Freshman forward Wintersville, Ohio/Indian Creek H.S.

Wilson notched a hat trick with three goals, the first of his collegiate career, twhile leading the Jackets to a 5-1 non-conference victory at NAIA Mount Aloysius in Waynesburg's only game of the week.

### **Bethany Bison**

The Bison suffered their first loss of the season on Saturday, 1-0 at home to Buffalo State in the championship game of the Bethany Invitational ... Bethany won its first first round game over Medaille, 3-0 and is now 4-1 this season ... The four wins eclipses last season's win total (three) ... In the Medaille game, the Bison got goals from sophomore Brian Bajek, freshman Marc Auger and senior Nick Krayvo on a free kick ... Bajek also added an assist on the Auger goal and Lavel Williams assisted on the Bajek goal ... Against the Bengals, defense dominated as Bethany had four total shots and Buffalo State managed just three. However, Prisco Houndanon scored in the 24th minute for BSC.

#### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Allegheny edged Washington & Jefferson, 1-0, on Saturday afternoon in Meadville on a goal in the 69th minute ... AC held a 22-8 shot advantage ... Senior forward Mike Chiodo nearly tied the game in the final minutes, but his shot was cleared off the goal line by a Gator defender ... Senior goalie Mike Garet made seven saves to keep his goals-against average for the season at 1.00 ... Chiodo, the W&J all-time leading scorer, has been held to just five shots in three games ... W&J has been shutout in back-to-back contests and plays another regionallyranked opponent, Carnegie Mellon, on Wednesday in Pittsburgh ... The Presidents also travel to Penn State-Behrend on Saturday.

## **Grove City Wolverines**

Grove City continued with non-conference play Saturday, falling at home to Pitt-Greensburg...The Wolverines trailed 2-0 at halftime but tied the match in the second half on goals from Nate Jones and Jake Burns ... Senior Peter Williams had Grove City's lone assist in the match ... The Wolverines' PAC opener at Waynesburg Sept. 8 never materialized as heavy rains forced the match to be postponed ... No makeup date has been established yet ... Grove City opens conference play Saturday at Bethany.

### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg posted a 5-1 victory over Mt. Aloysius Saturday to give the Yellow Jackets back-to-back wins for the first time since Sept. 2003 ... Jacket freshman F Michael Wilson notched his first collegiate goal in fine fashion this weekend, and then went on to add two more to register a hat trick against the Mounties ... Classmate John Danhires assisted on Wilson's first two goals, before Wilson scored his final goal unassisted in the 70th minute ... Sophomores Ross Philips and Dave Thorn each netted goals in the Jackets' lone game of the week, as rain postponed the contest with Grove City ... Freshman GK Camillo DiLorenzo made five saves in the win while going the distance against Mt. Aloysius.

#### Thiel Tomcats

Freshman Nikola Vasilev scored three goals at this weekend's Penn State Altoona Hoss's/Comfort Inn Lion Invitational, but the Tomcats lost to the host Lions 3-1 on Saturday and fell to Juniata College 5-2 in the consolation game Sunday ... The Tomcats fell behind early against Altoona Saturday, trailing 3-0 with 41 minutes played in the first half ... Vasilev scored in the 43rd minute and again in the 45th minute to bring the Tomcats to within one, 3-2, going into the half ... Sophomore GK Mark Coney recorded seven saves in the loss...Juniata had a 1-0 halftime lead before Vasilev scored to tie the game at 1-1, but Juniata scored two more in the second half ... Freshman GK Ryan Lewis made a pair of saves.

#### Westminster Titans

The Titan booters remained unbeaten at 4-0 after posting home wins over Pitt-Bradford (4-1) and Penn State-Behrend (2-0) last week ... Against UP-B, sophomore M Blake Ordell opened the scoring assisted by freshman M Garrett Horvath ... UP-B rallied to tie the game 1-1, only to see the Titans answer with an unassisted goal by senior M Sebastian Driver-Salazar and a goal by senior D Zach Saxman assisted by Driver-Salazar for a 3-1 halftime lead ... Five minutes into the second half, senior D Nick White posted an insurance goal assisted by Driver-Salazar and Ordell ... Freshman F Andrew Saporito scored both goals againt Behrend, with Horvath and sophomore M Alex Castillo posting assists.
