Bethany Bison

Bethany went undefeated in three matches last week, which included a tie at PAC foe Grove City and two victories to claim the Stuart Bracher Classic championship ... In the first game of the week, BC settled for a 0-0 tie with the Wolver-

ines ... GK **Kosta Floros** made seven saves to keep GCC off the scoreboard ... Bethany kicked off the weekend with a 1-0 blanking of Gallaudet ... Floros made five saves and F **Sean Esterbauer** scored on a PK in the 71st minute ... The championship game was highlighted by more Bison defense, as Floros made two saves and a goal by **Ashkan Alavy**, off an assist from **Marc Auger**, late in the first half was all BC needed ... Floros, who has posted four shutouts in five matches this year, was named the Classic MVP.



Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats, despite taking early leads in both contests last week, dropped 2-1 home losses to both Hiram and Pitt-Bradford ... Thiel, forced to play a man short just 18 minutes into the game, took a 1-0 lead in the 26th minute when sophomore **Nikola Vasilev** tallied his second goal of
