PAC Men's Soccer Player of the Week

Reinoso picked up all three Bethany goals in PAC wins over Grove City (1-0 in OT) and Thiel (2-1) last week. He hit the game-winner against GCC six minutes into overtime and scored the decisive goal against Thiel with 31 seconds to play.

Bethany Bison

Bethany split four contests last week, claiming a pair of PAC victories before dropping two at the Methodist Tournament ... Midfielder **Daniel Reinoso** scored the game-winner with six minutes left in the second overtime to give the Green and White a 1-0 win over Grove City ... Reinoso came back with both goals, including the game-winner with just 31 seconds left in a 2-1 triumph over Thiel ... Down in N.C., Bethany gave up two goals in the final seven minutes against Methodist and three goals in the final 18 minutes against Wesleyan ... Forward **Billy Constantine** scored Bethany's only goal against Methodist and **Ehren Grill** and **Papa Sane** tallied the scores in the N.C. Wesleyan game.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson picked up its first PAC victory of the season by defeating Thiel, 3-0, on Saturday at Cameron Stadium ... The win gave the Presidents their first in five tries this season ... Sophomore **Phil Zaccarrino** scored two goals for the Presidents, while senior **Anton Loffreda** added his first goal of the season ... Zaccarrino now leads the team with three goals and seven points ... The Presidents dropped two one-goal contests this week after losing a 3-0 lead against Pitt-Greensburg and falling, 4-3, and dropping a 2-1 double-overtime decision to Penn State-Behrend on Wednesday ... Junior goalie **Brad Guinn** leads the W&J goalkeepers with a 0.66 GAA.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City began Presidents' Athletic Conference play with a pair of double-overtime matches ... Wolverines had not played a double-overtime match against a PAC foe since Sept. 13, 2000, when they fell to Waynesburg, 2-1 ... Wolverines received goals from **Mike Koper** and **Matt Dobson** against Mount Union ... Grove City faces rugged week with matches at Bethany and at national powerhouse Messiah Saturday.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Justin Fee recorded 13 saves to preserve Waynesburg's 0-0 tie against Grove City in its PAC opener last Wednesday ... Waynesburg then shutout D'Youville, 5-0, as sophomore midfielder **Matt Elban** continued his scoring spree ... Elban scored his seventh goal in four games during the win over D'Youville by recording a hat trick ... **Anthony Mariani** netted the Jackets other two goals, while Fee and **Andrew Fencil** combined for the shutout.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcat men's soccer team went 0-2 last week, with both defeats coming at the hands of PAC foes ... They fell 2-1 to Bethany on Sept. 11 and 3-0 to W&J on Sept. 14 ... The Tomcats were outshot 41-10 in the two conference matches ... Senior **Jeremy Rotzell** made 13 saves against Bethany and sophomore **Evan Knox** tallied the Tomcats first goal since their opening game on Aug. 31 ... The Presidents held an 11-4 advantage in shots and a 9-1 advantage in corner kicks taken ... Rotzell stopped 11 shots for the Tomcats in the loss to the Presidents.

Westminster Titans

Westminster men's soccer split a pair of non-conference contests this week ... The Titans posted a 3-0 shutout over La Roche in their home opener on Wednesday, then fell at Pitt-Greensburg 3-2 on Sunday ... Sophomore **John Booth**, junior **Matthew Roser** and senior **Carl Baldwin** each scored against La Roche, while senior GK **Kevin Humberston** made four saves to post his second shutout of the season ... Humberston was credited with 11 saves in the loss to the Bobcats.
