neither team really had a solid scoring chance after that as the game ended in a tie ... The Bison, who had never lost to W&J prior to last season, are now 0-1-1 in the last two games at Hoag Field.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J opened up its PAC schedule last week by tying Bethany, 2-2 ... The Presidents tied the game, 1-1, in the first half on freshman **Luis Rosales**' first career goal and took a 2-1 lead in the second half on a goal by **Andy Komar** before Bethany tied the contest in the 59th minute ... Sophomore goalkeeper **Mike Garet** made nine saves for the Presidents ... Bethany holds a 33-1-3 lead in the all-time series dating back to 1970, however, W&J has fared much better over the last two seasons, going 1-0-2 in regular-season matchups.

Grove City Wolverines

The Wolverines picked up first victory of the season with a six-goal outburst at Lake Erie last Wednesday afternoon ... **Phil Bresson** tallied a goal and two assists to pace Grove City ... The Wolverines led 2-1 at the half and put the match away with four second-half goals ... Grove City's loss to Pitt-Greensburg Saturday snapped a four-game win streak against the Bobcats.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg split two games in its weekend road trip to Hilbert College and Pitt-Bradford ... **Matt Elban** led the Jackets by scoring four goals on nine shots in two games to lead ... His two-goal, sevenshot performance led Waynesburg to a 2-1 win at Hilbert on Sept. 6, while his two goals on two shots were the Jackets only offense in a 5-2 loss at Pitt-Bradford.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcat men's soccer team went 0-3 last week, falling to Pitt-Greensburg 7-0 on Wednesday and dropping two at the Shenandoah University Shootout in Winchester, VA ... The Tomcats dropped a 1-0 decision to the host Hornets on Saturday and fell 2-0 to Catholic University Sunday ... Tomcat senior goalkeeper Jeremy Rotzell made 8 saves against Shenandoah and 6 stops in the loss to Catholic ... Shenandoah notched the game-winning goal with only 3 minutes remaining in regulation, holding the Tomcats to zero shots ... Sophomore Dan Cookson led the squad with 3 shots on goal vs. Catholic.

Westminster Titans

Westminster men's soccer went 0-1-1 over the weekend, finishing second at the four-team Elizabethtown College tournament ... The Titans played the host school to a 0-0 tie through two overtimes on Friday, but advanced to the title game by posting a 4-3 advantage on penalty kicks ... Senior MF Tony Arrigo connected on the final penalty kick to put the Titans in the title game ... In the championship, Westminster lost to nationally-ranked Roanoke 4-0 ... Titan senior GK Kevin Humberston was named the Defensive Player of the Tournament after allowing just two goals in 185 minutes in goal, including the 110-minute shutout of Elizabethtown on Friday.
